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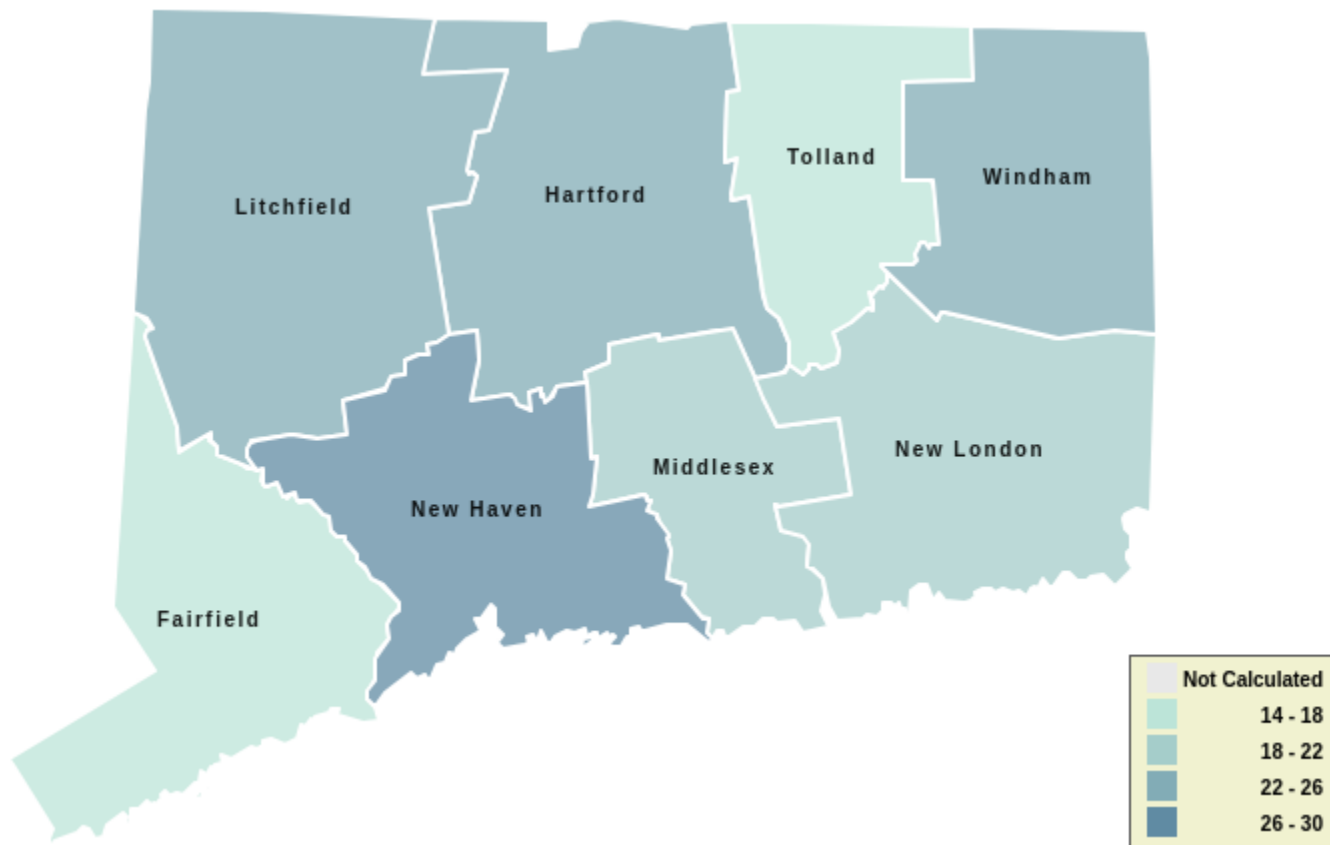

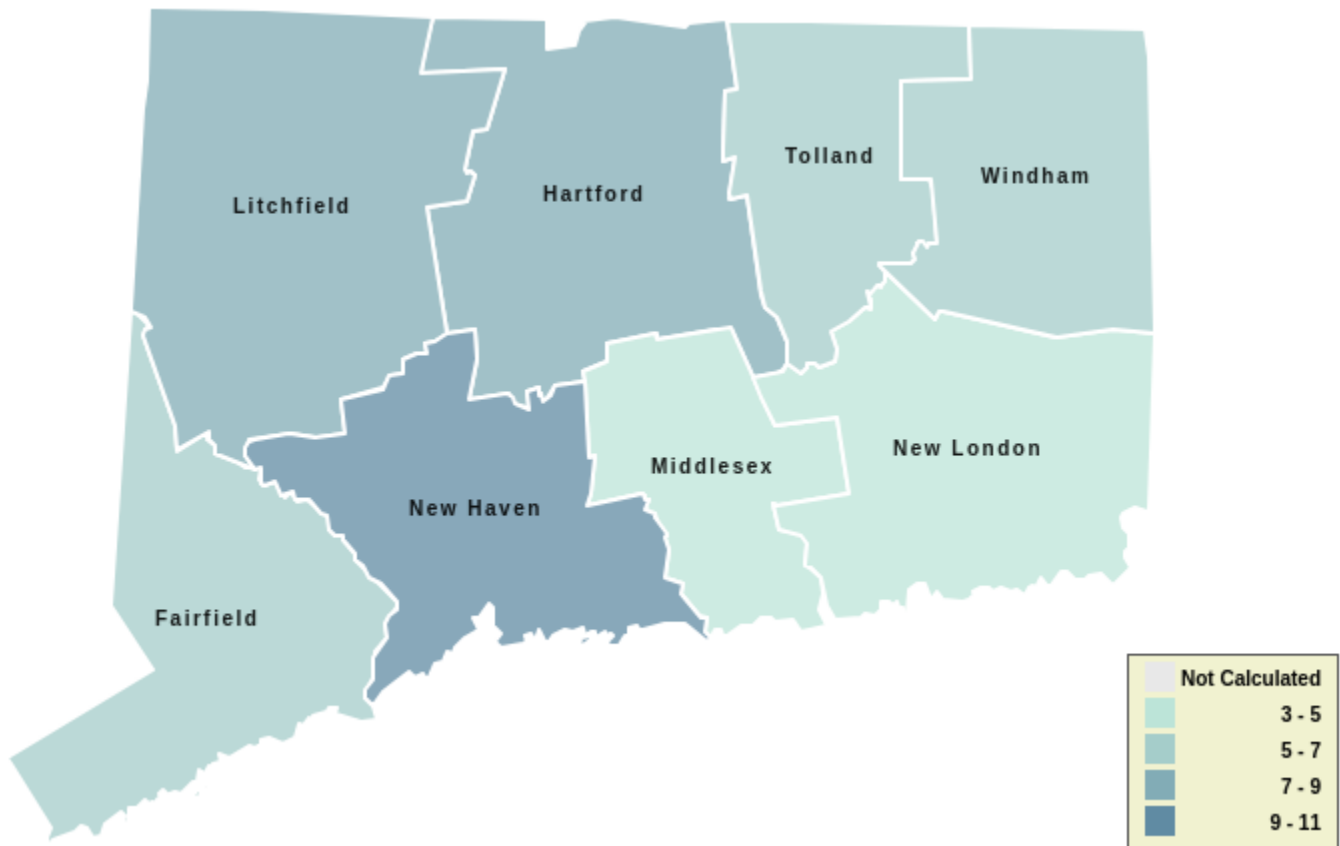

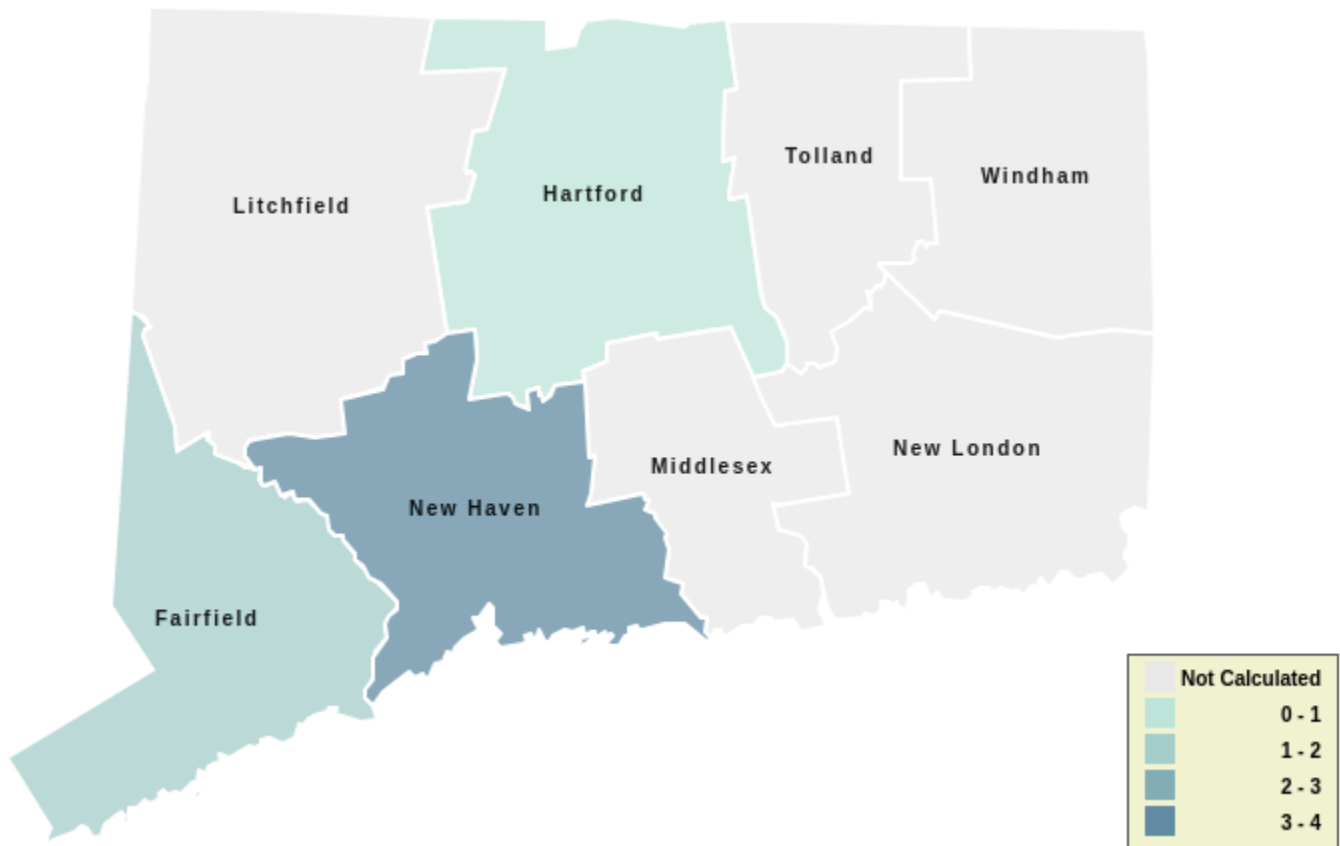

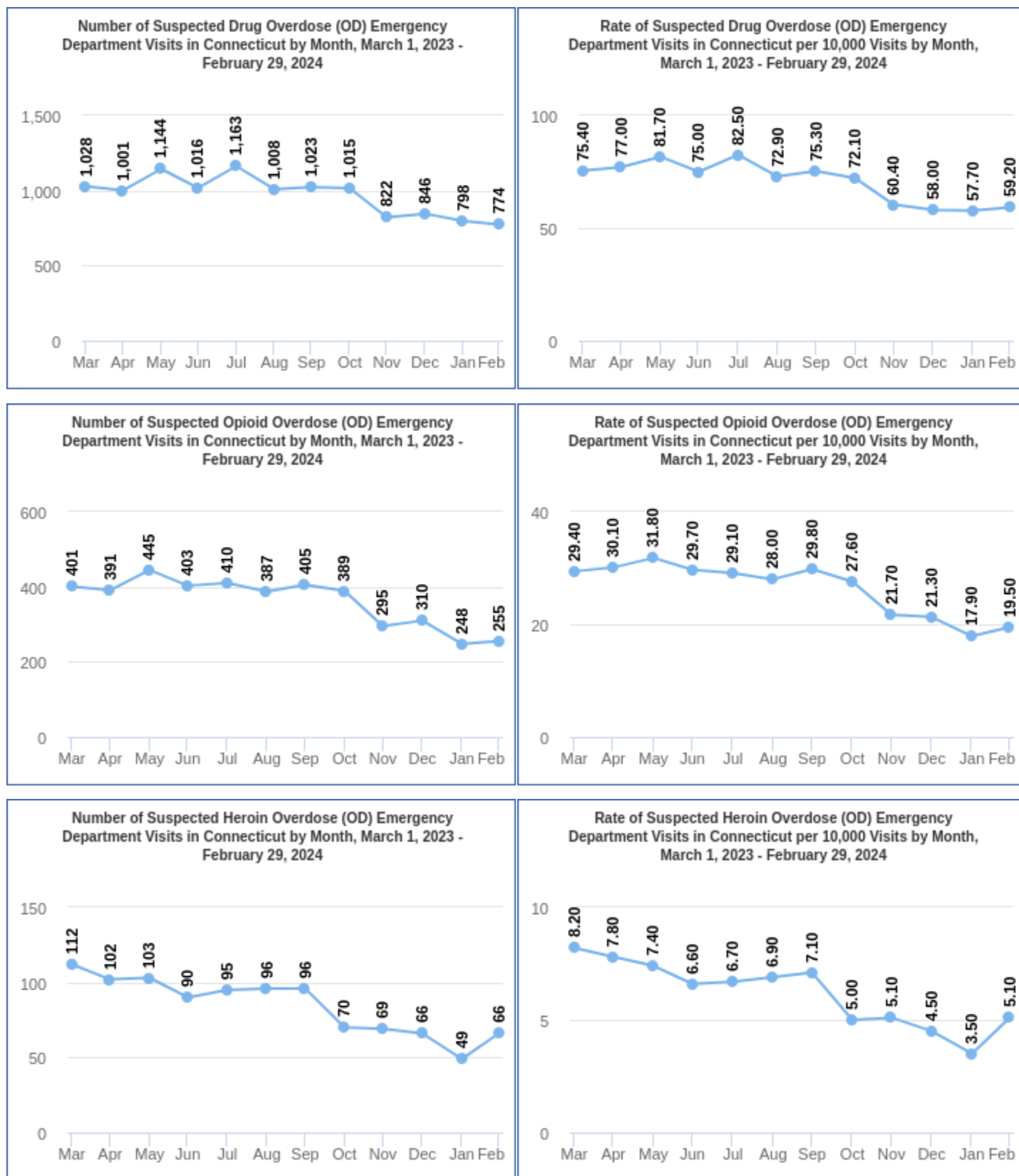

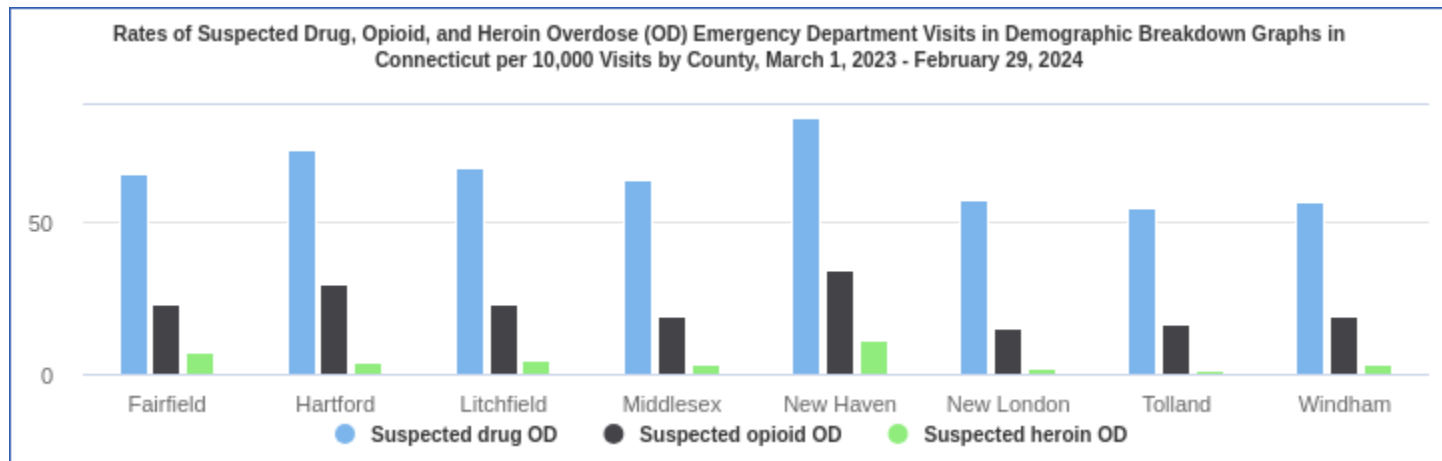

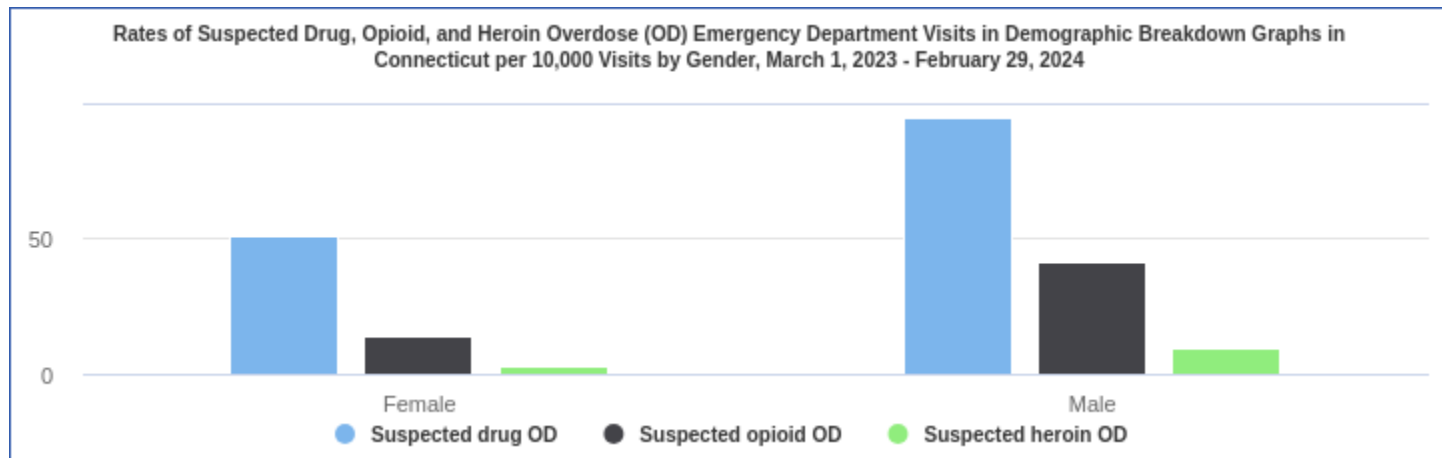

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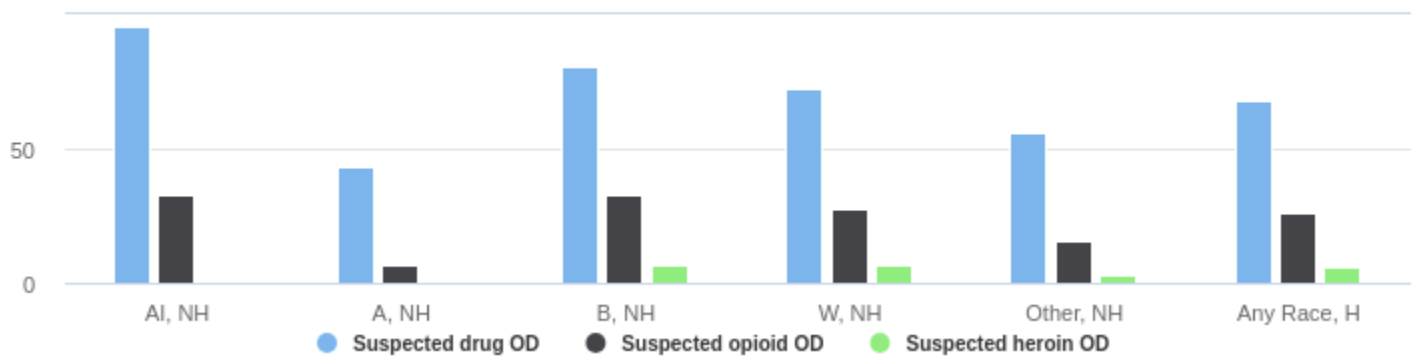

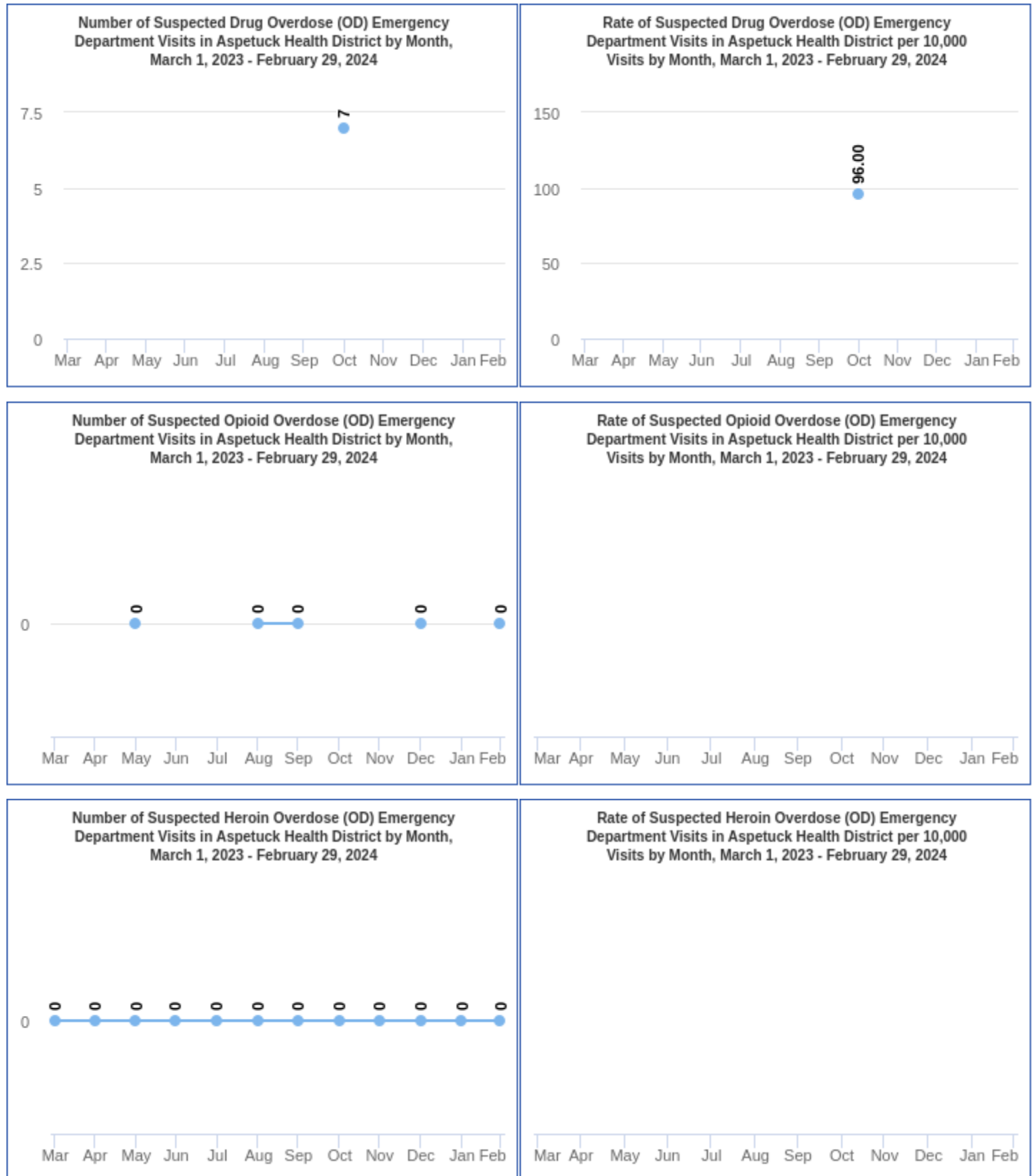

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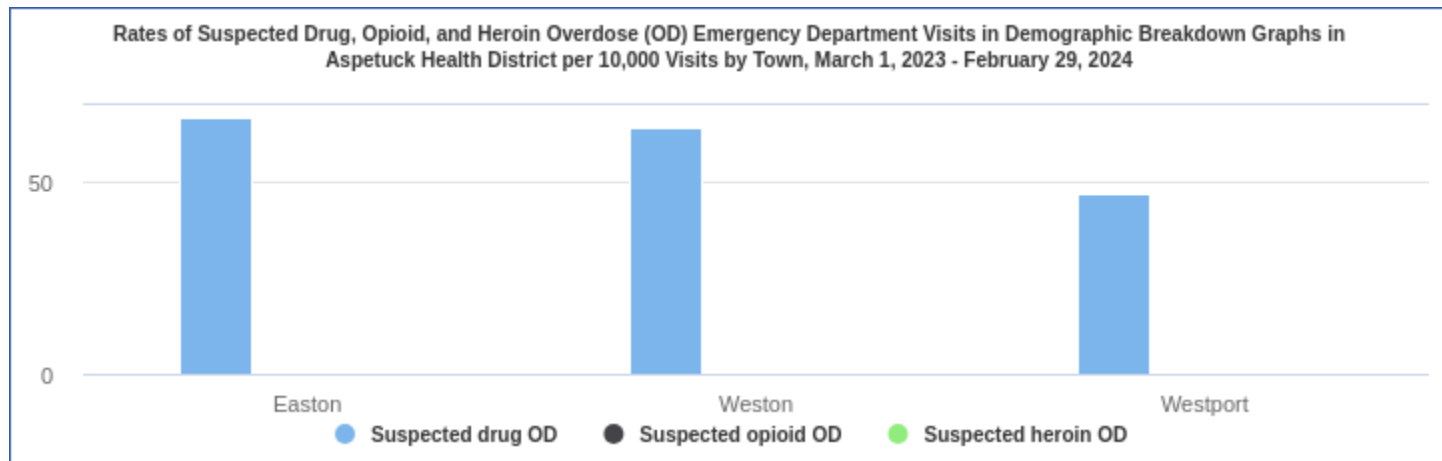

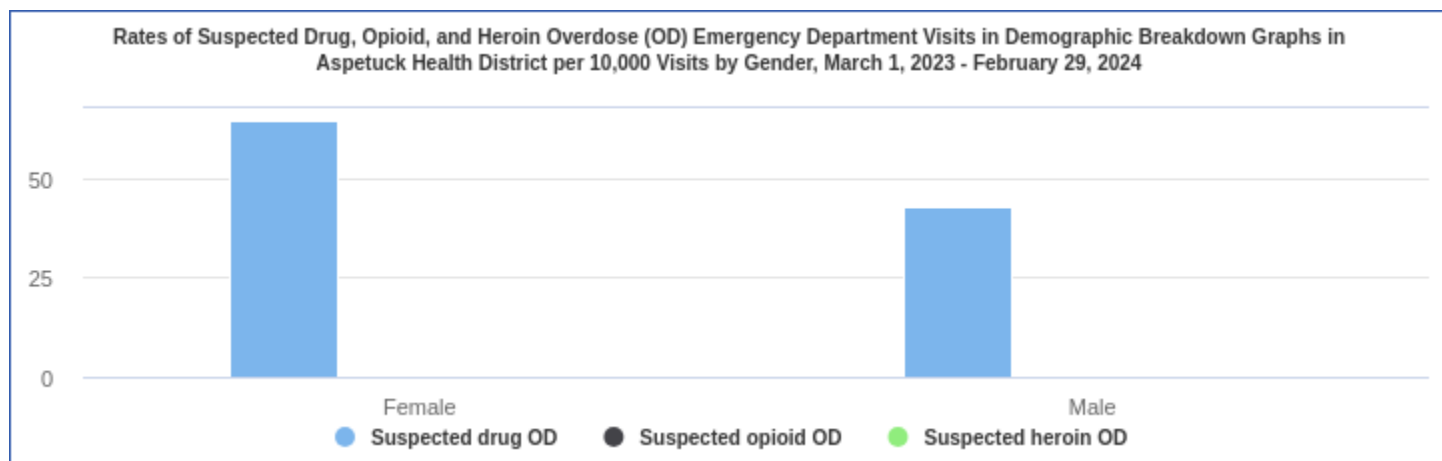

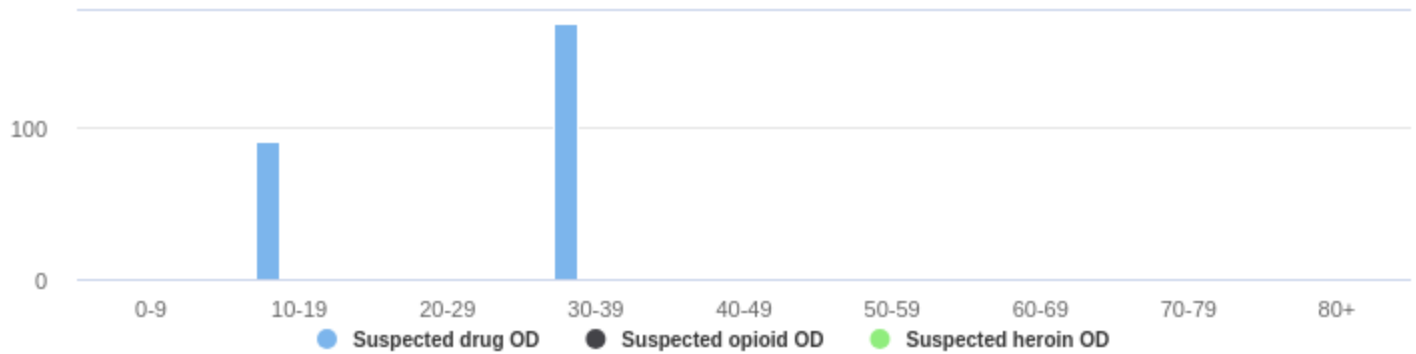

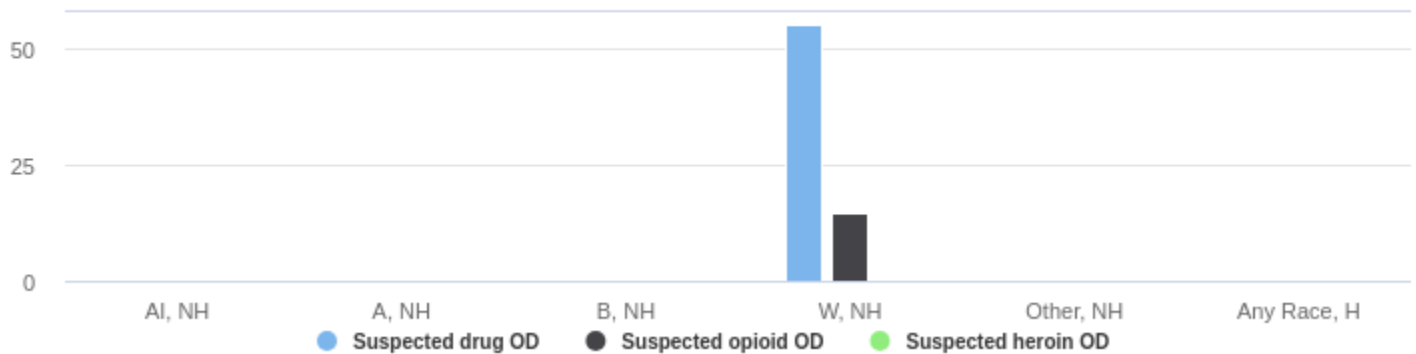

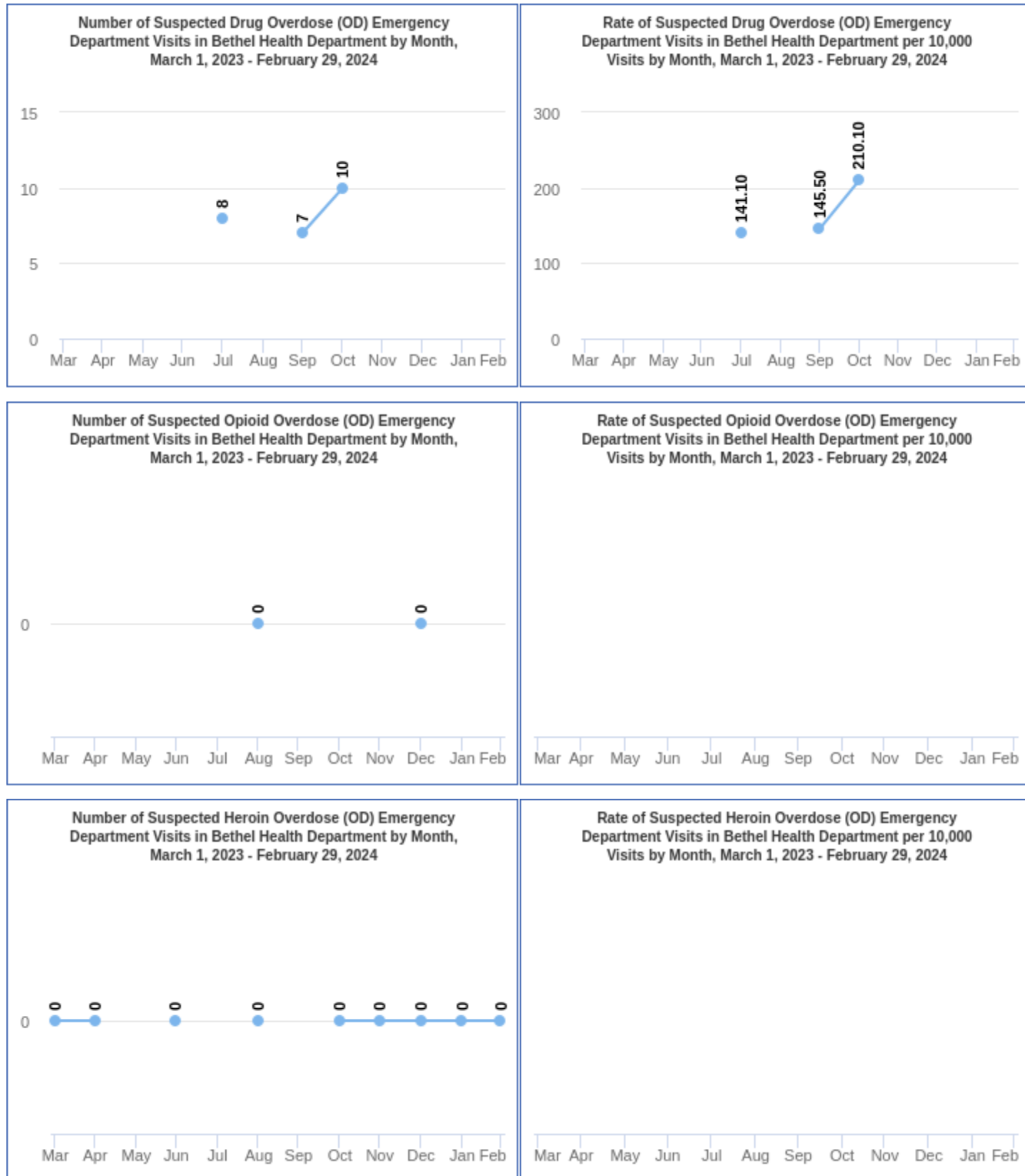

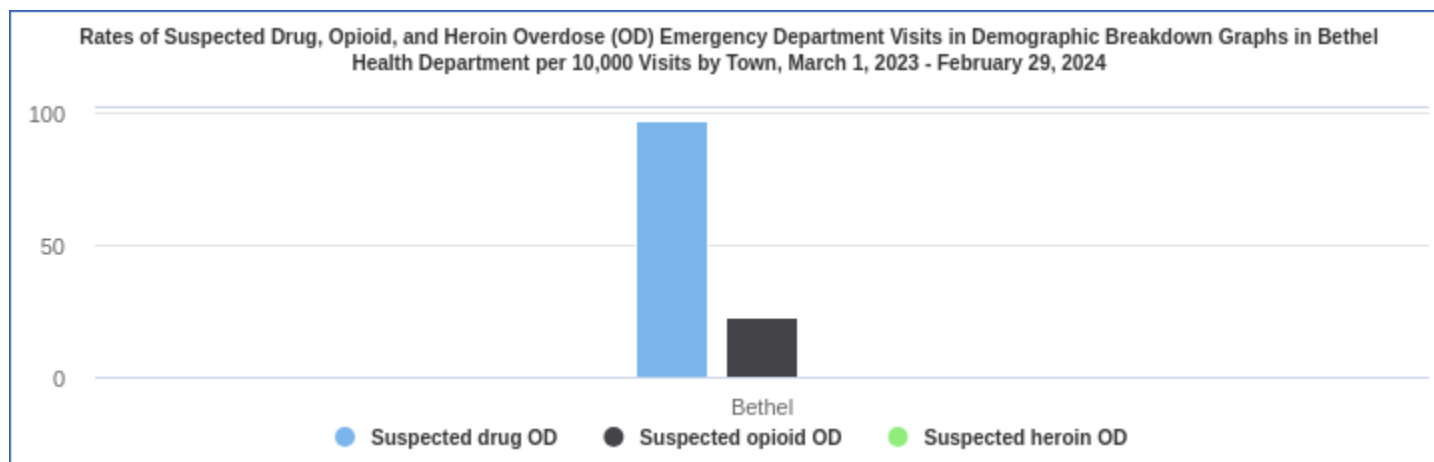

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Bethel Health Department



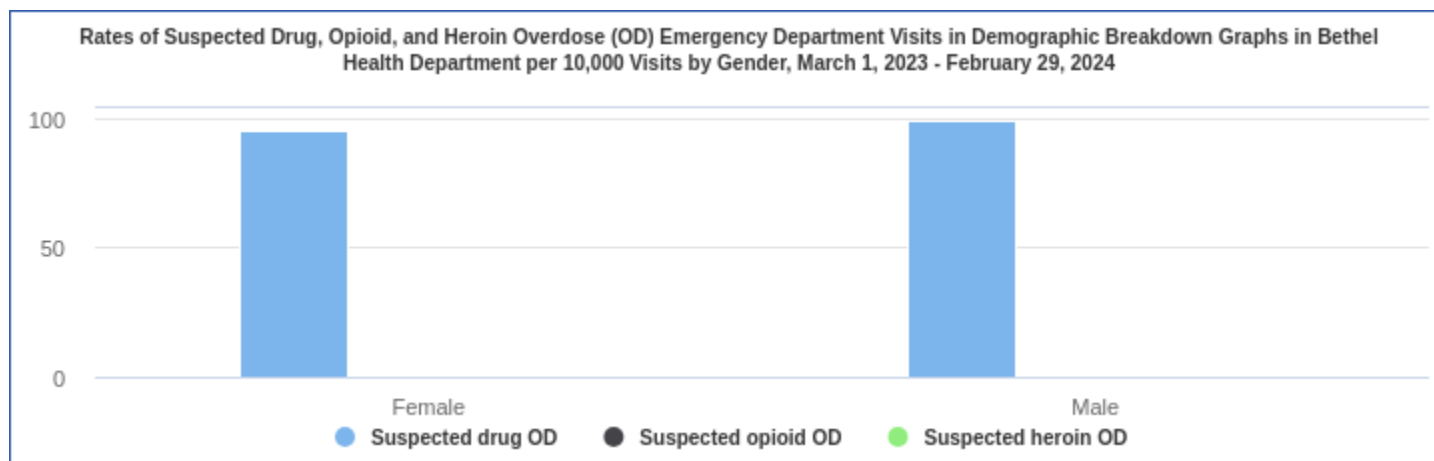

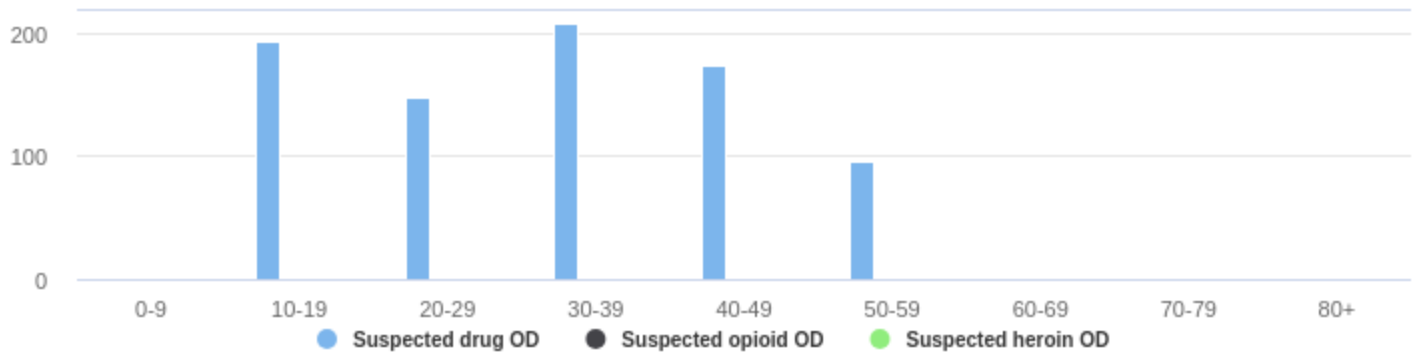

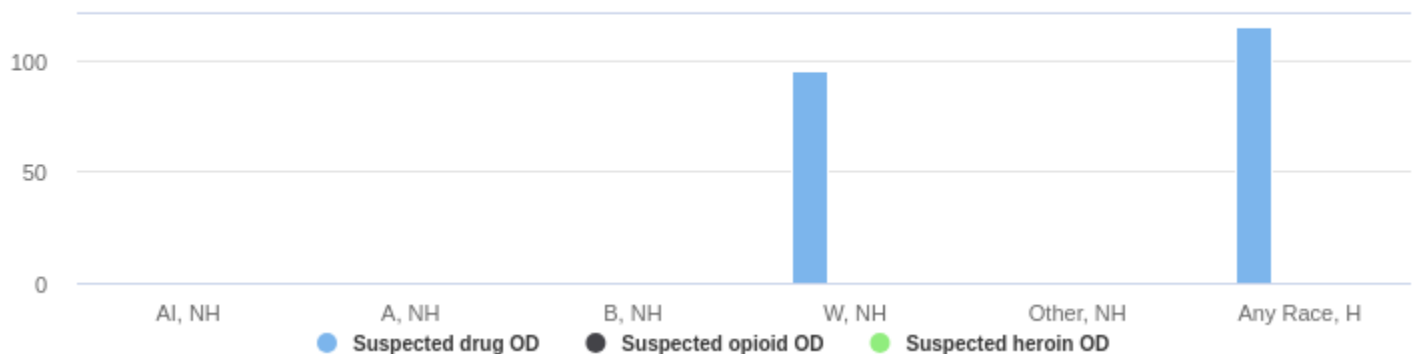

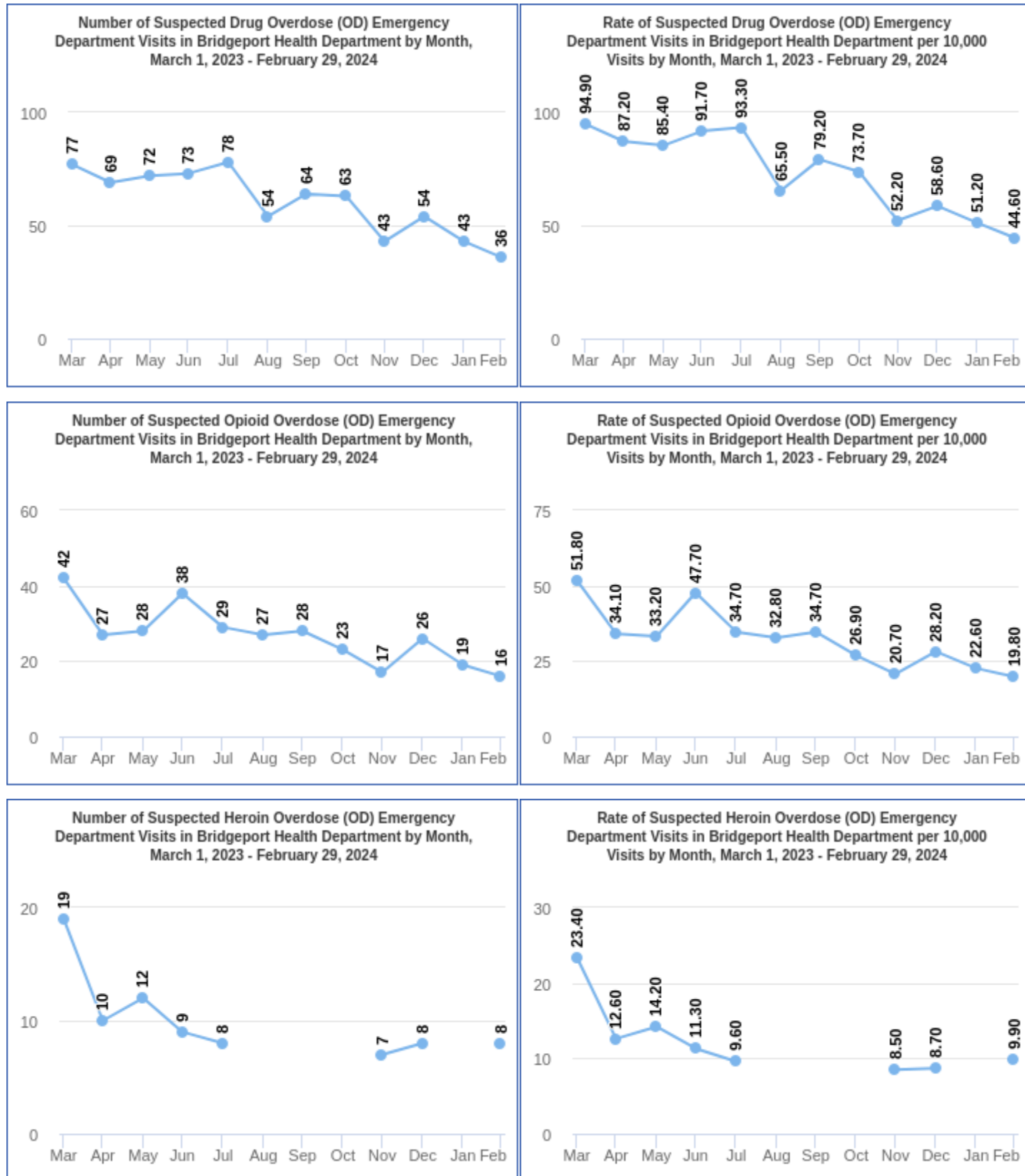

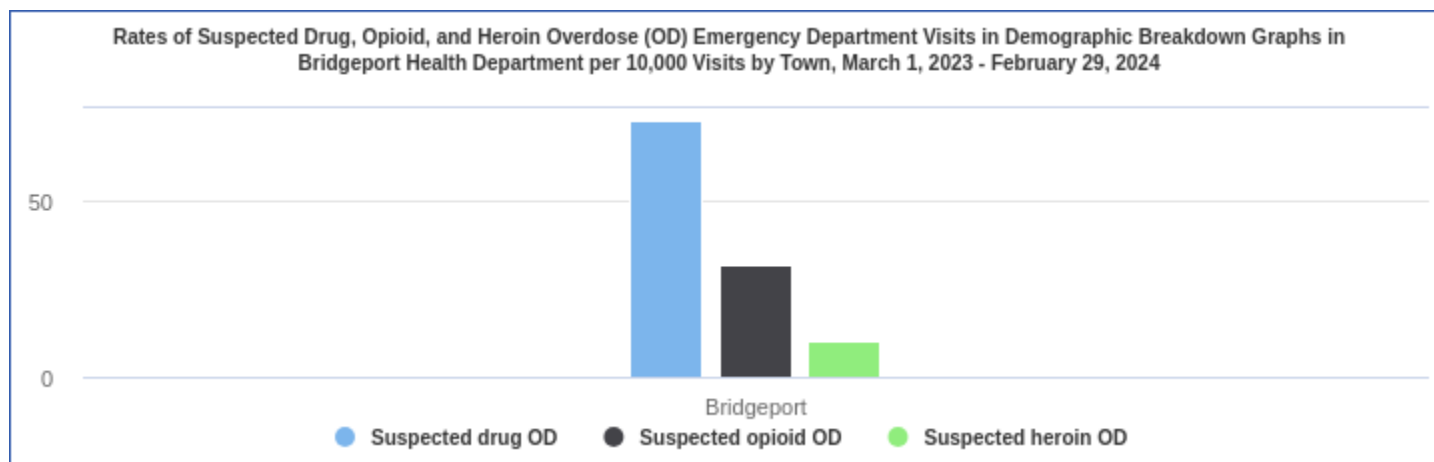

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Bridgeport Health Department



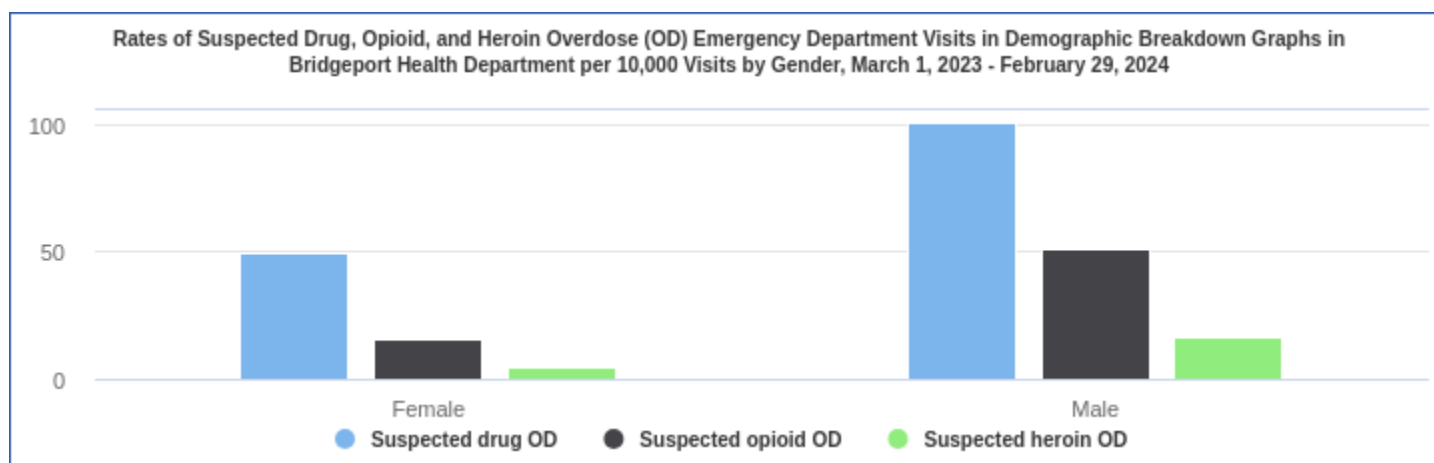

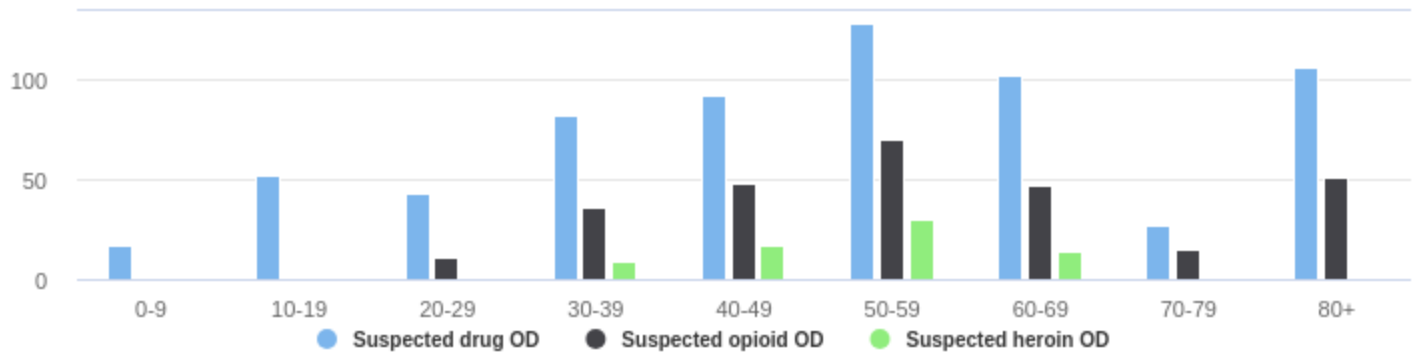

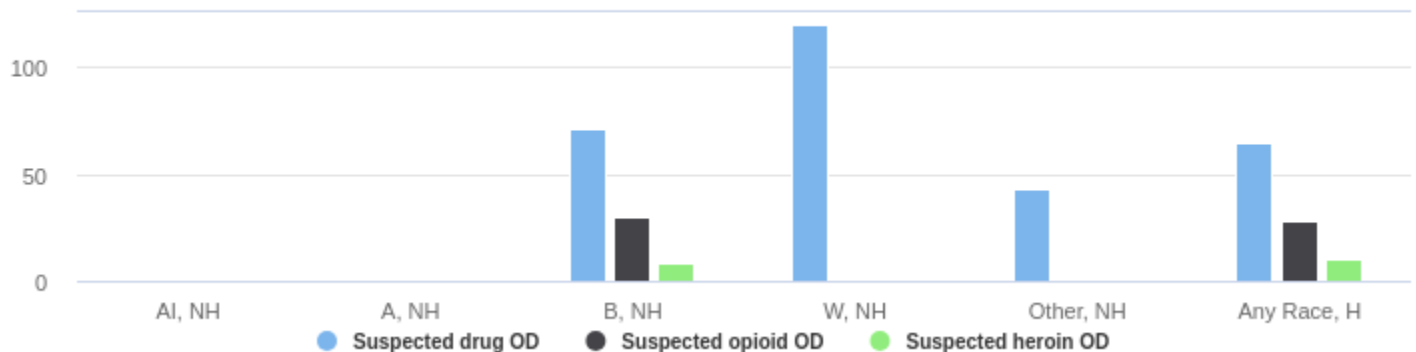

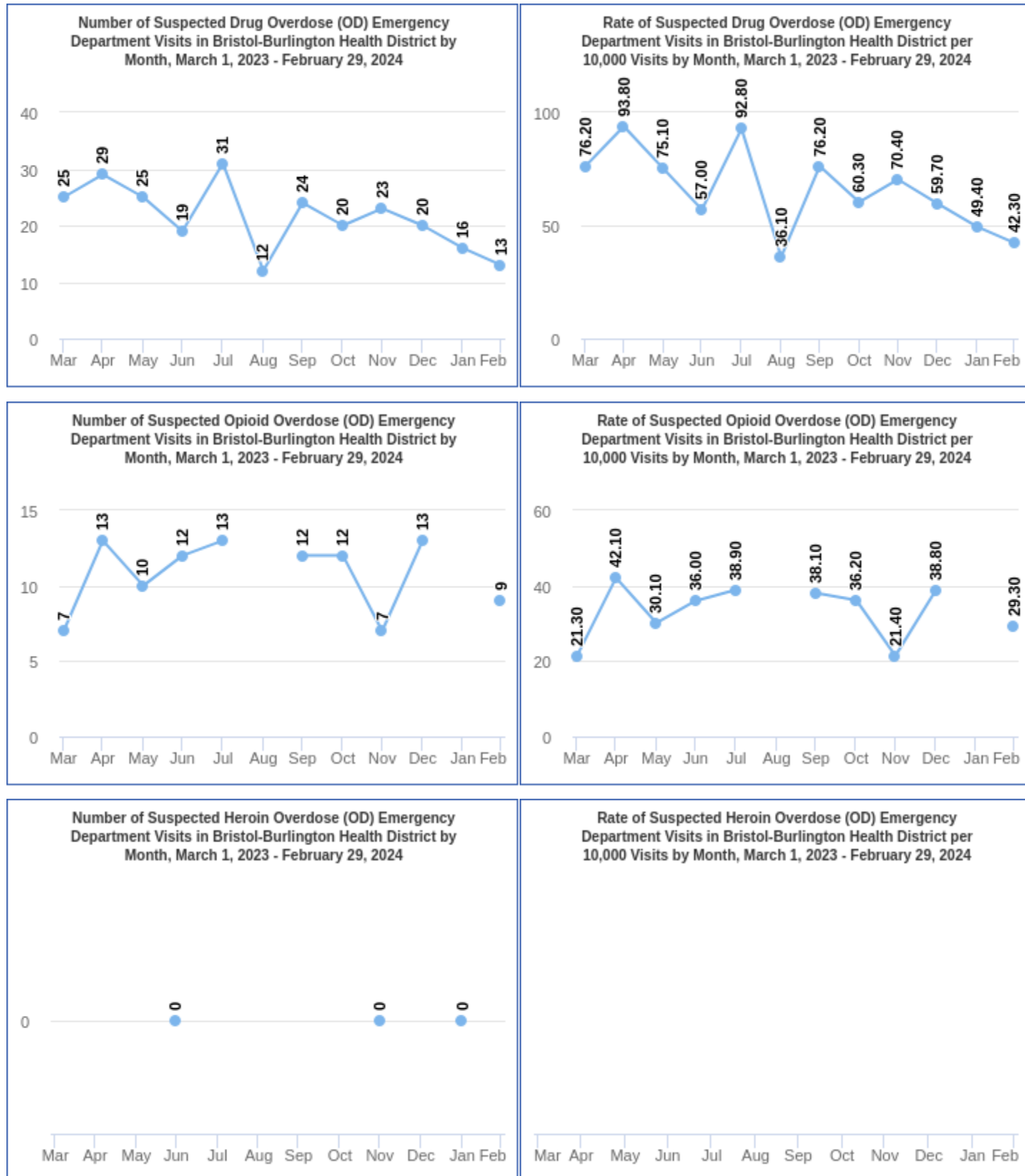

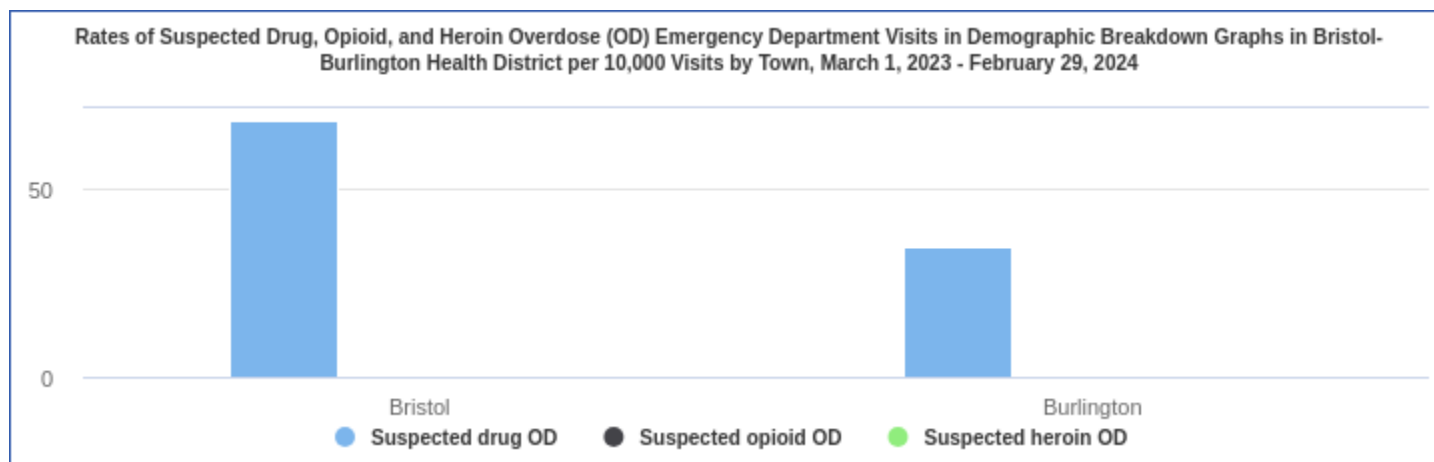

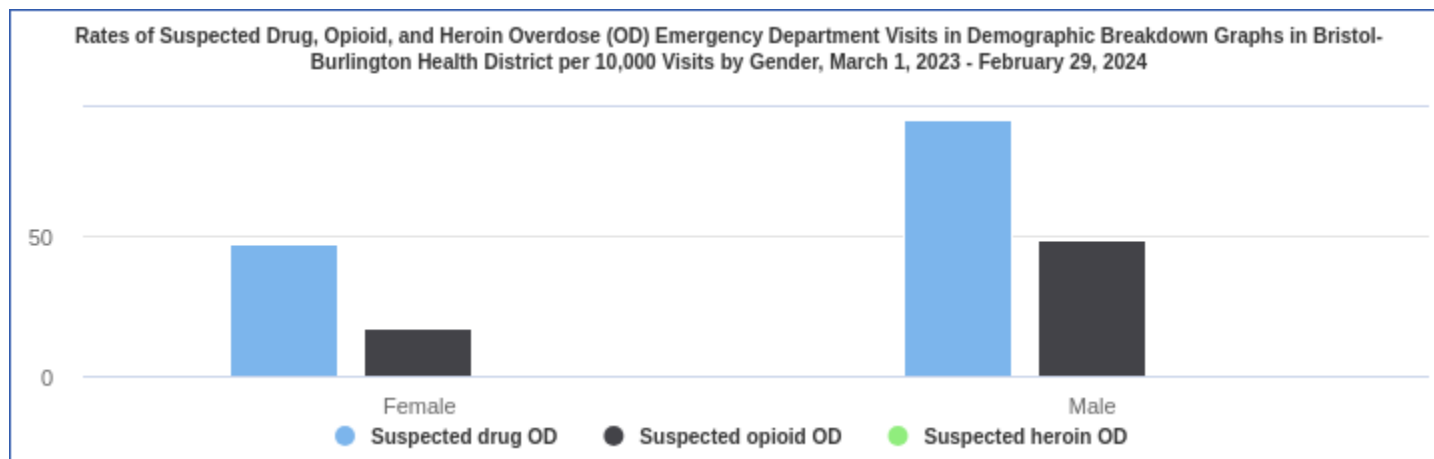

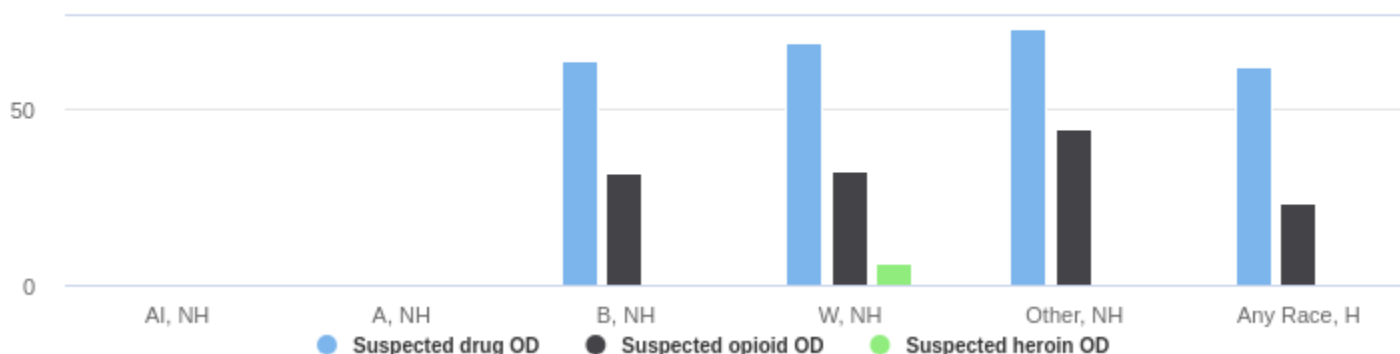

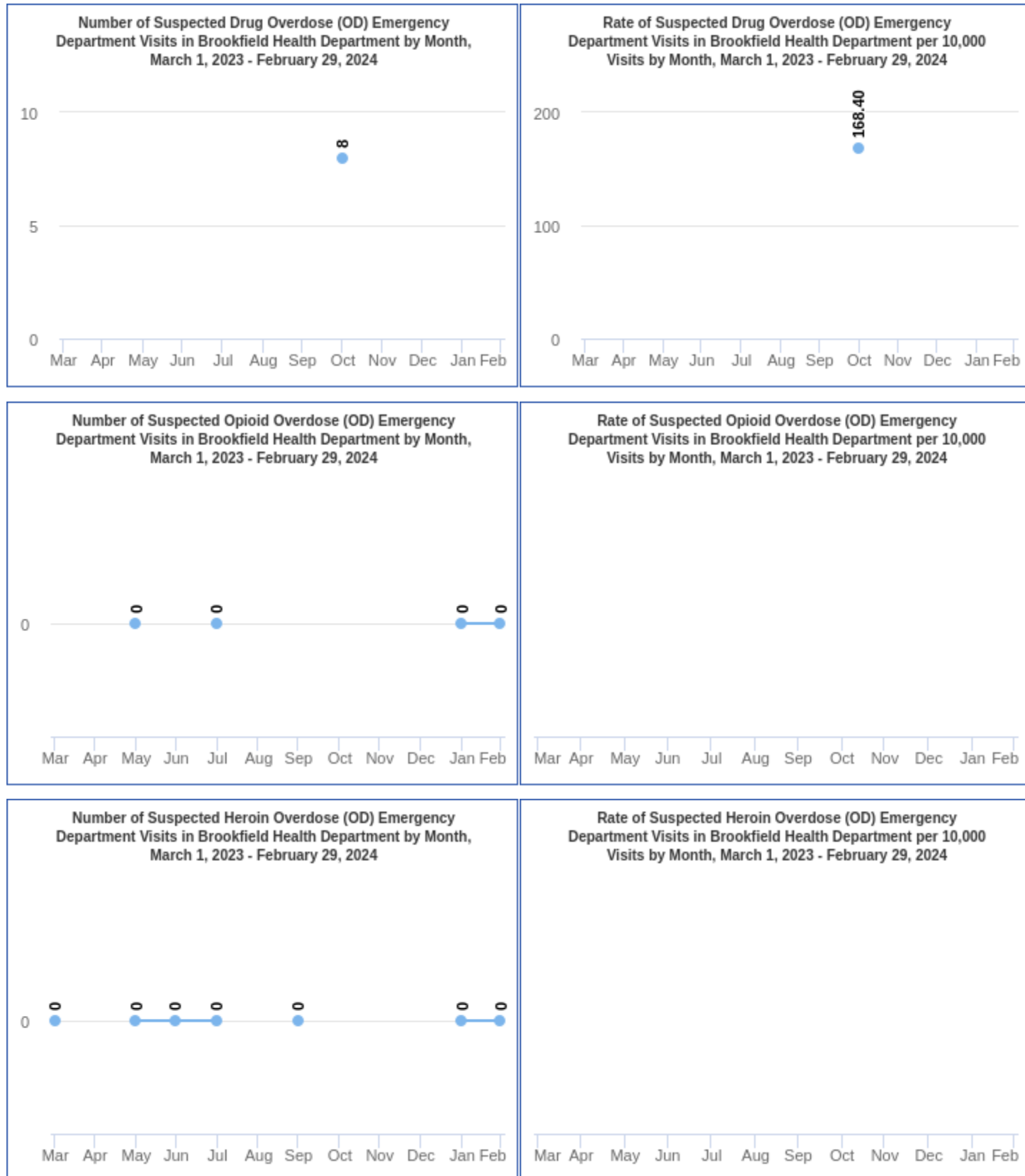

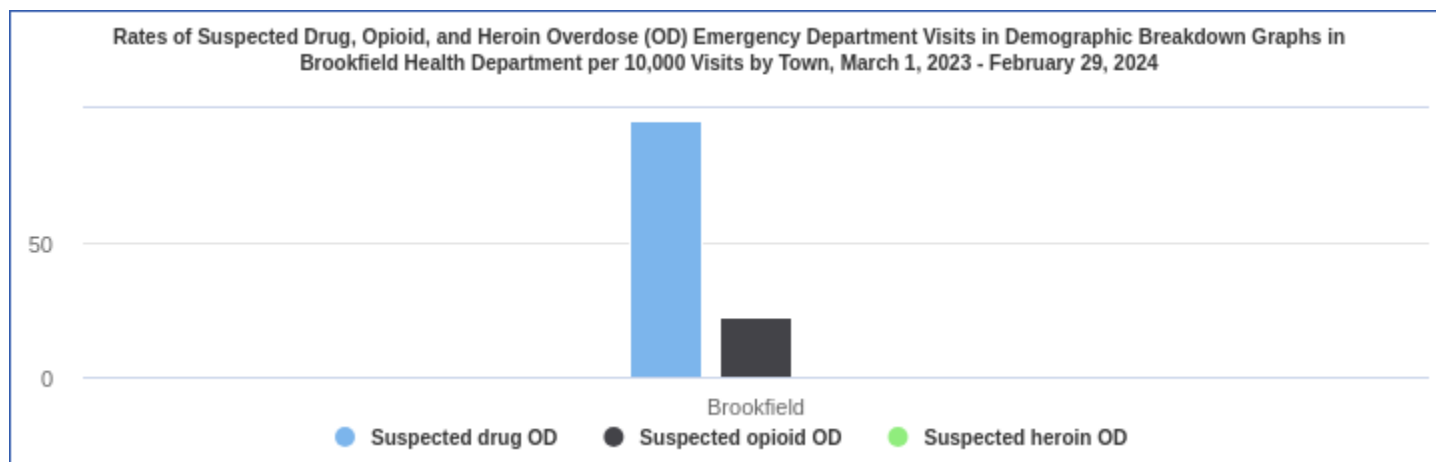

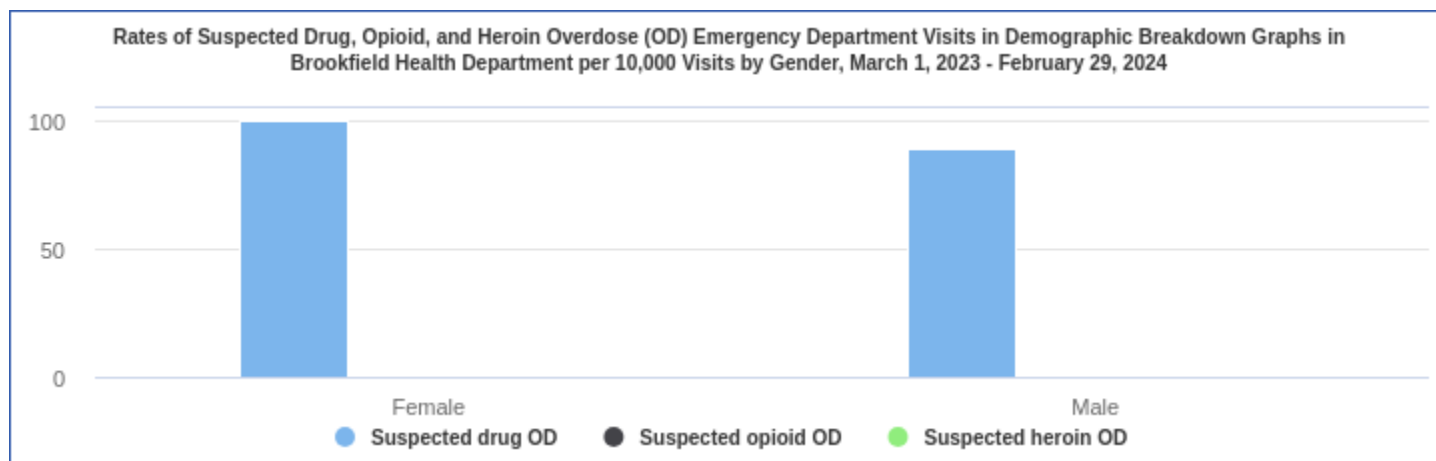

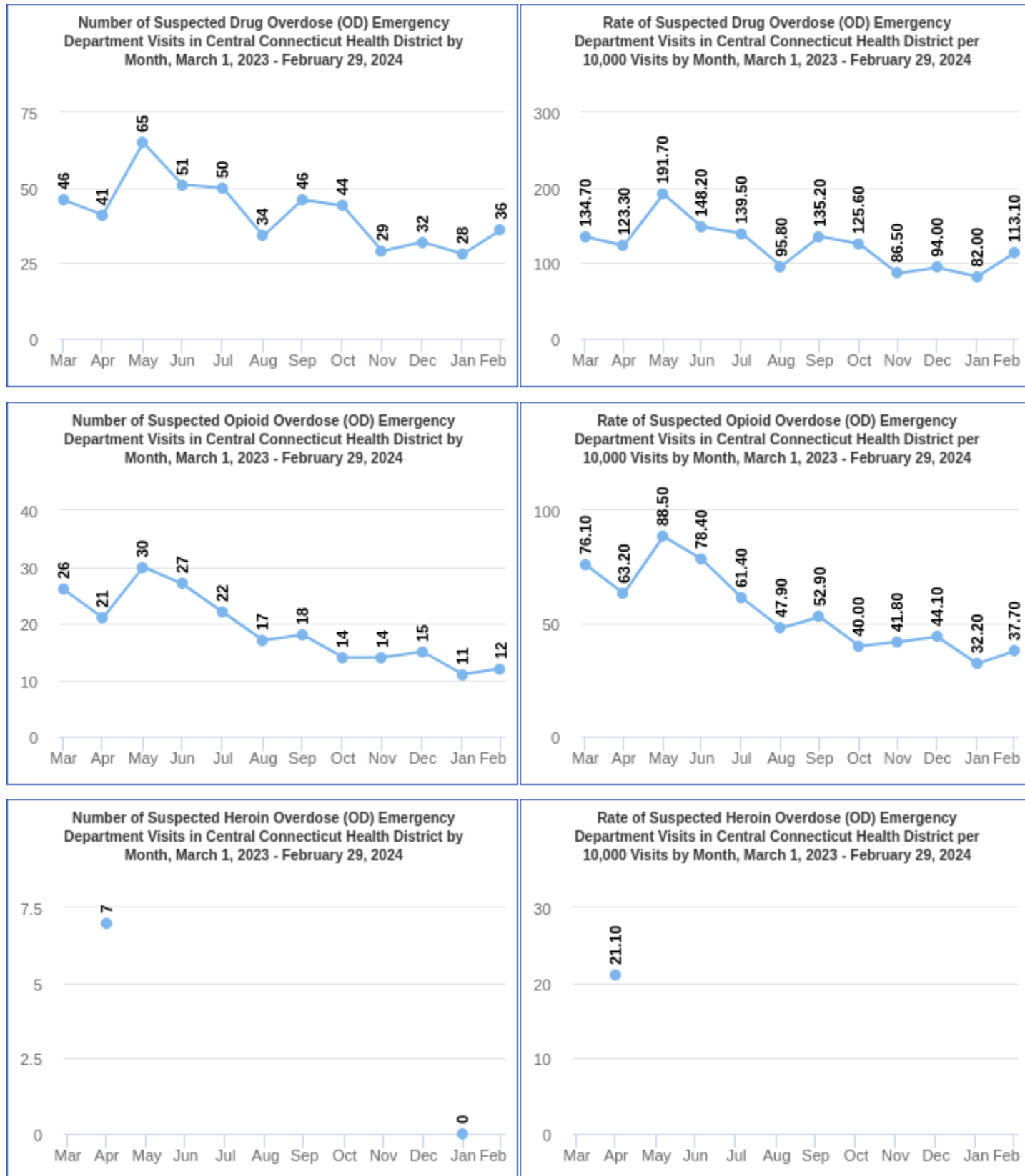

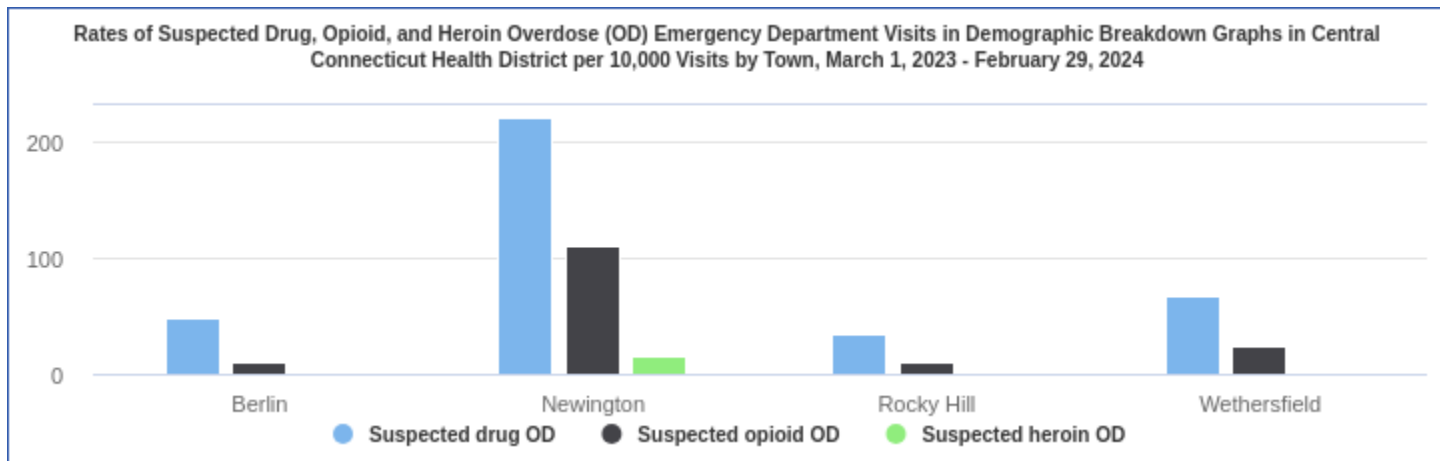

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Central Connecticut Health District



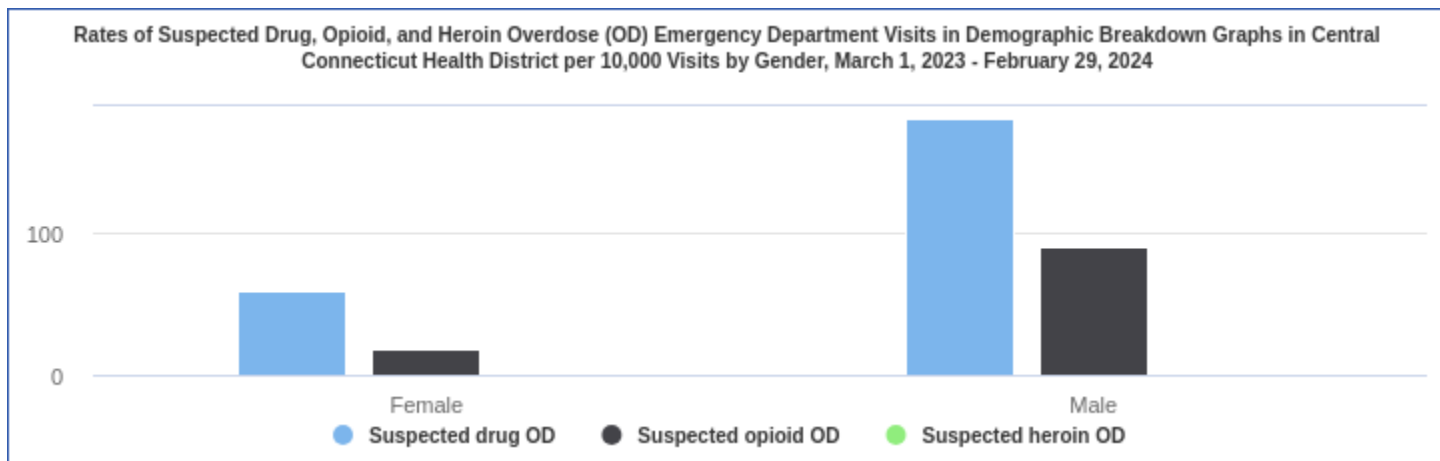

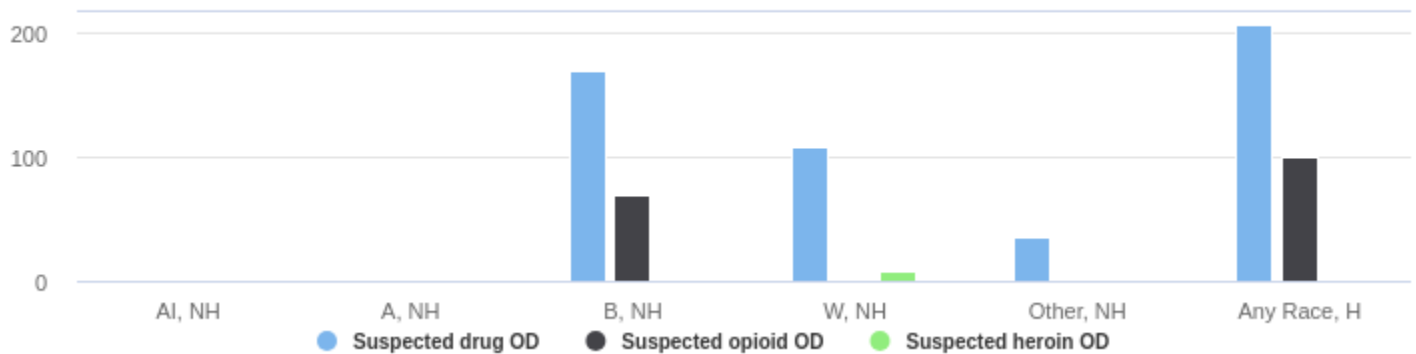

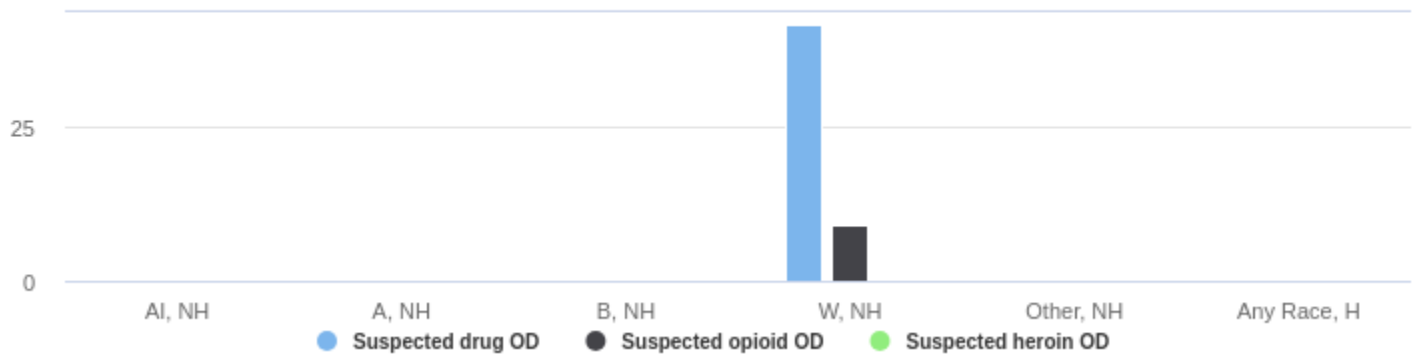

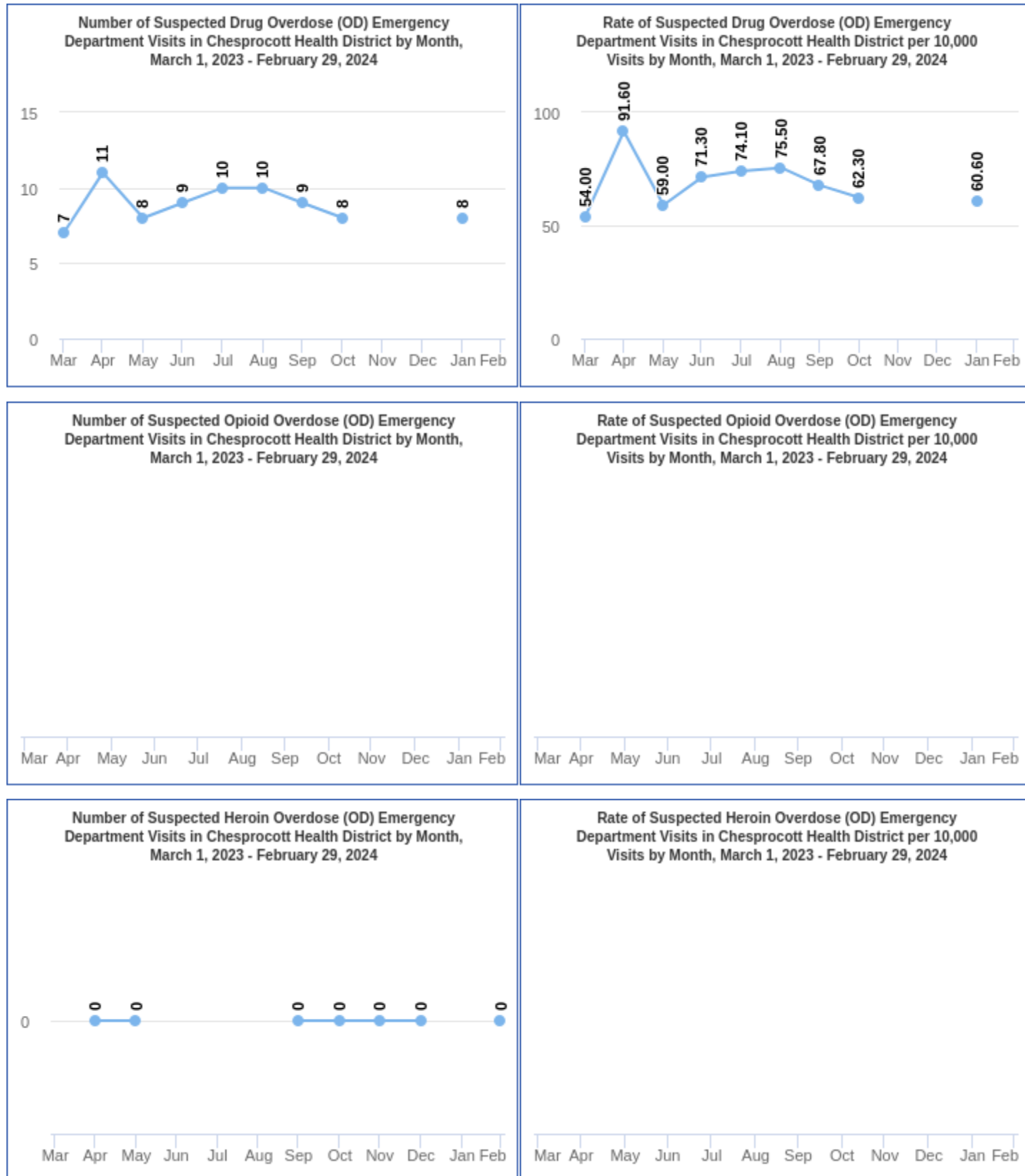

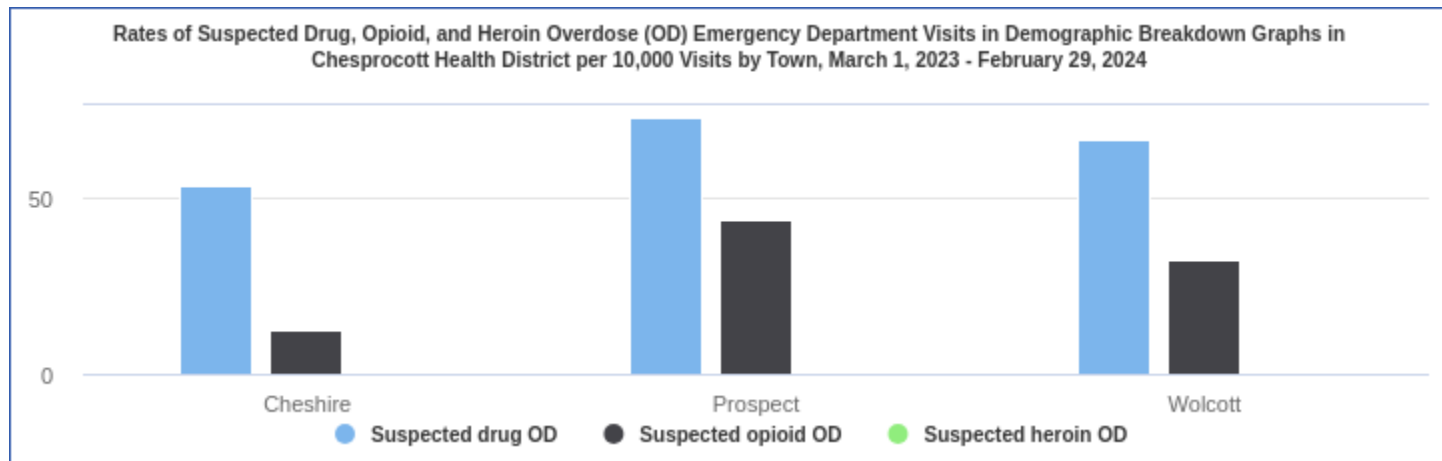

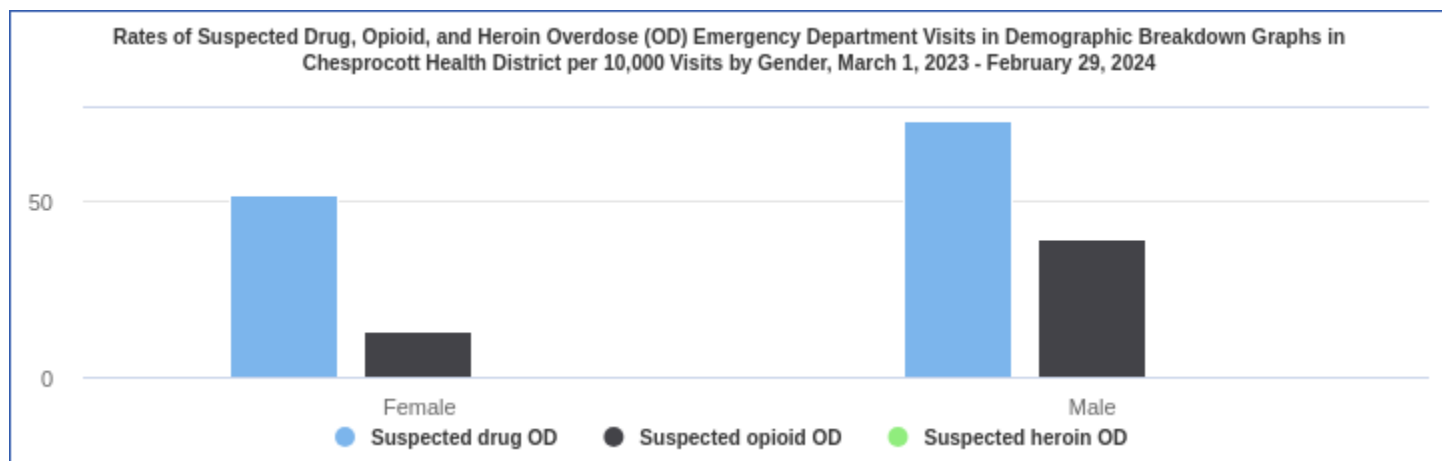

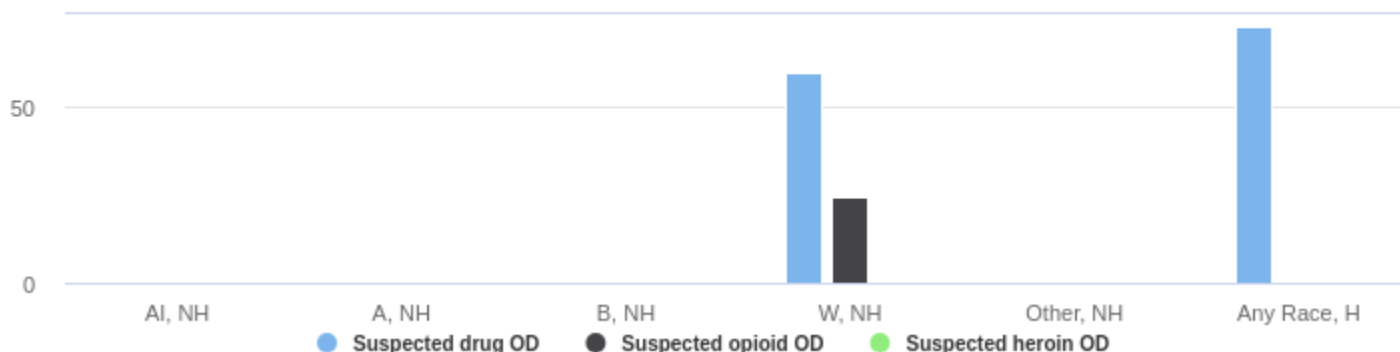

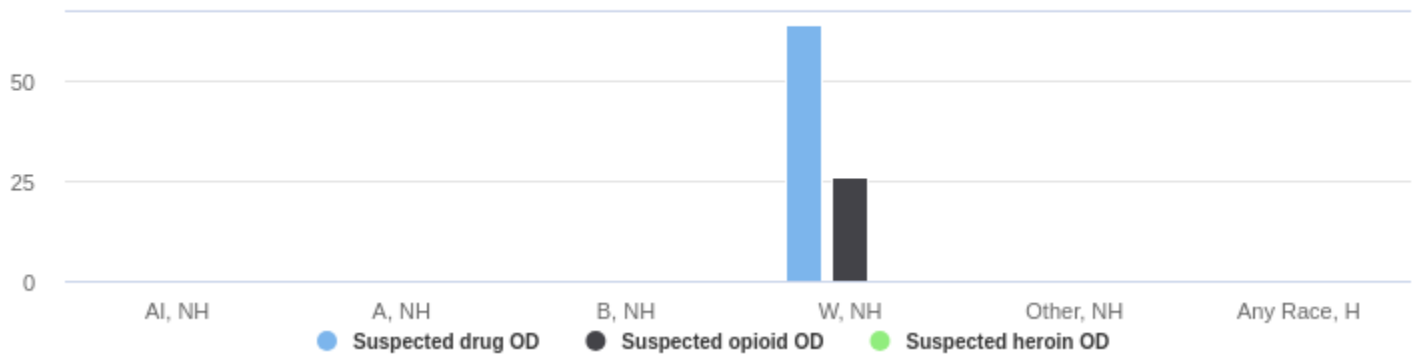

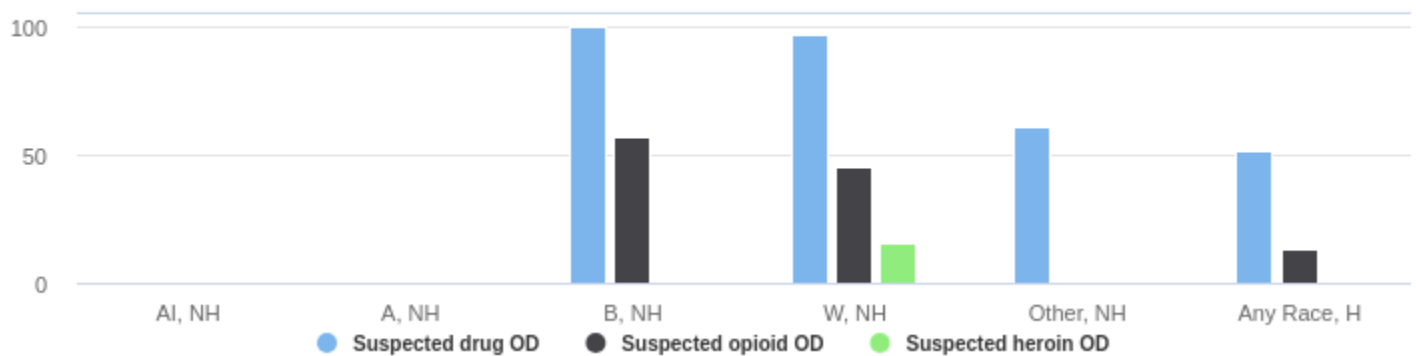

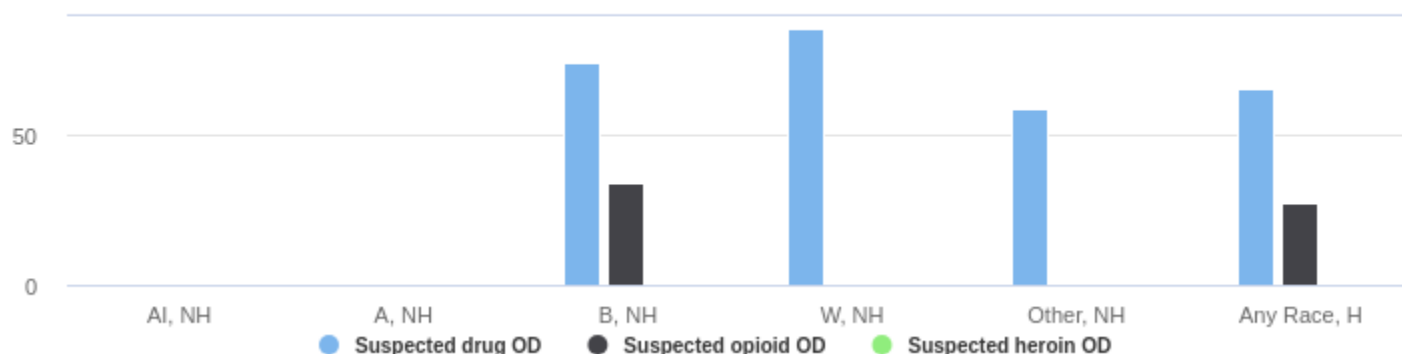

## Suspected Drug Overdose in East Shore Health District



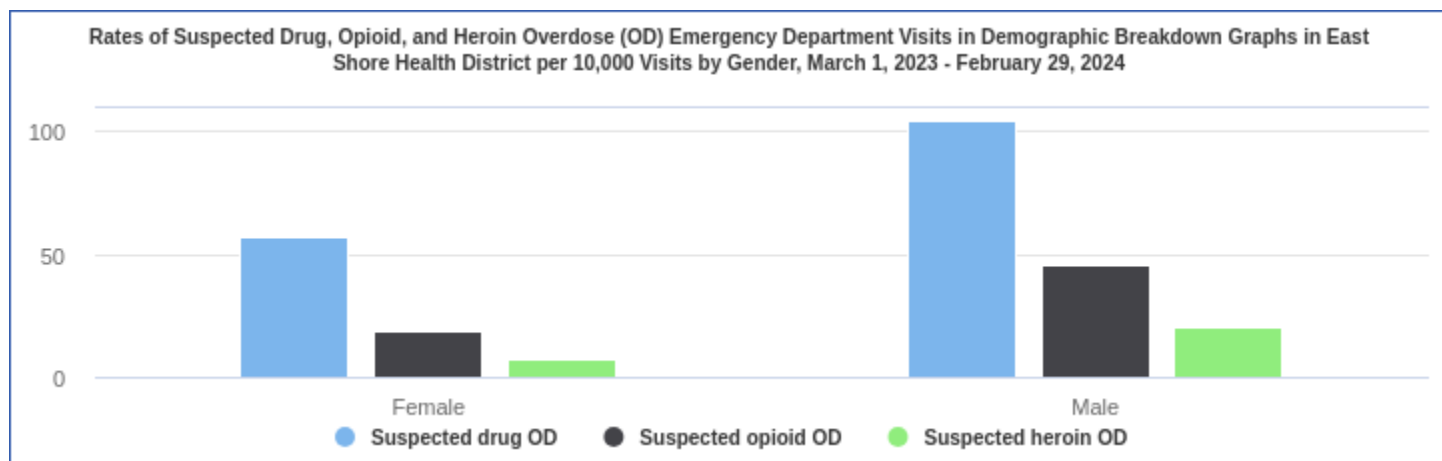

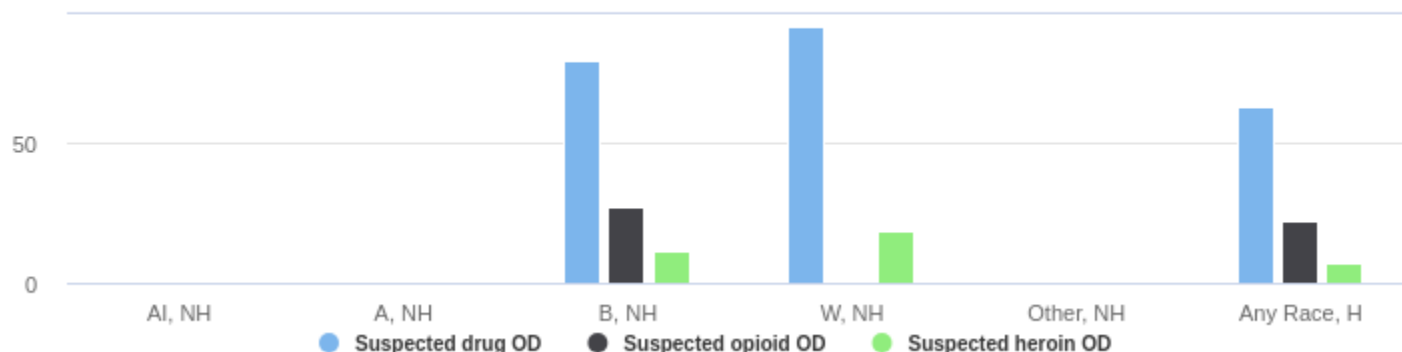

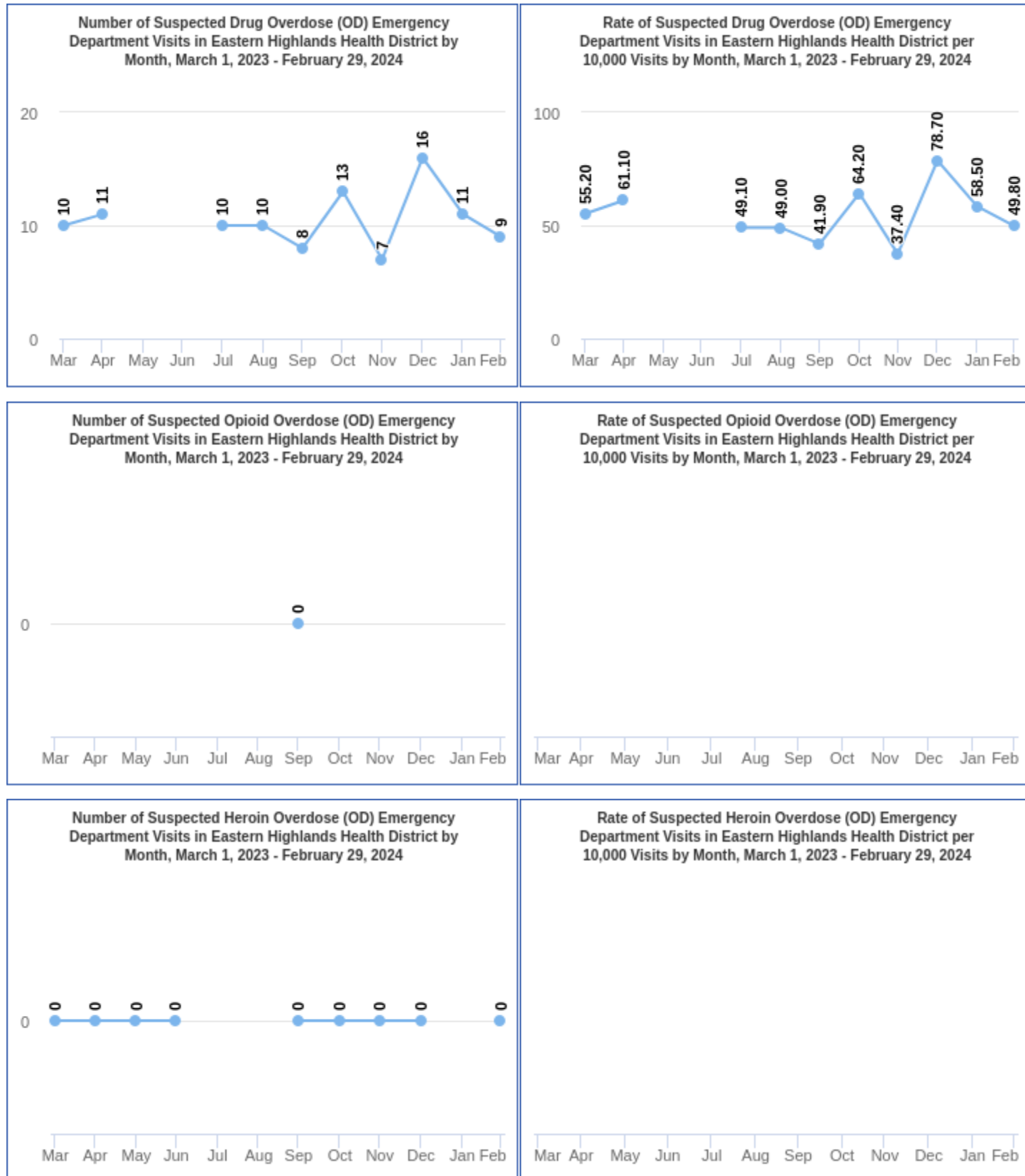

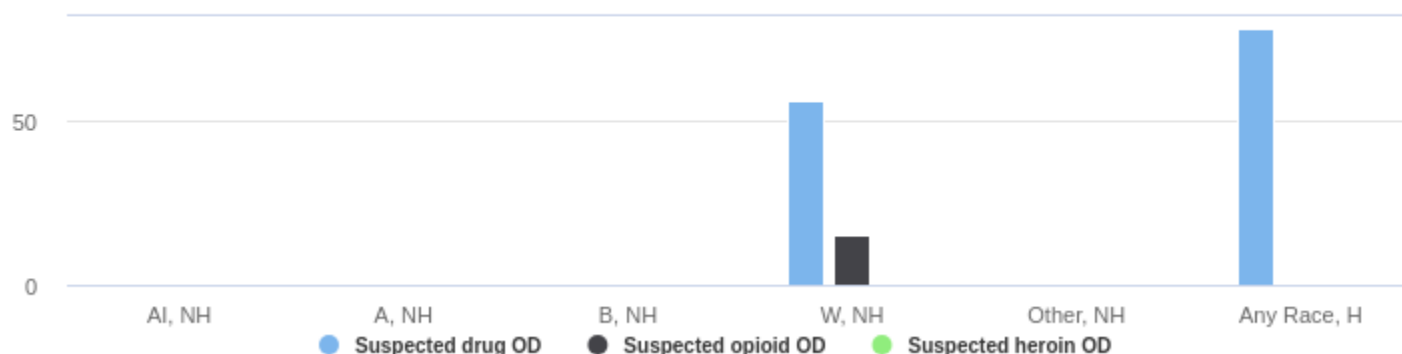

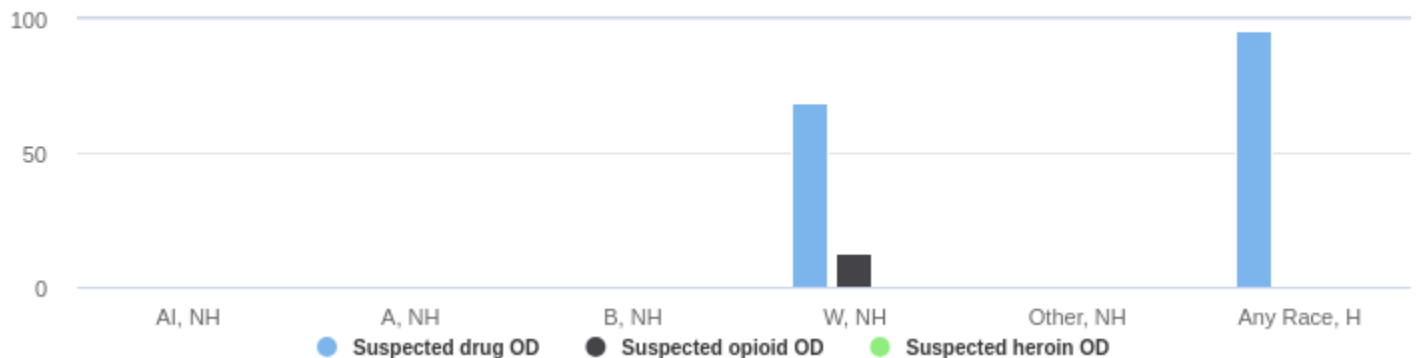

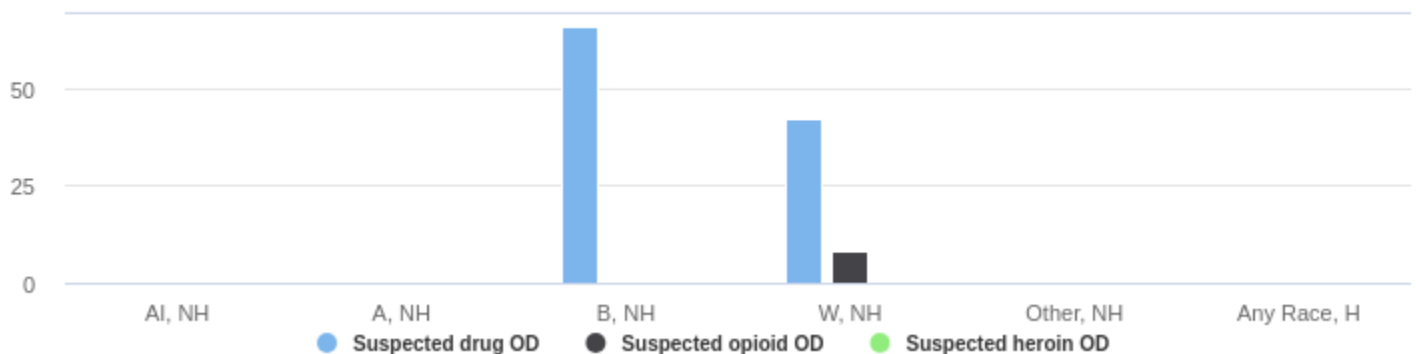

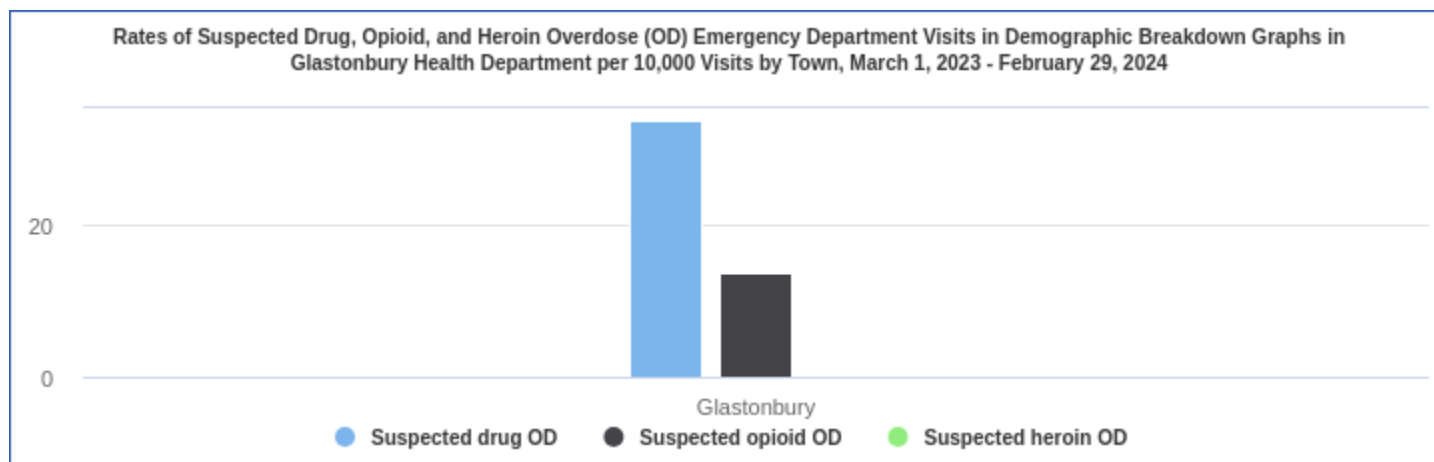

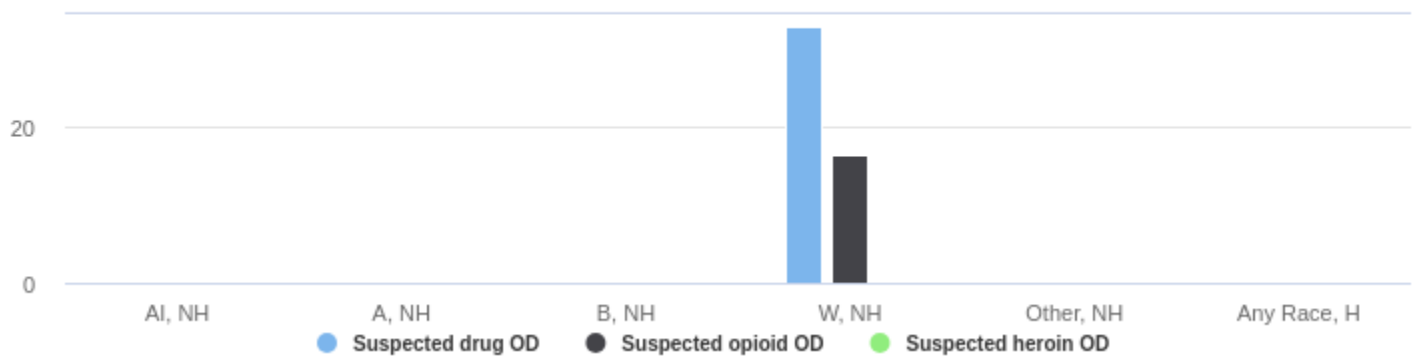

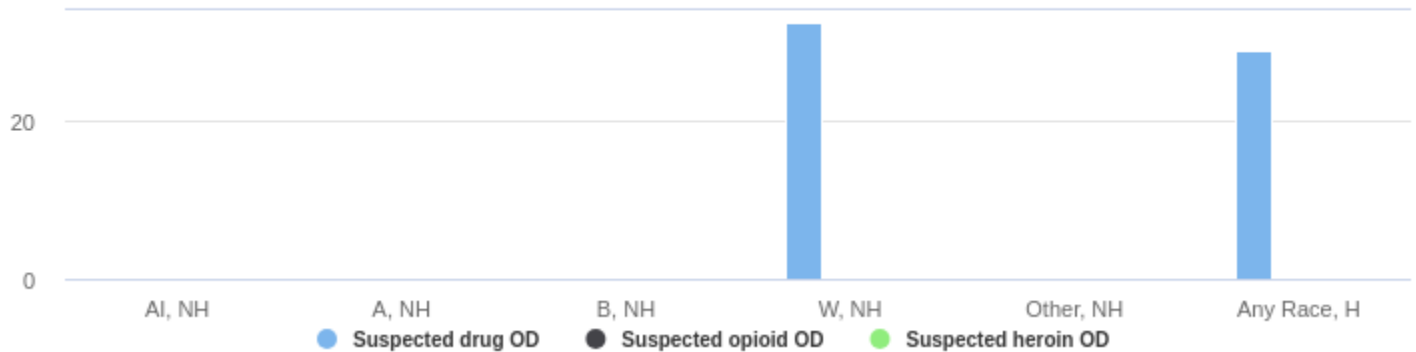

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Guilford Health Department



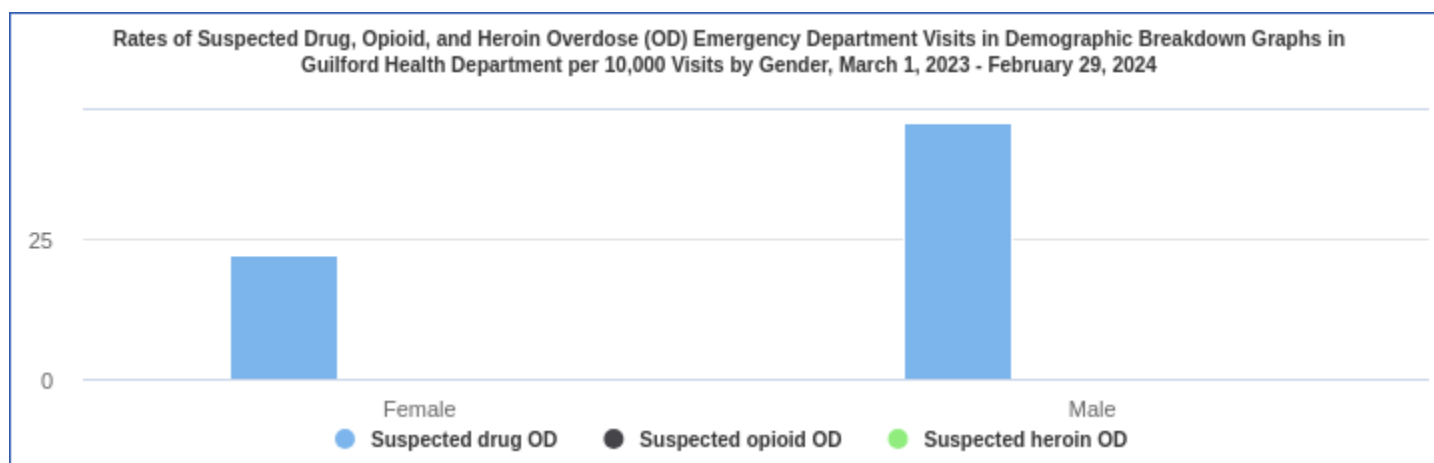

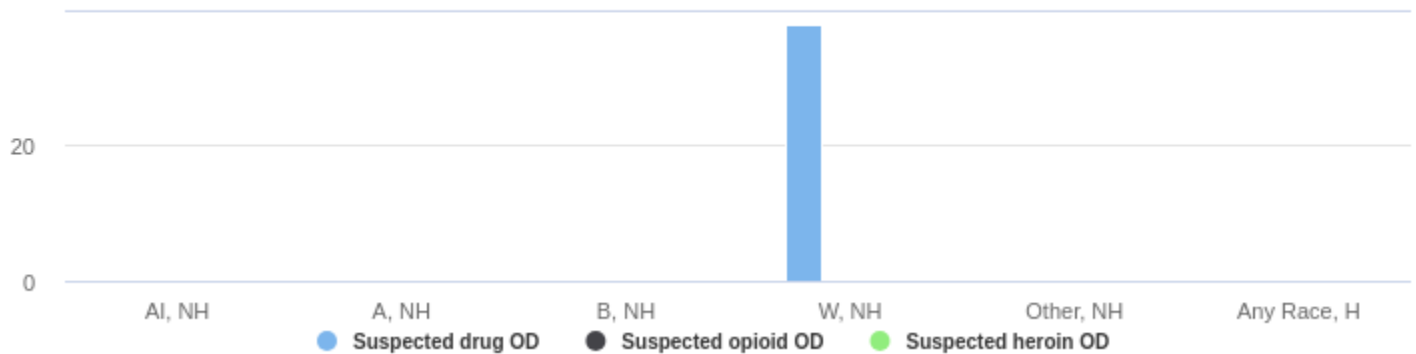

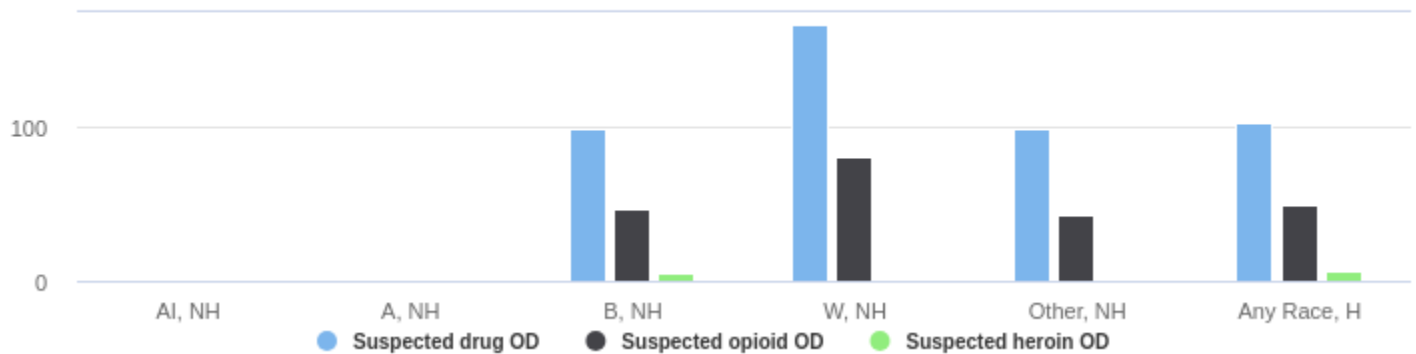

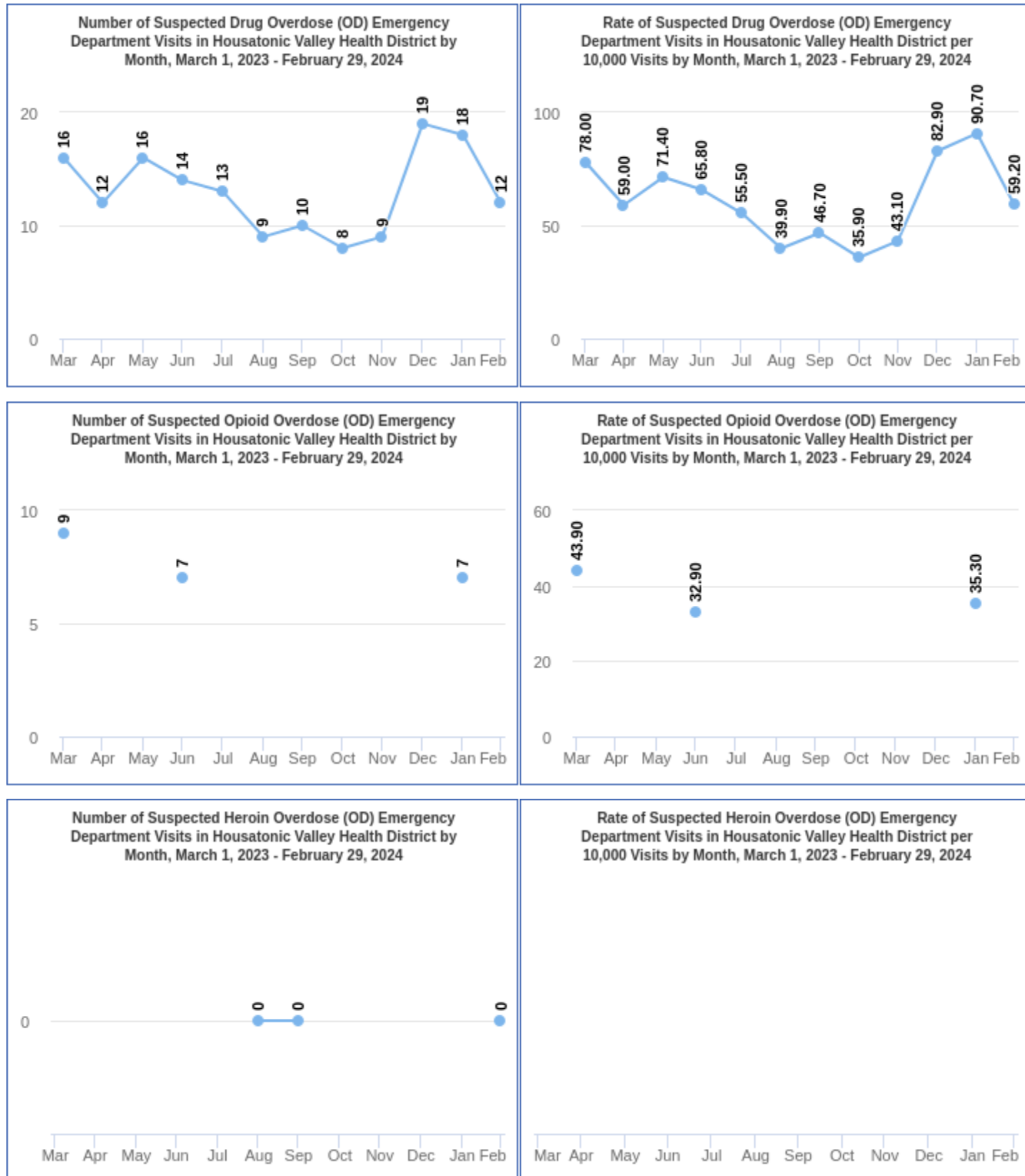

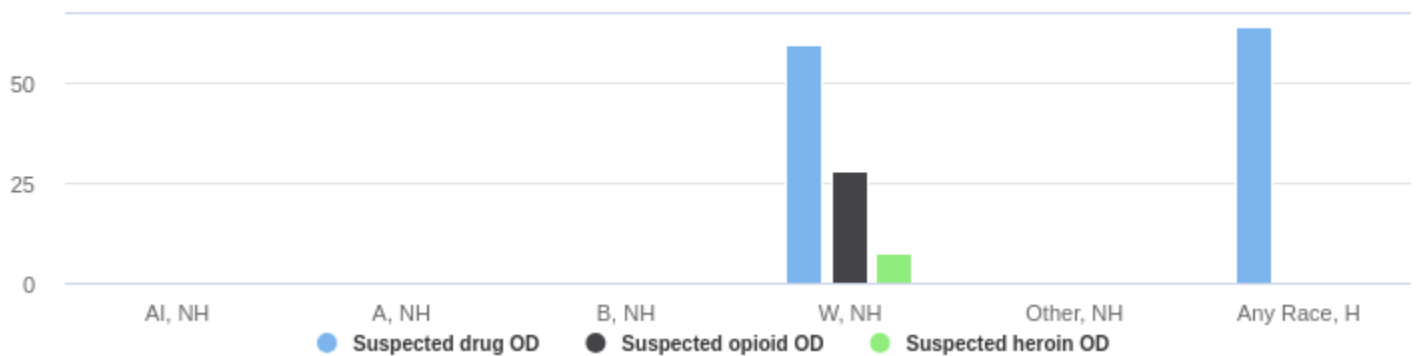

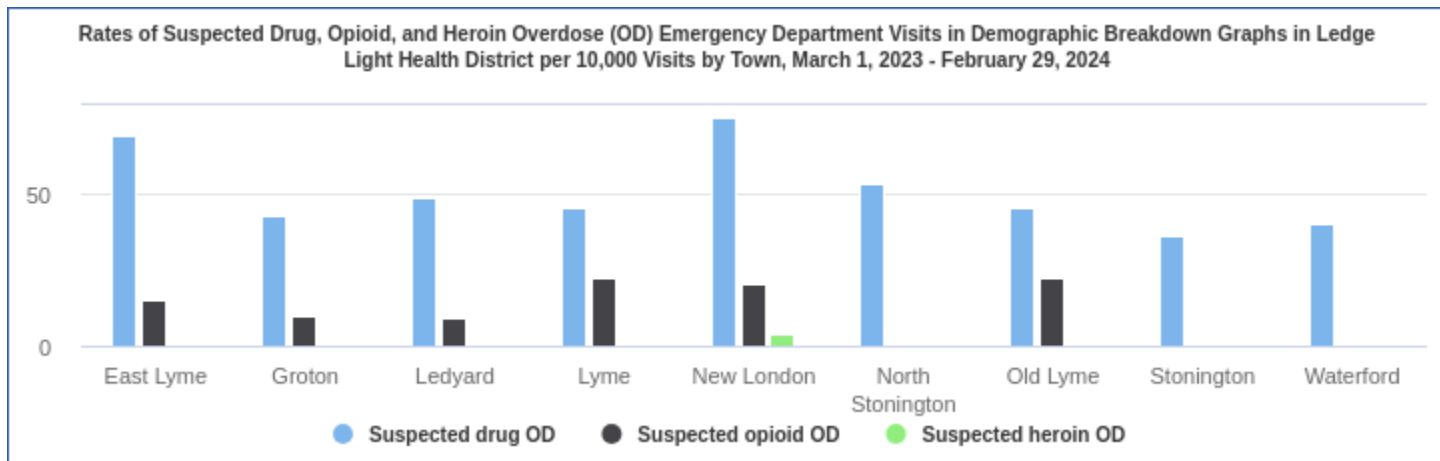

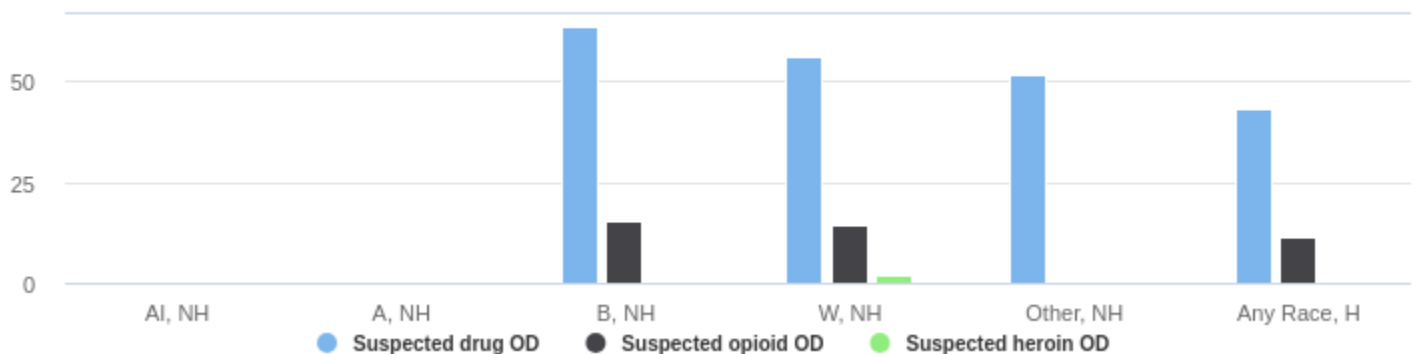

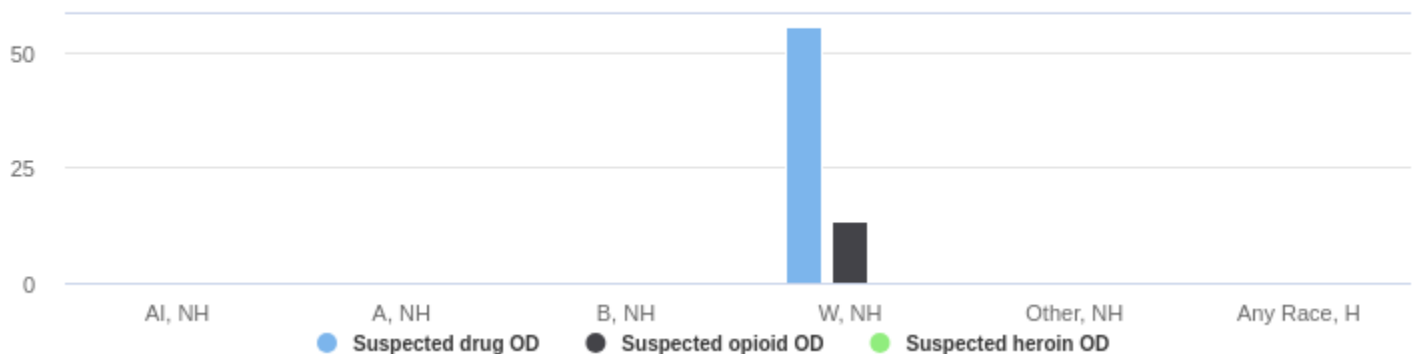

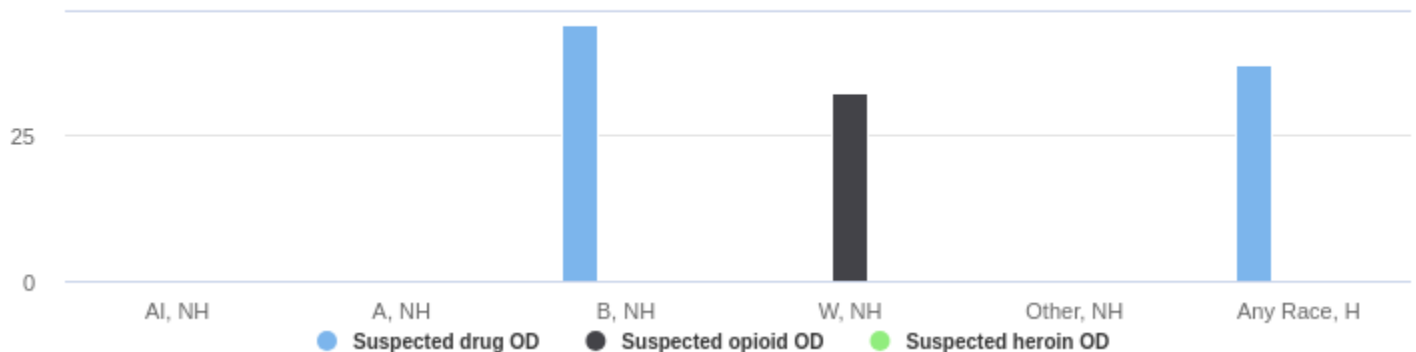

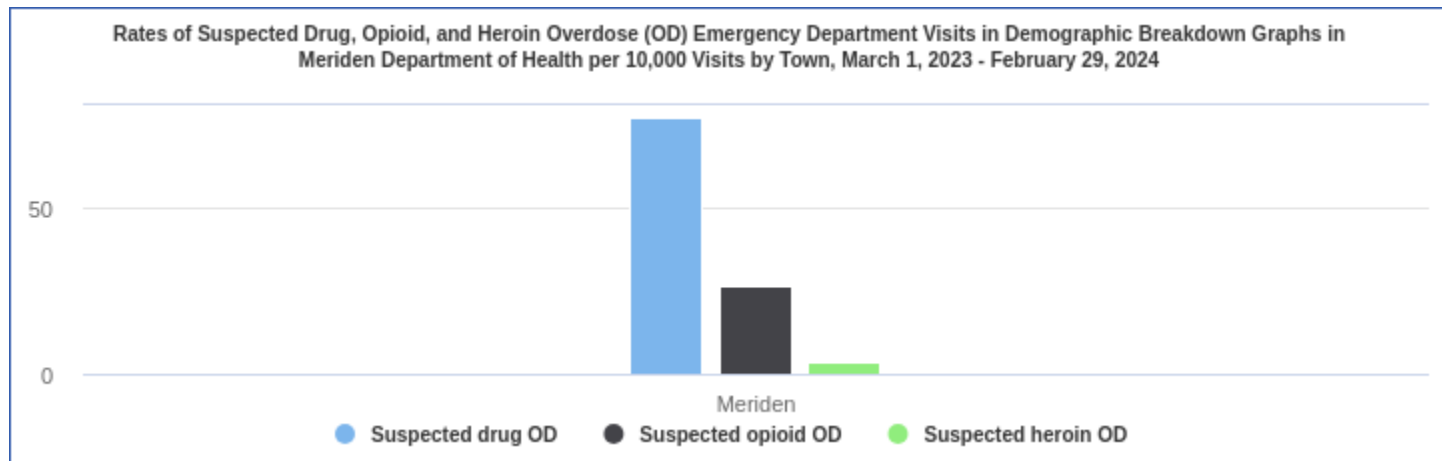
## Suspected Drug Overdose in Meriden Department of Health

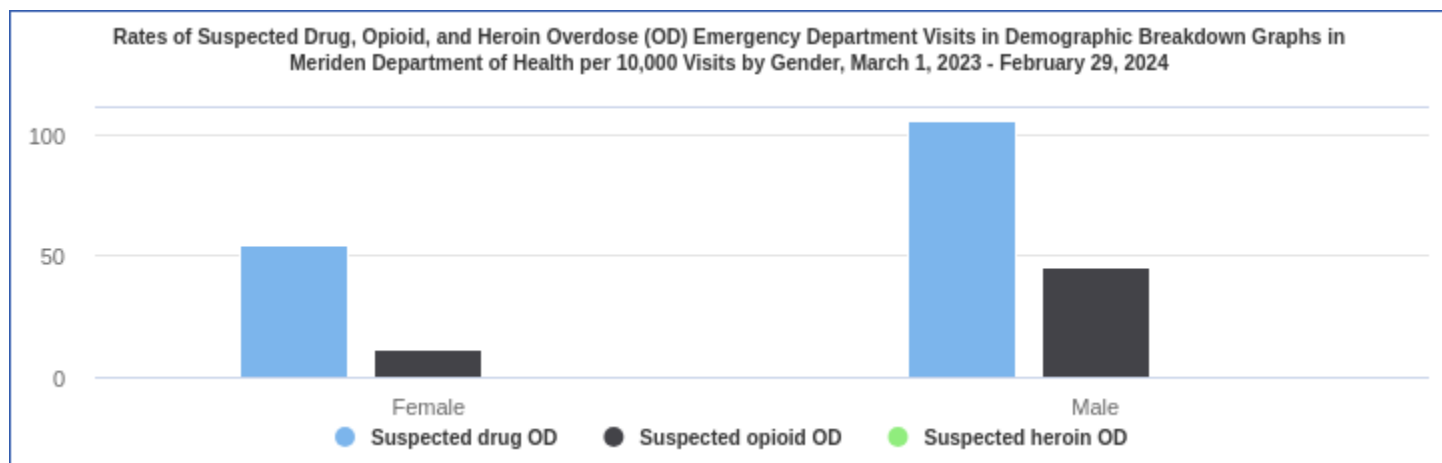

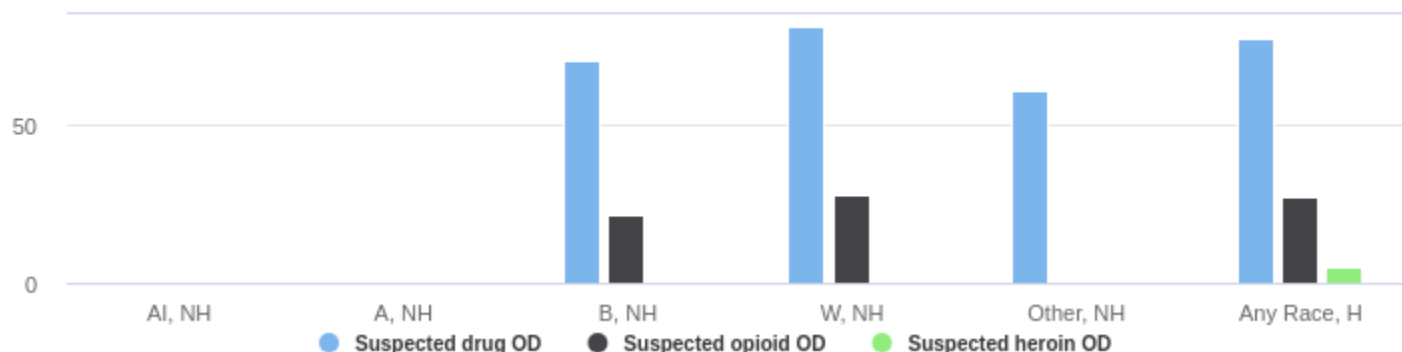

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Middletown Health Department



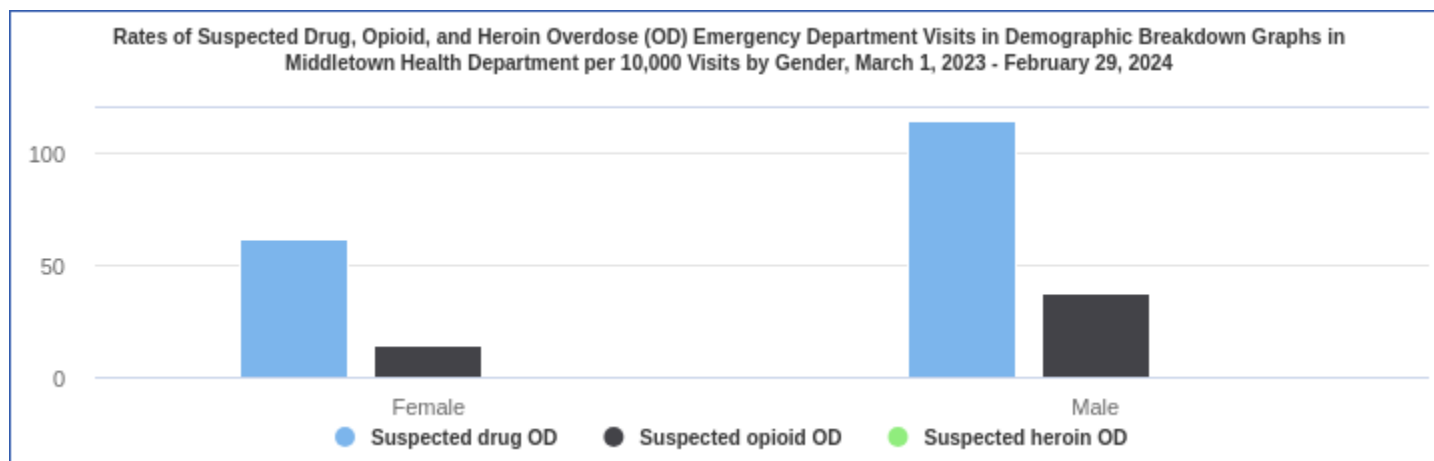

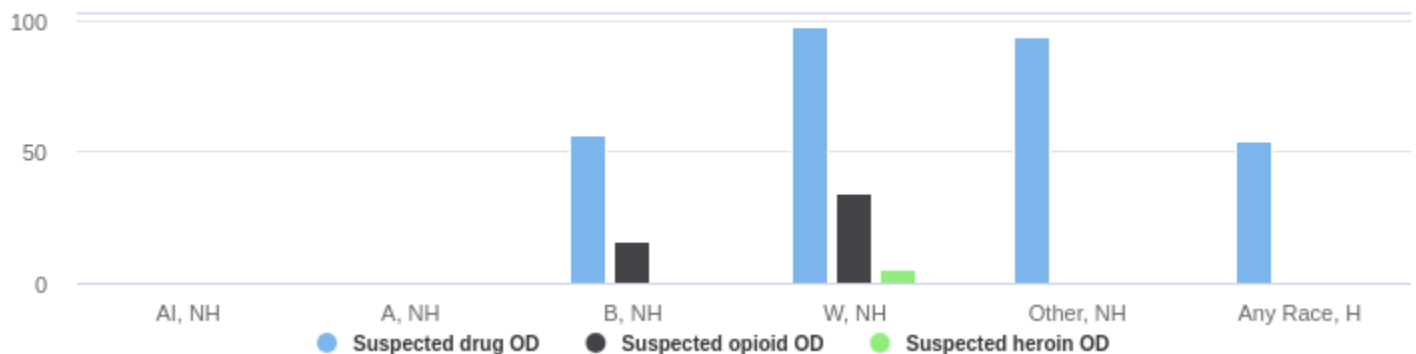

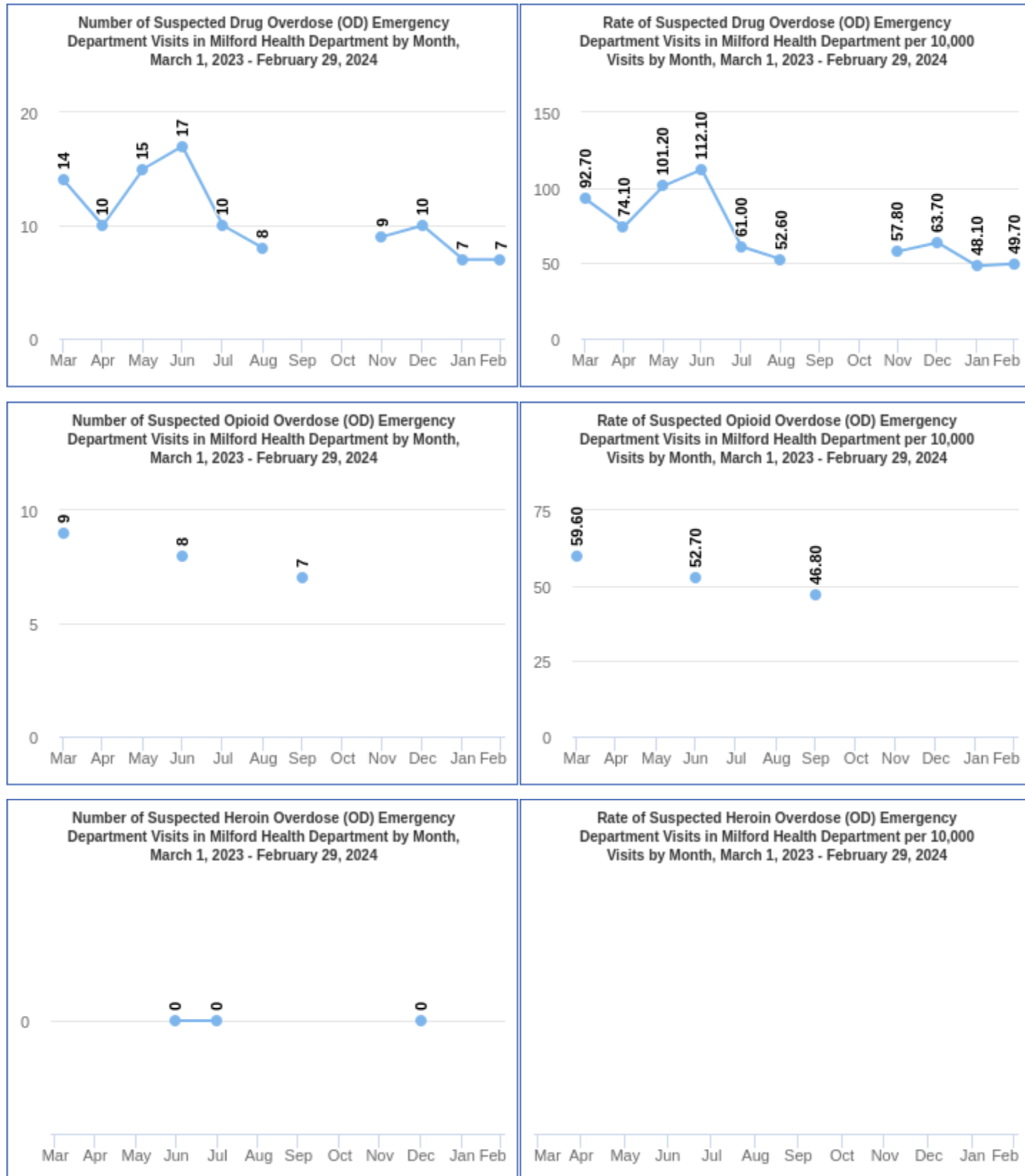

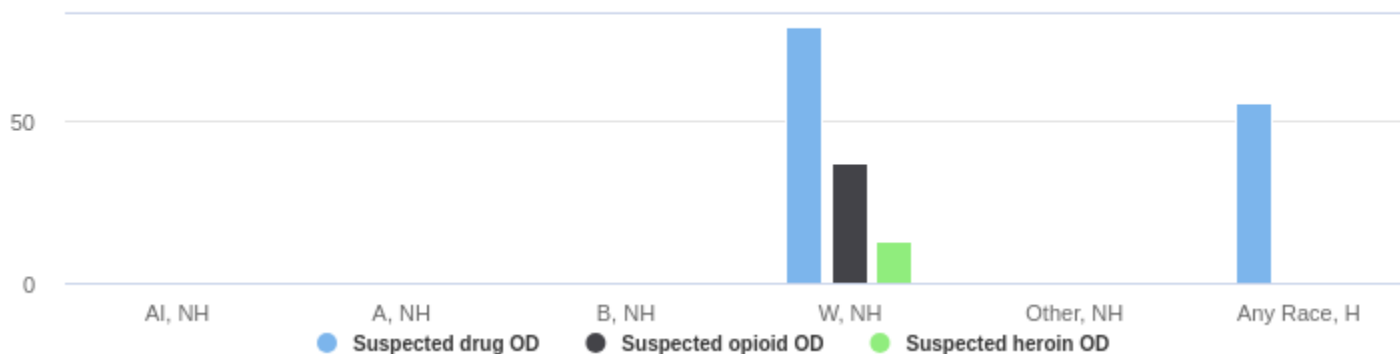

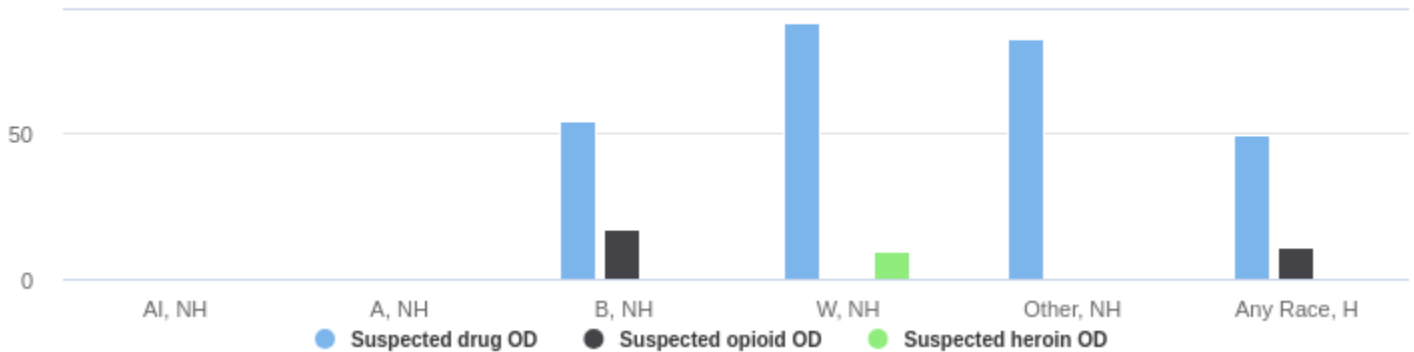

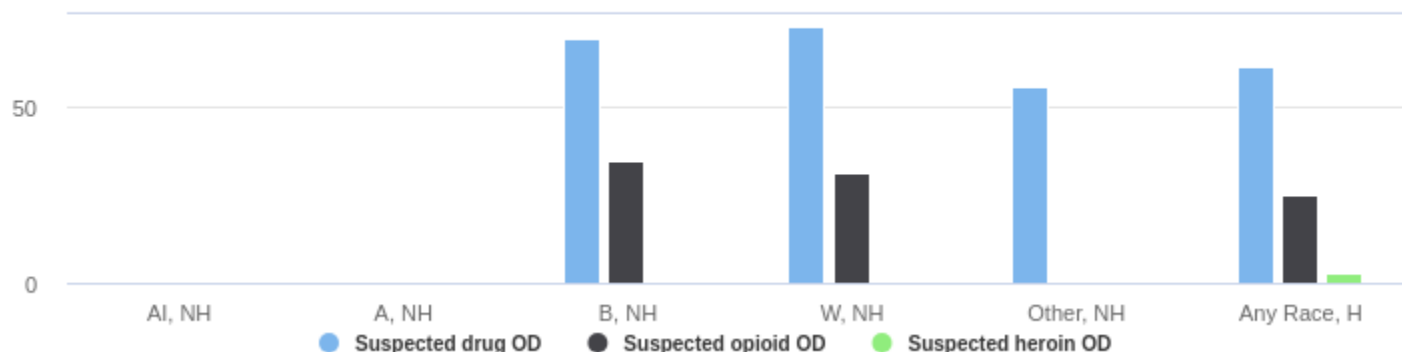

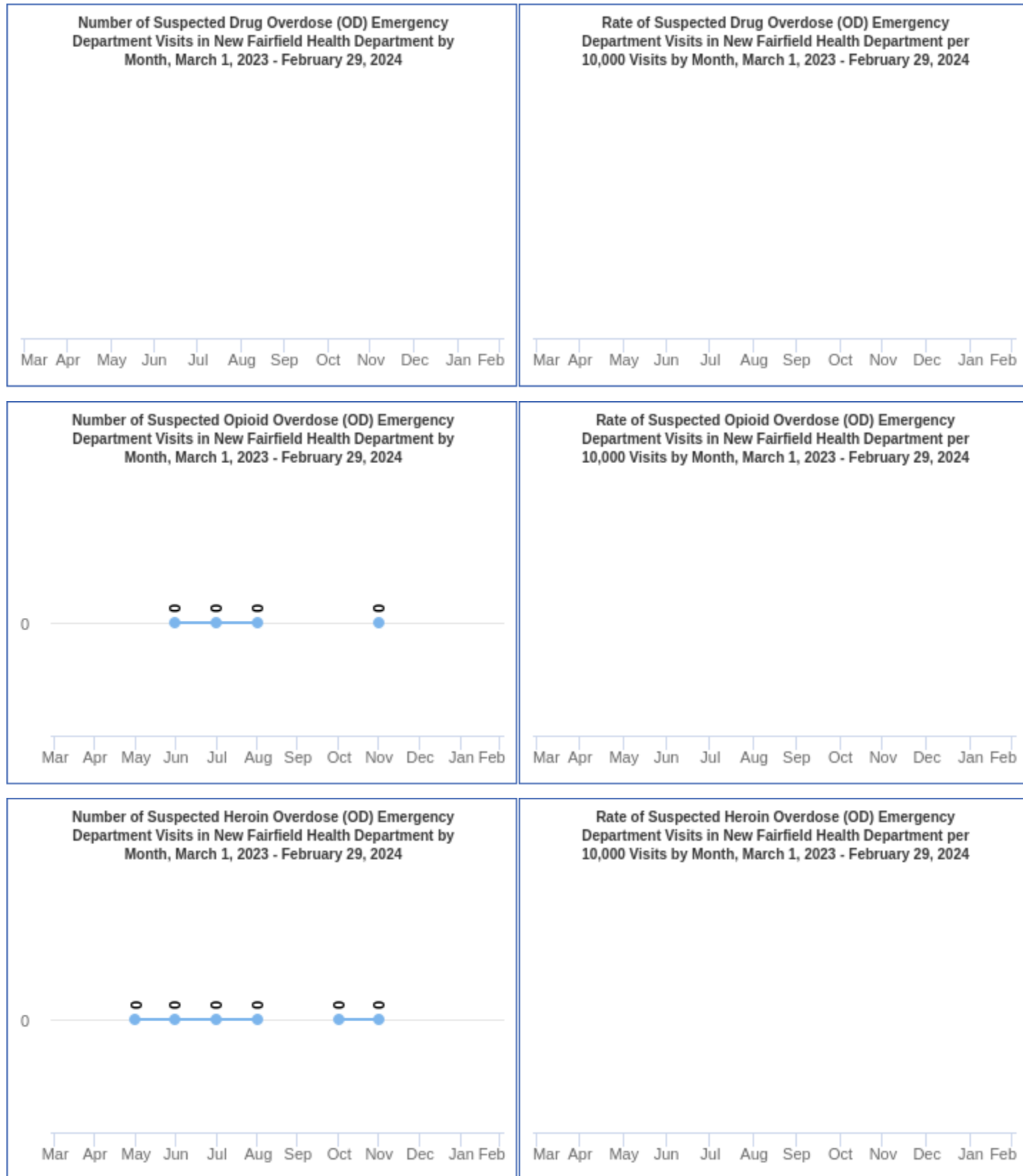

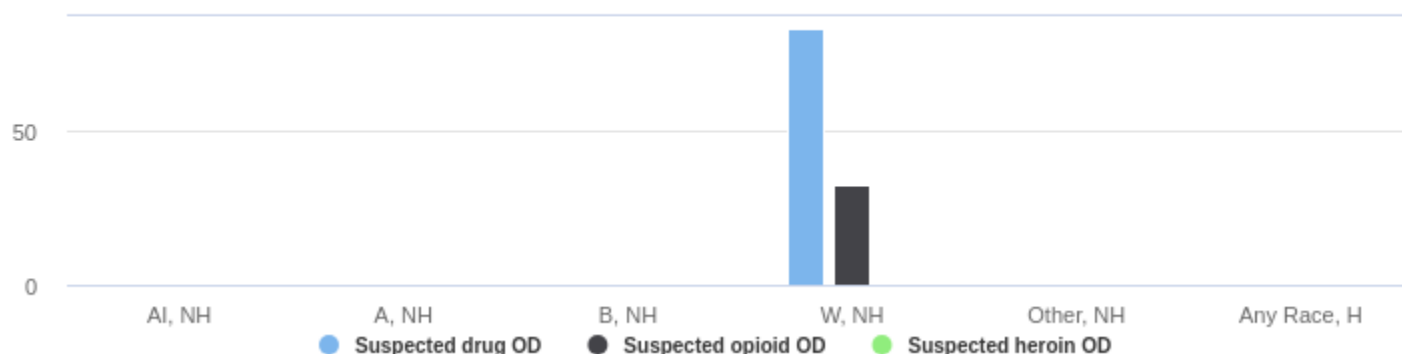

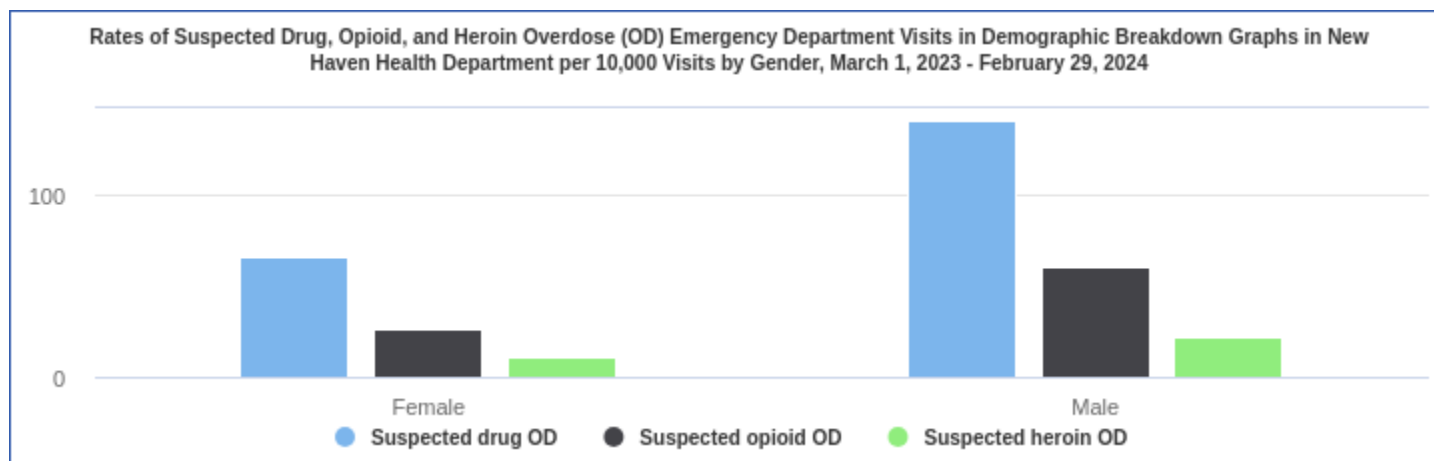

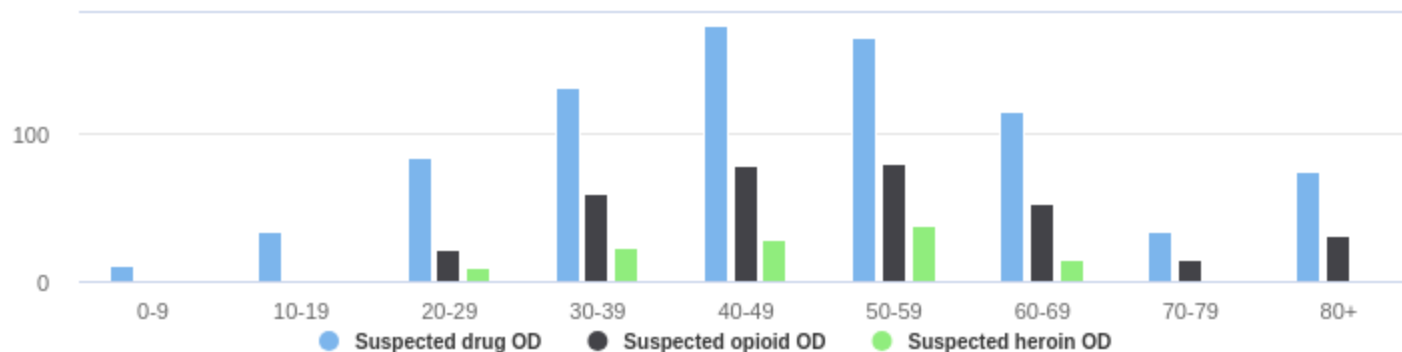

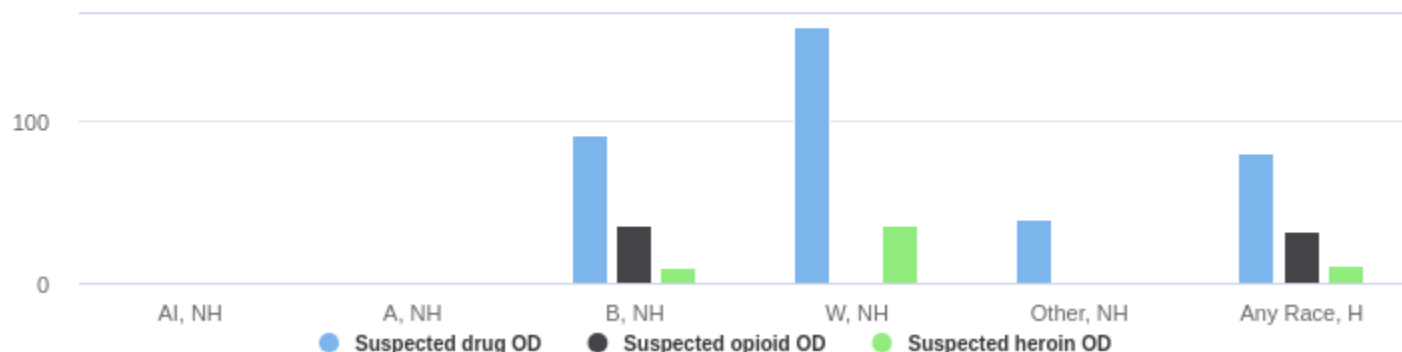

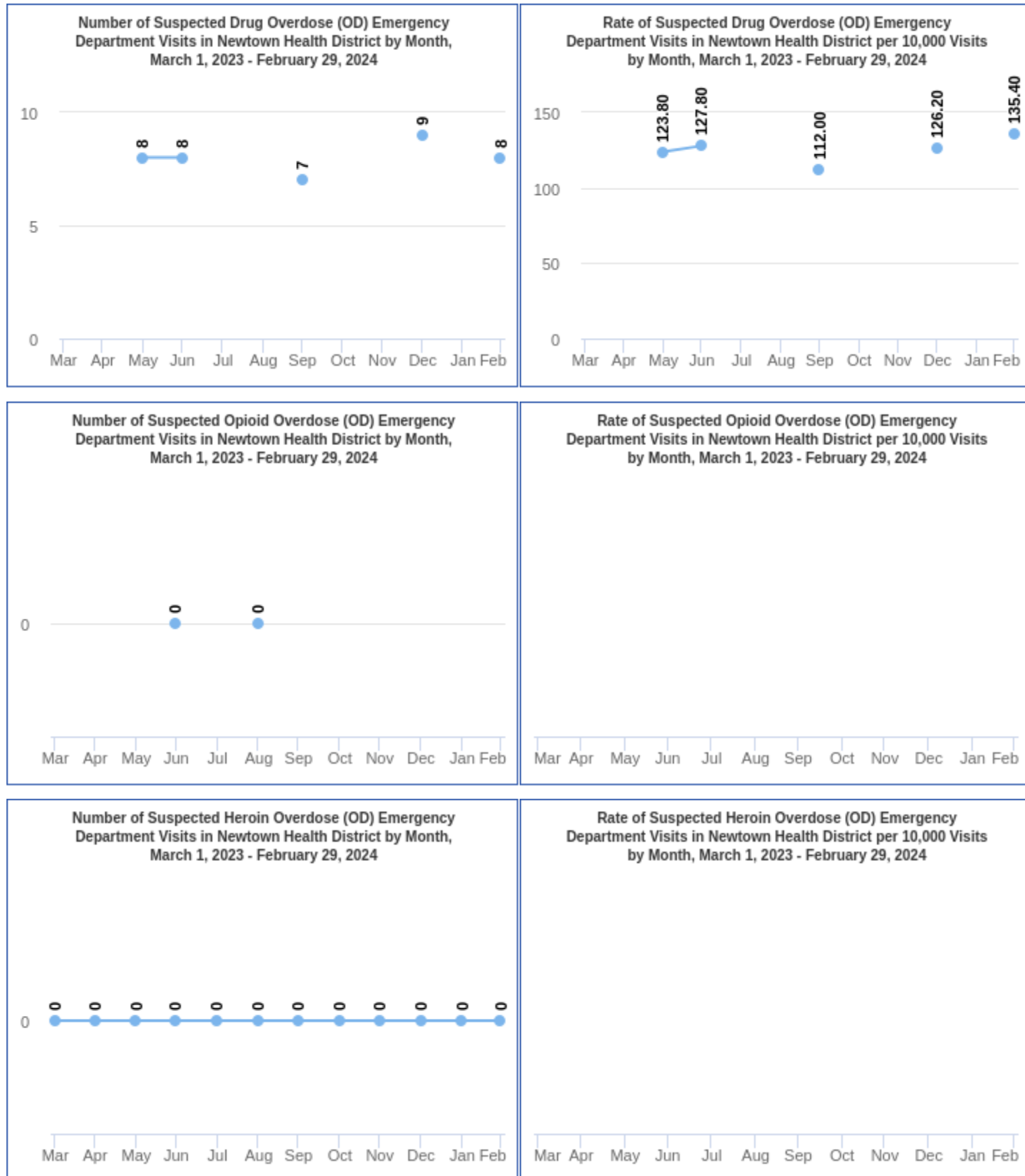

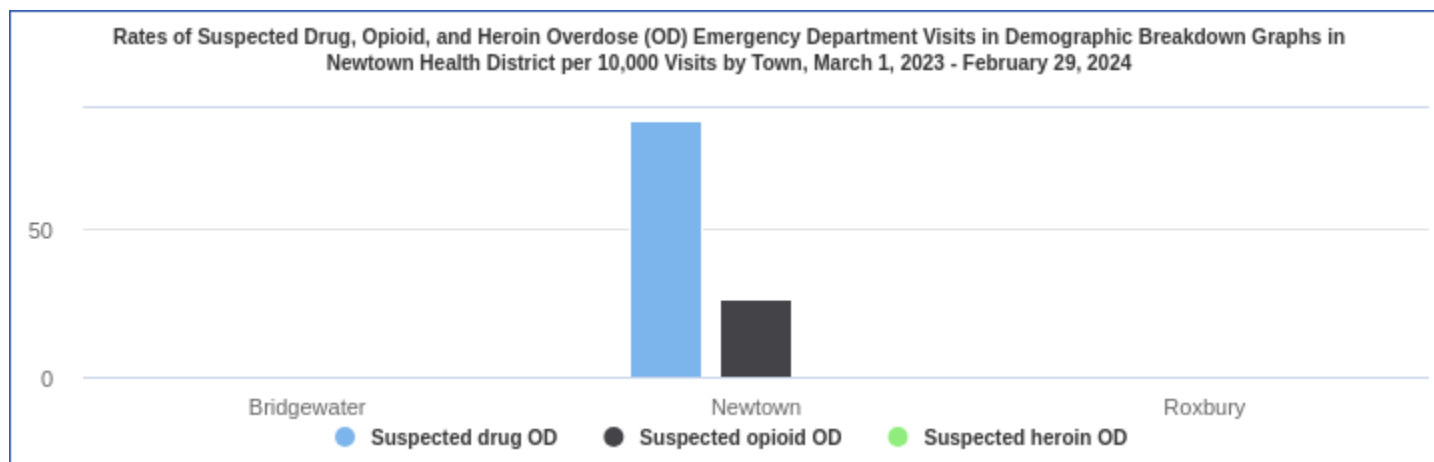

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Newtown Health District



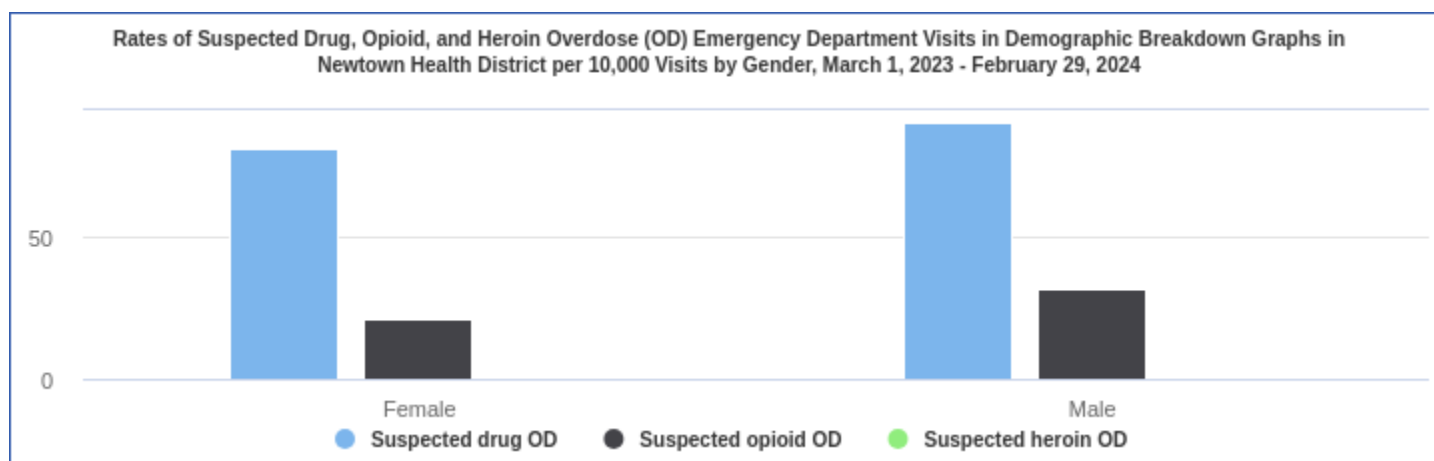

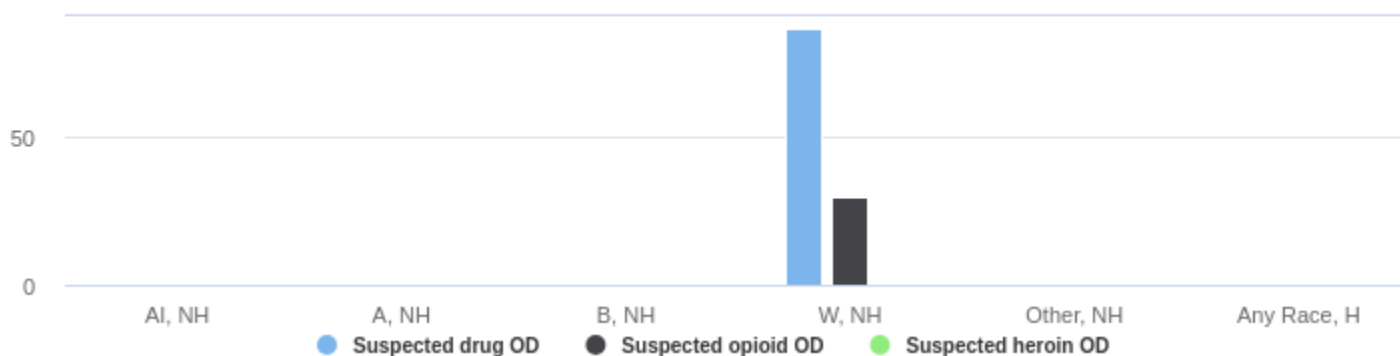

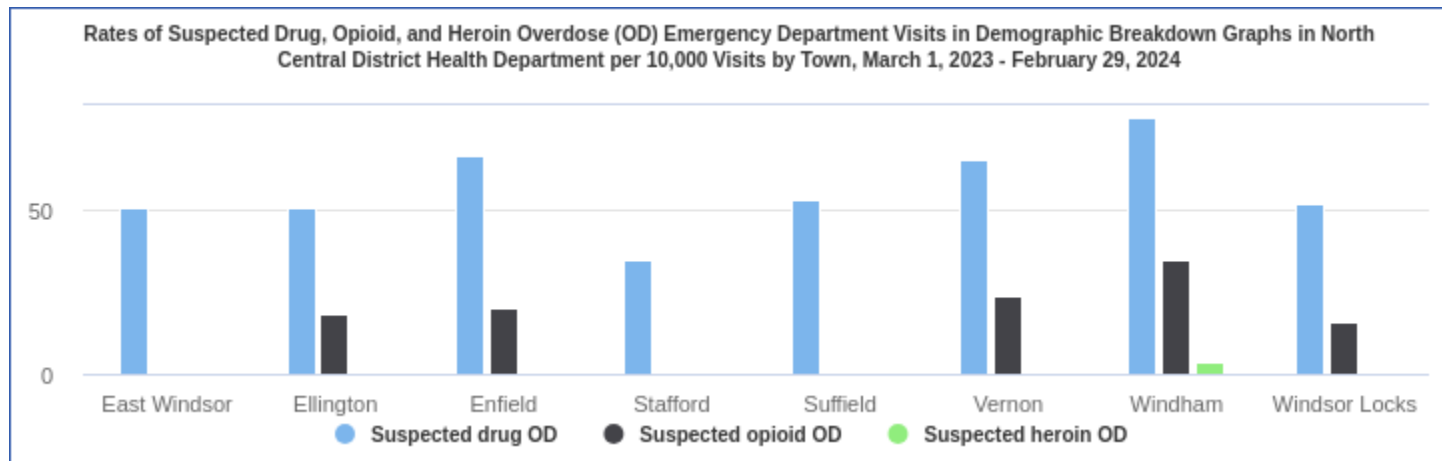
## Suspected Drug Overdose in North Central District Health Department

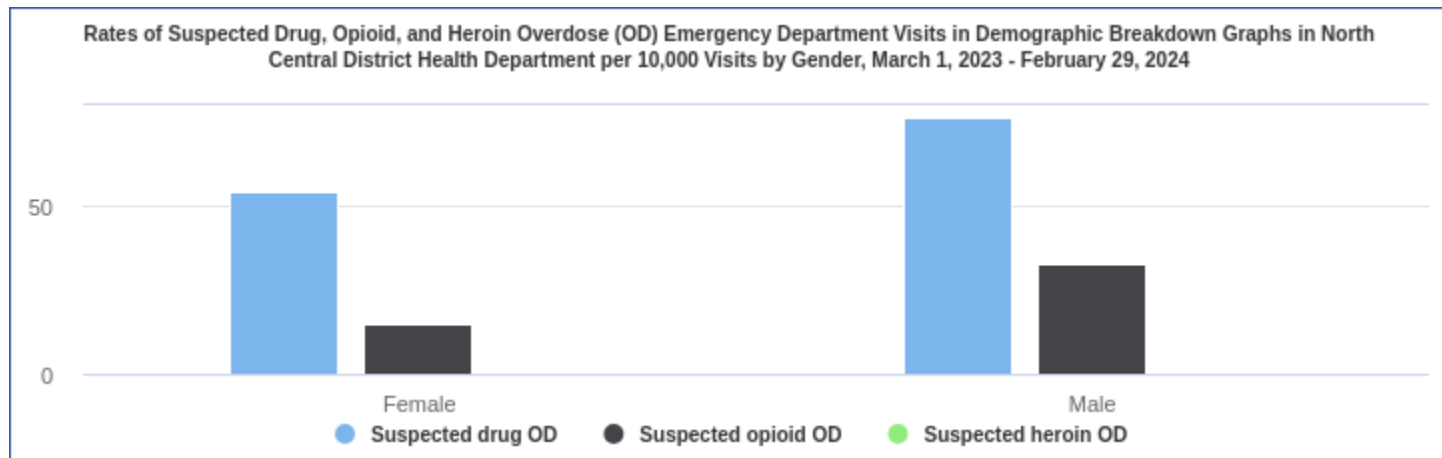

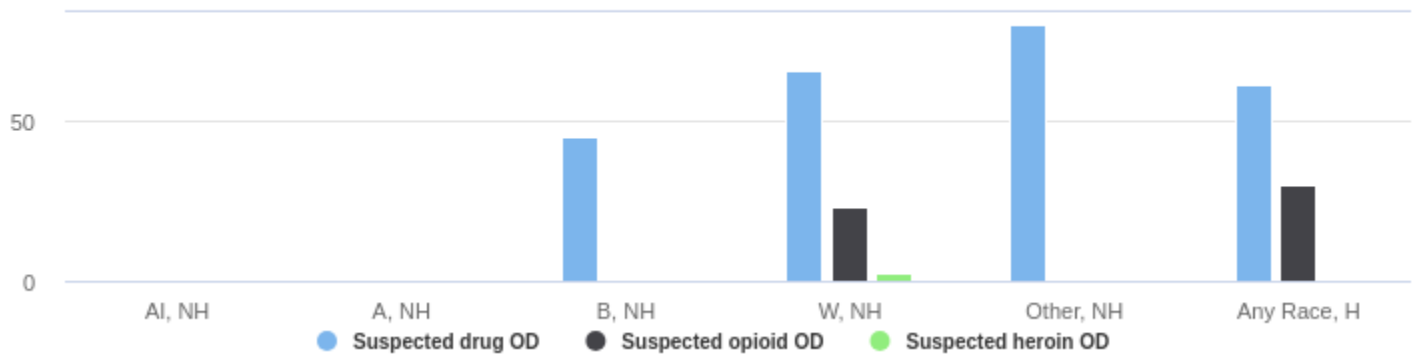

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Northeast District Department of Health



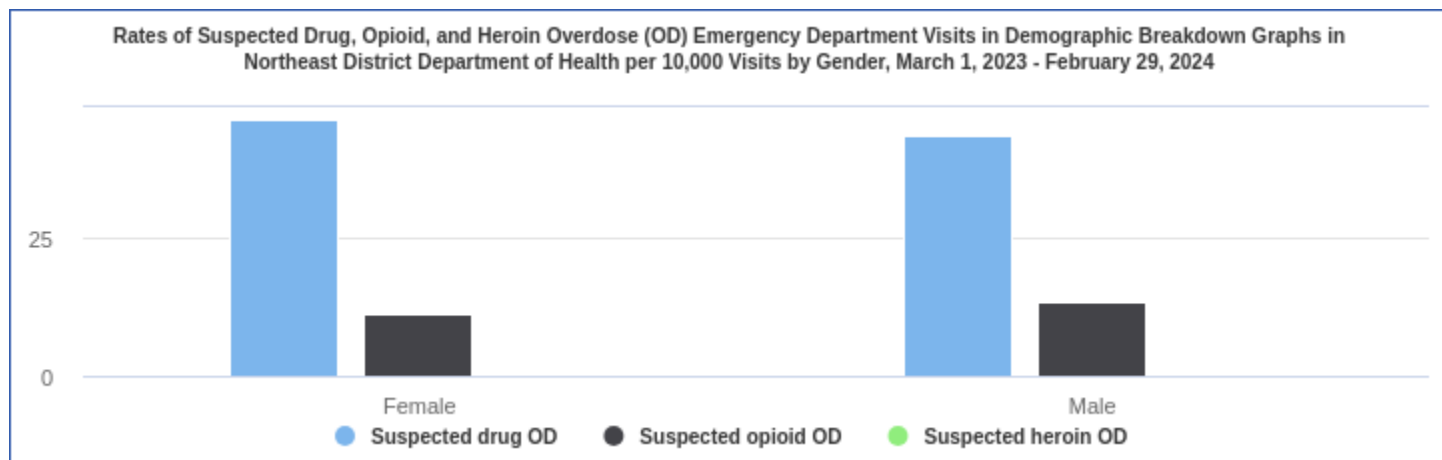

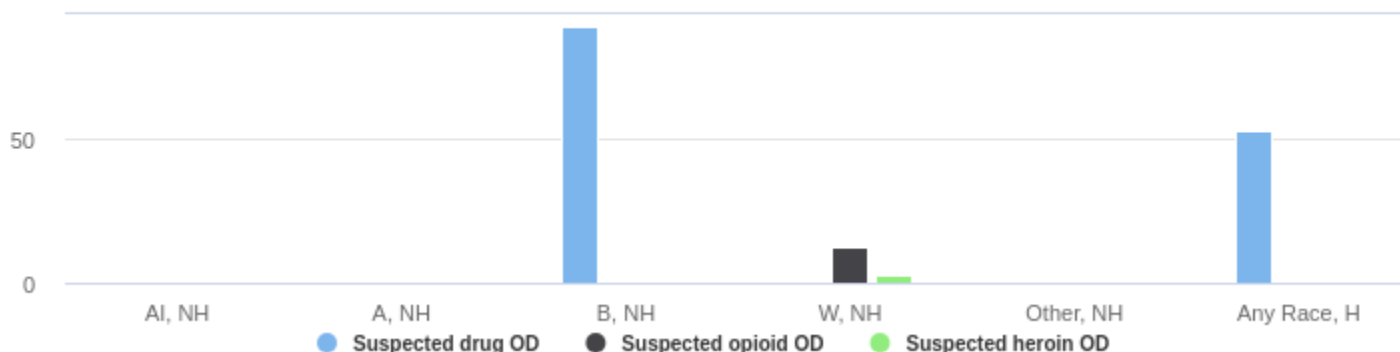

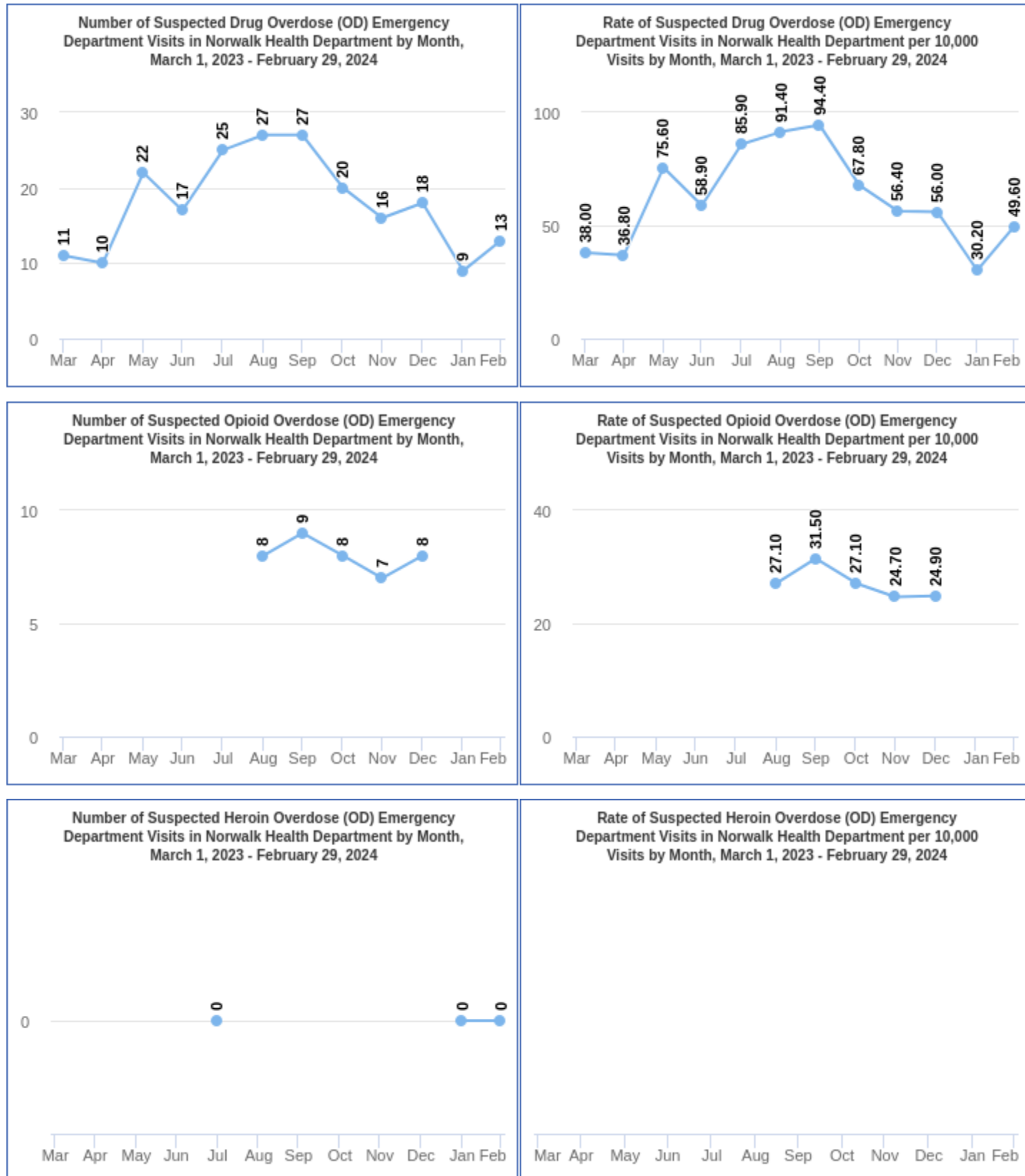

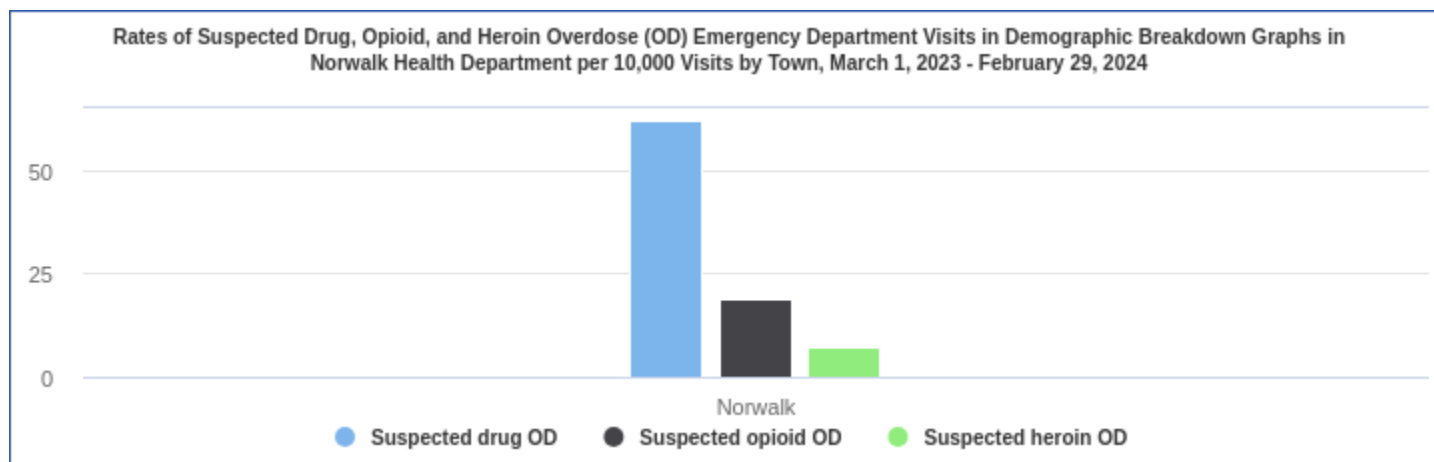

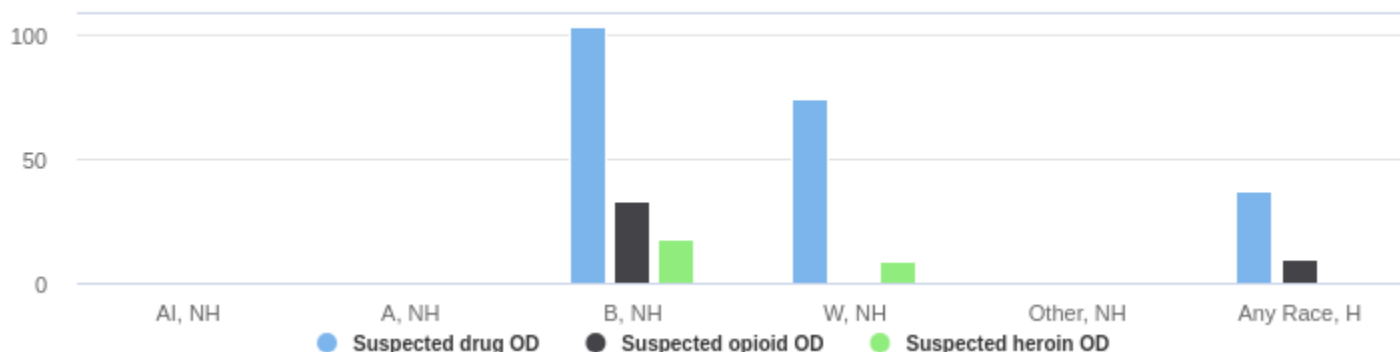

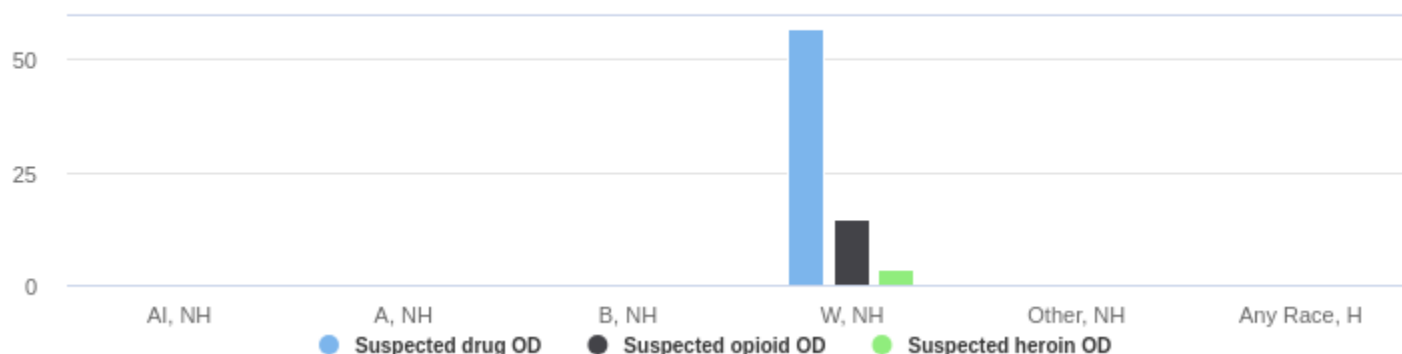

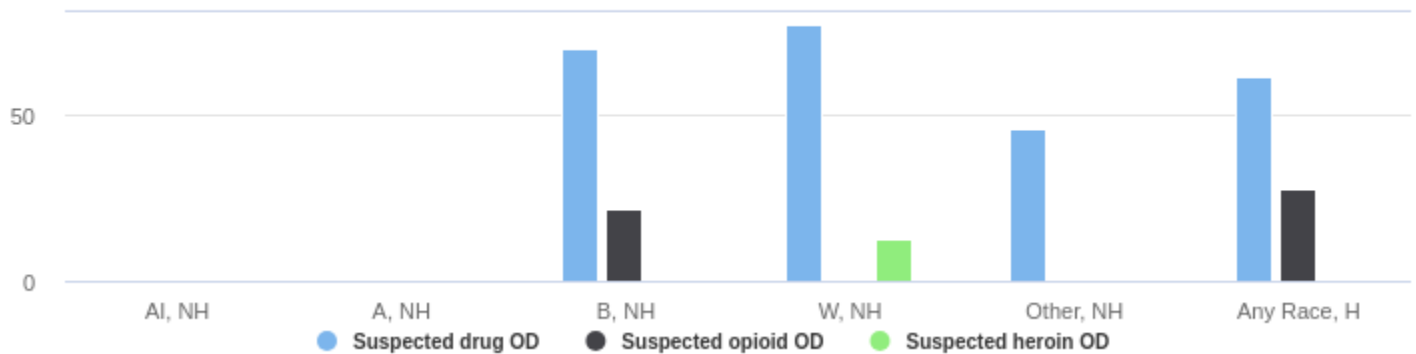

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Stamford Health Department



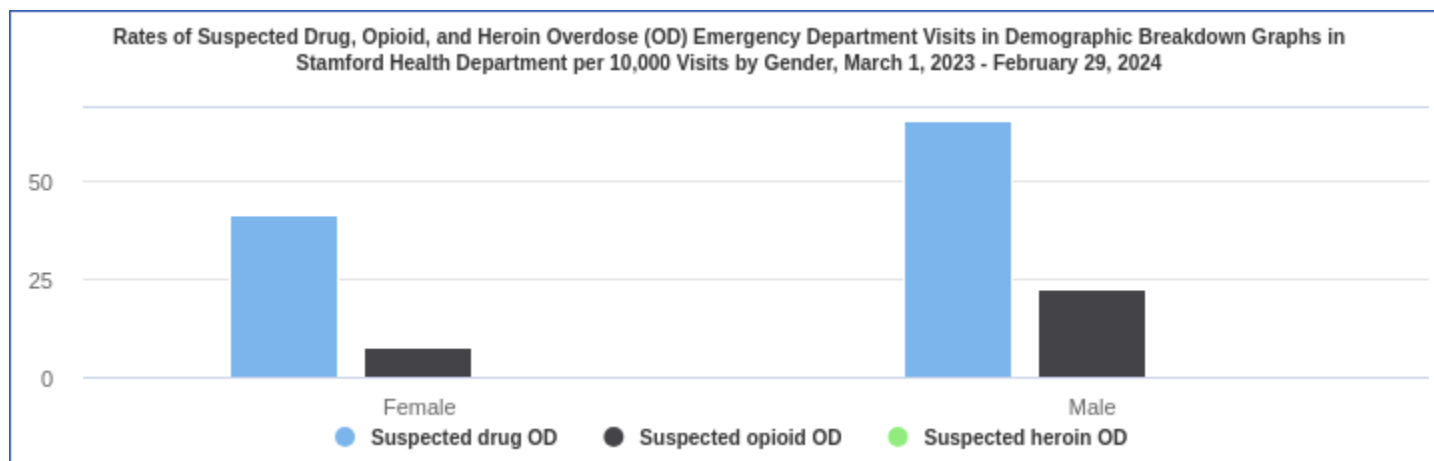

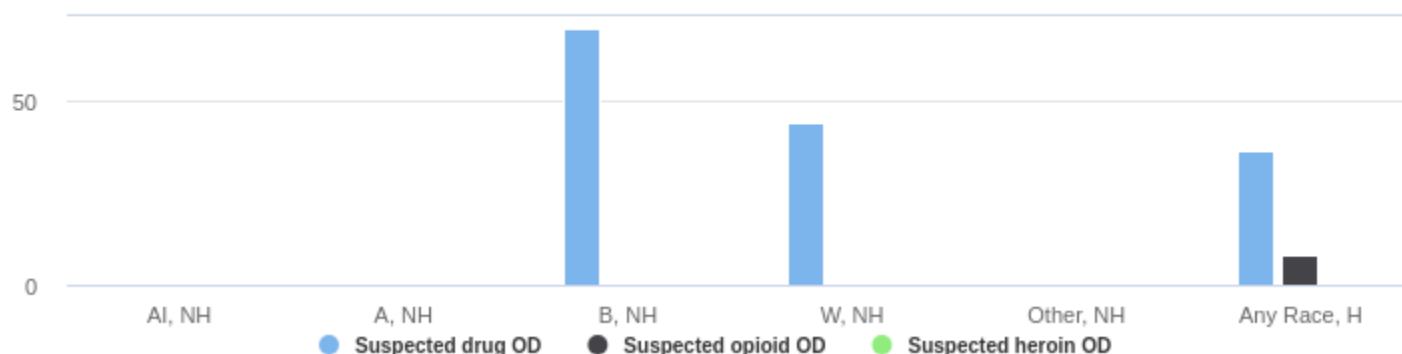

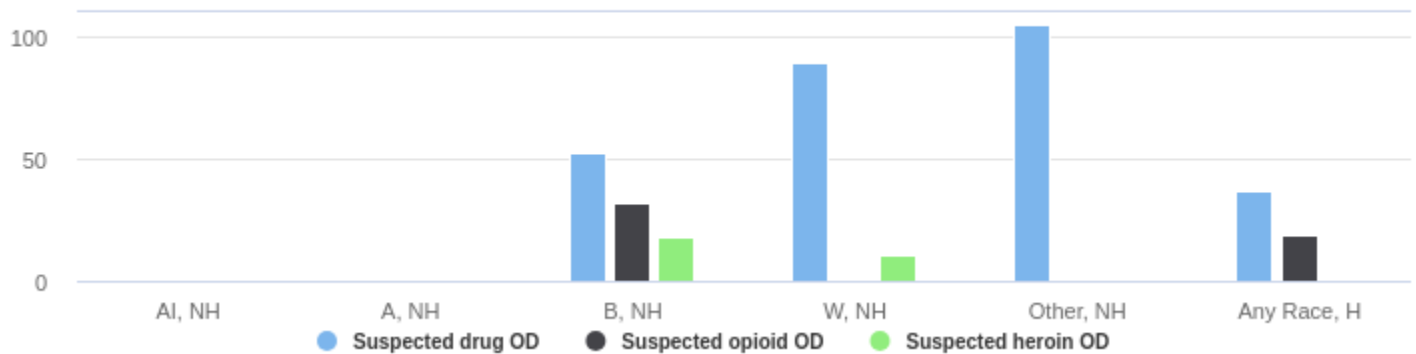

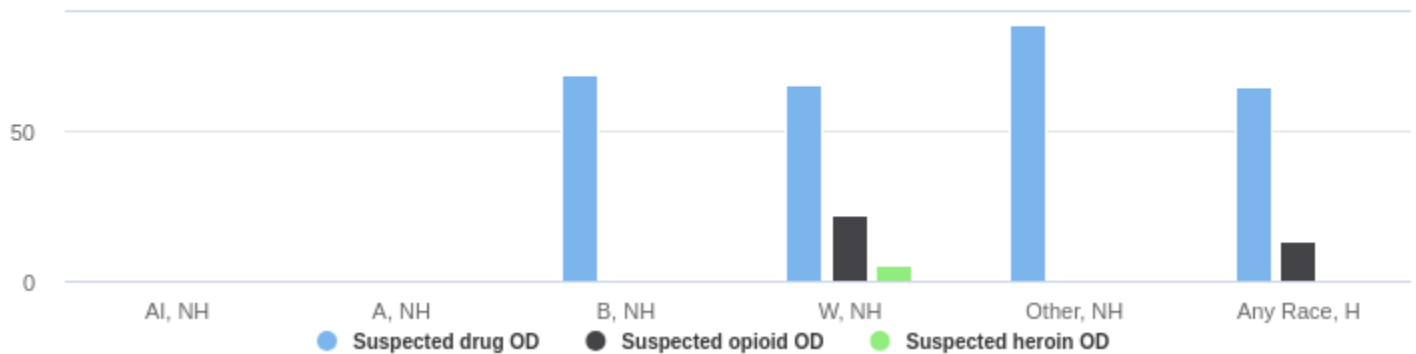

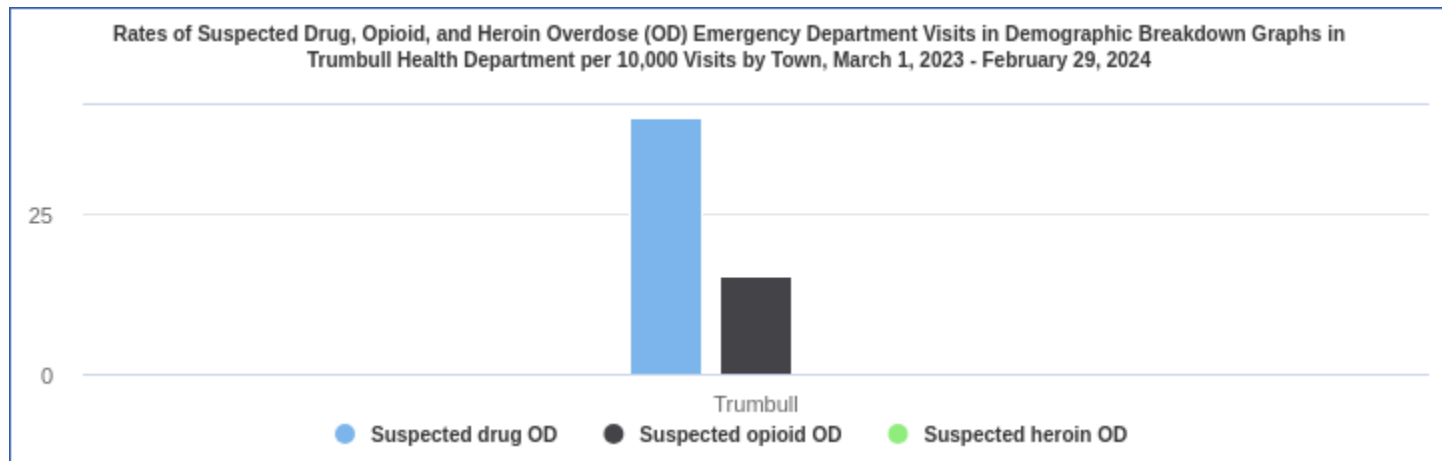
## Suspected Drug Overdose in Trumbull Health Department

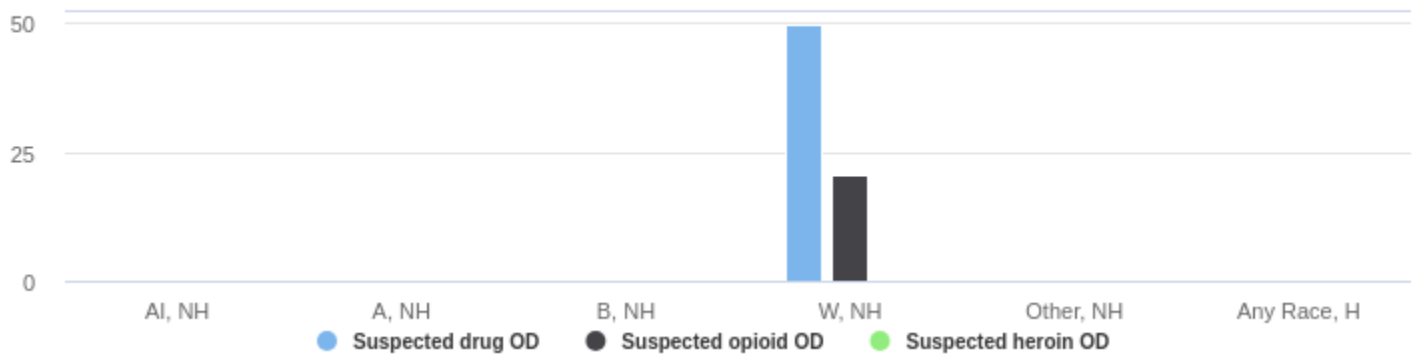

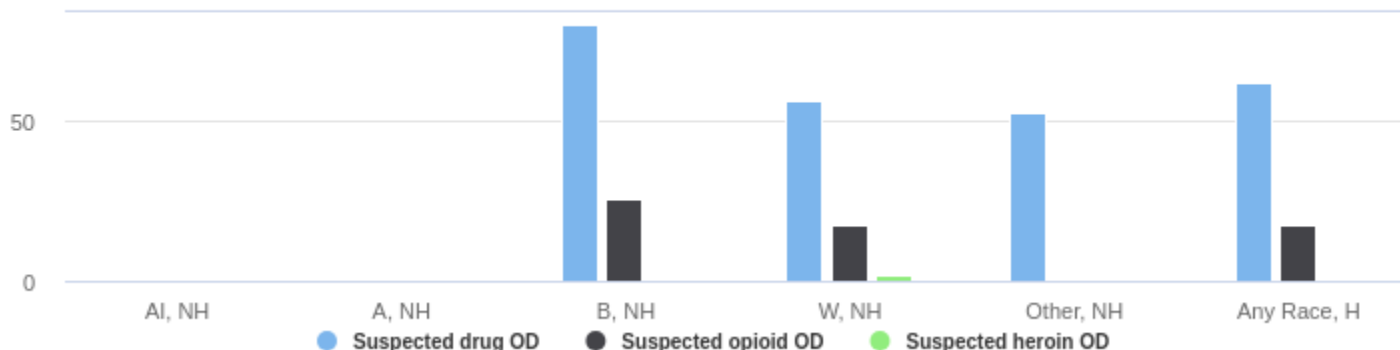

## Suspected Drug Overdose in Wallingford Health Department



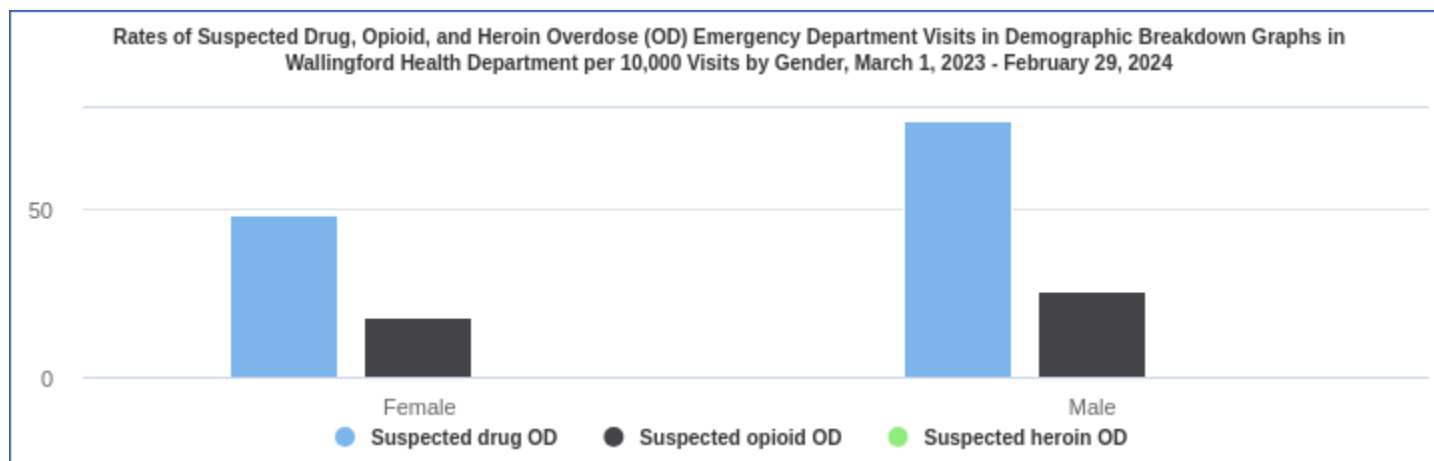

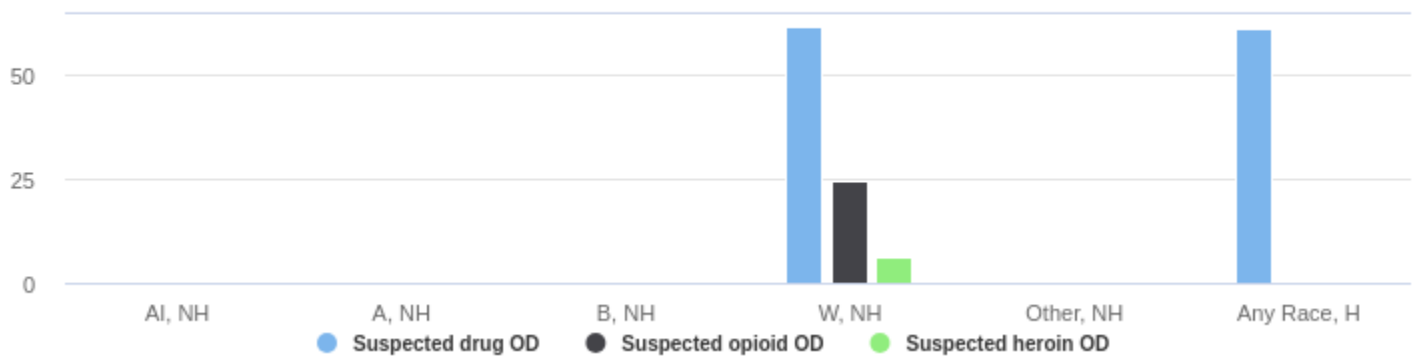

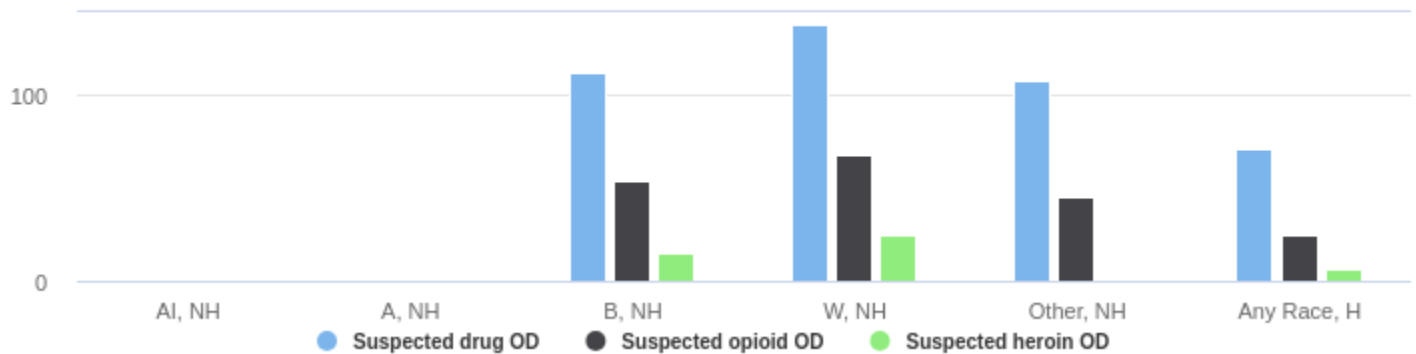

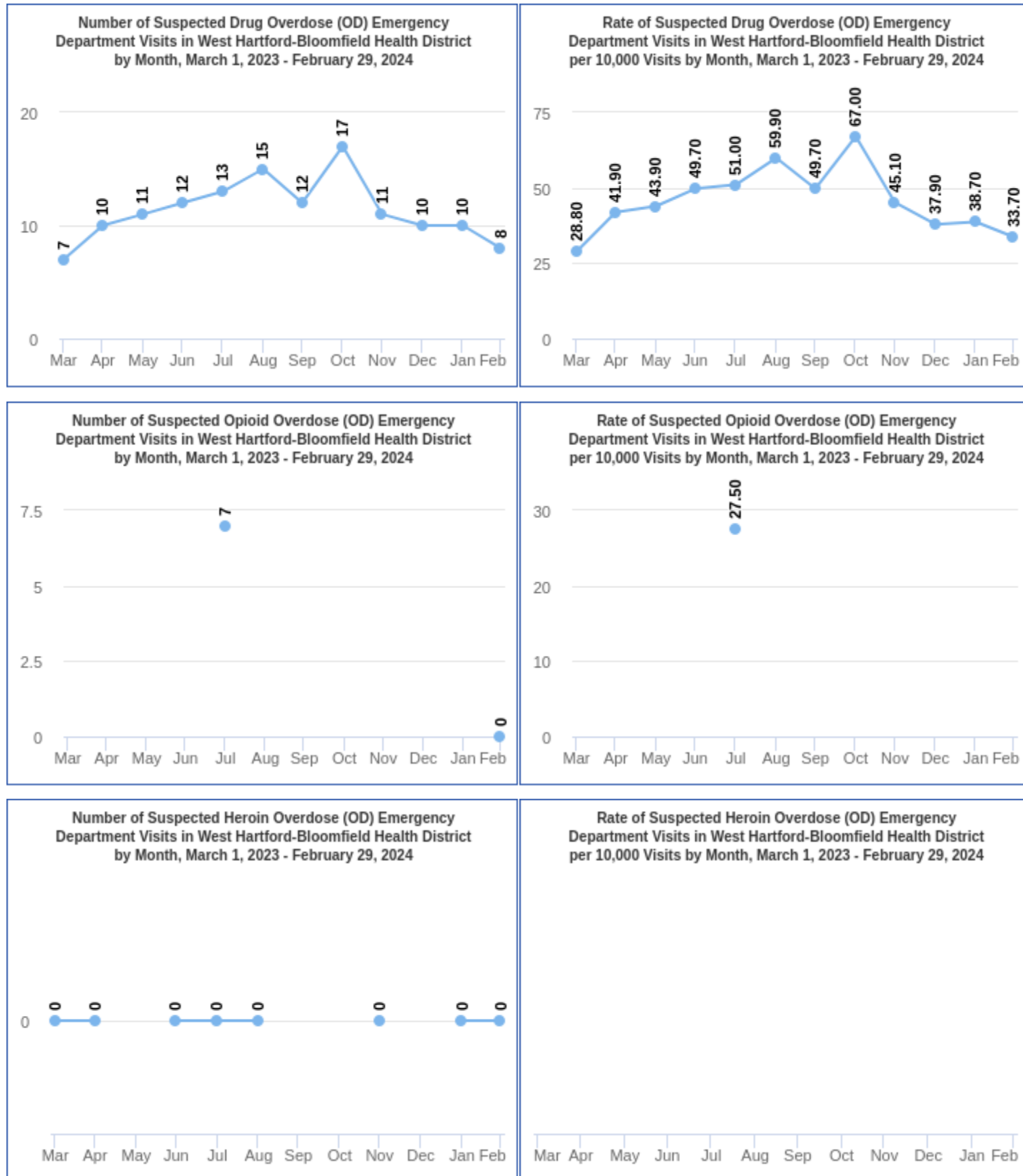

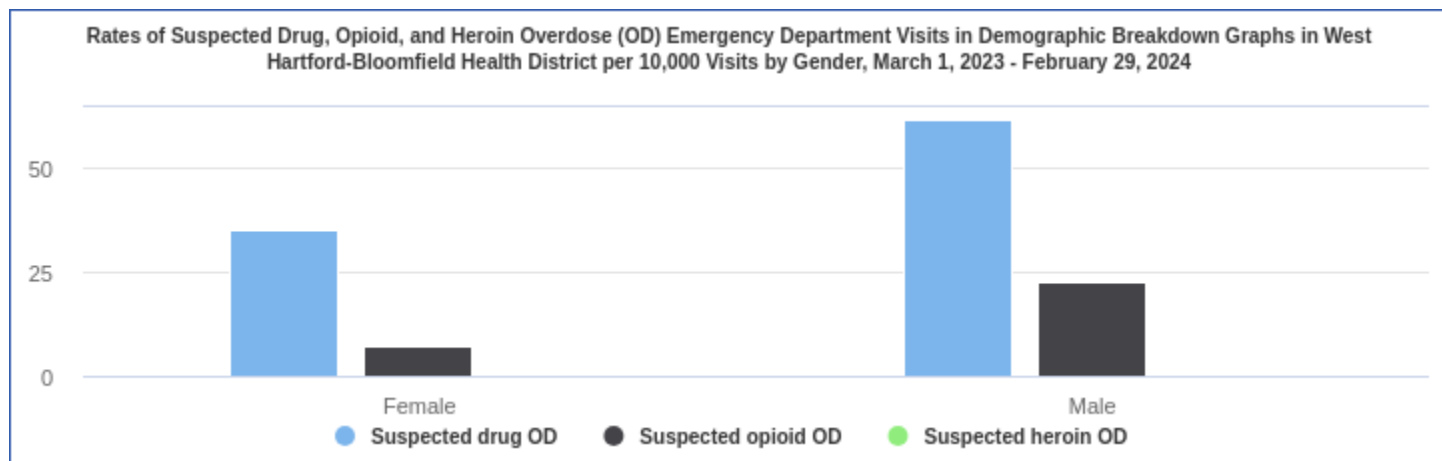

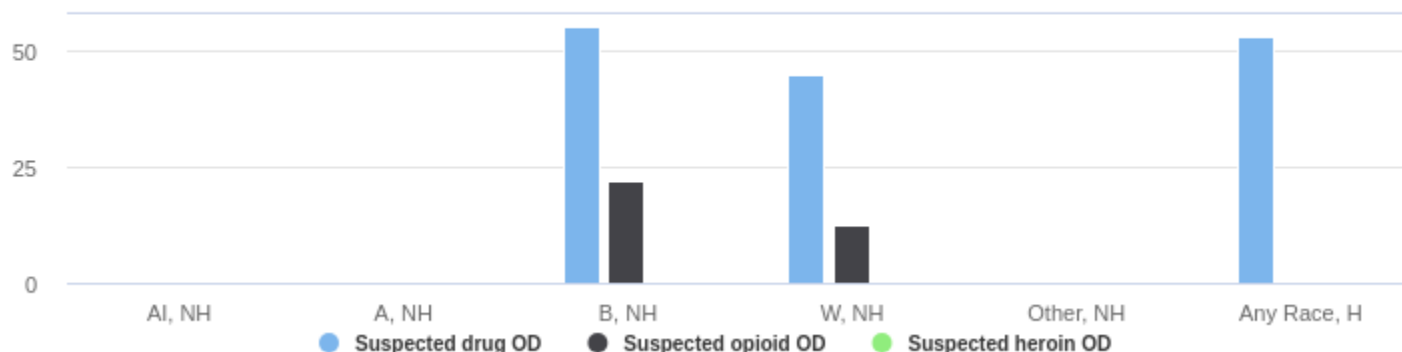

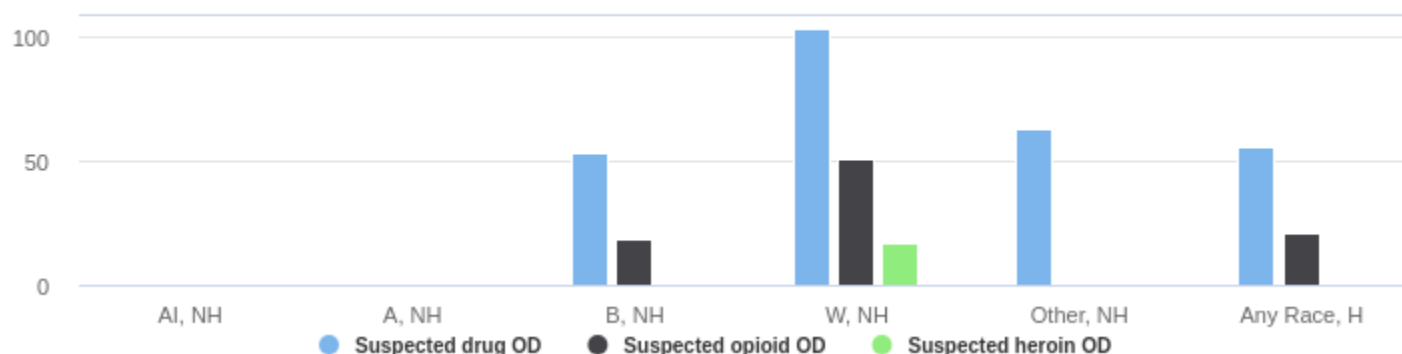

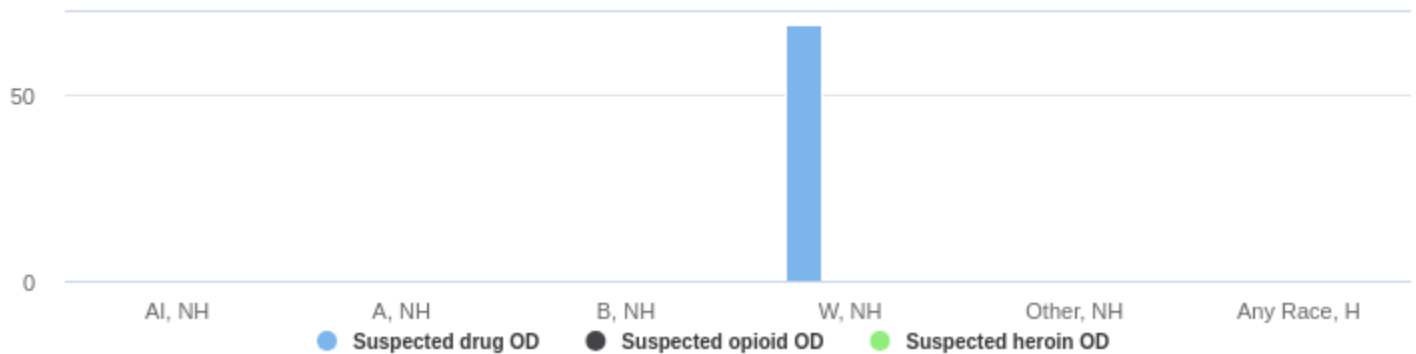

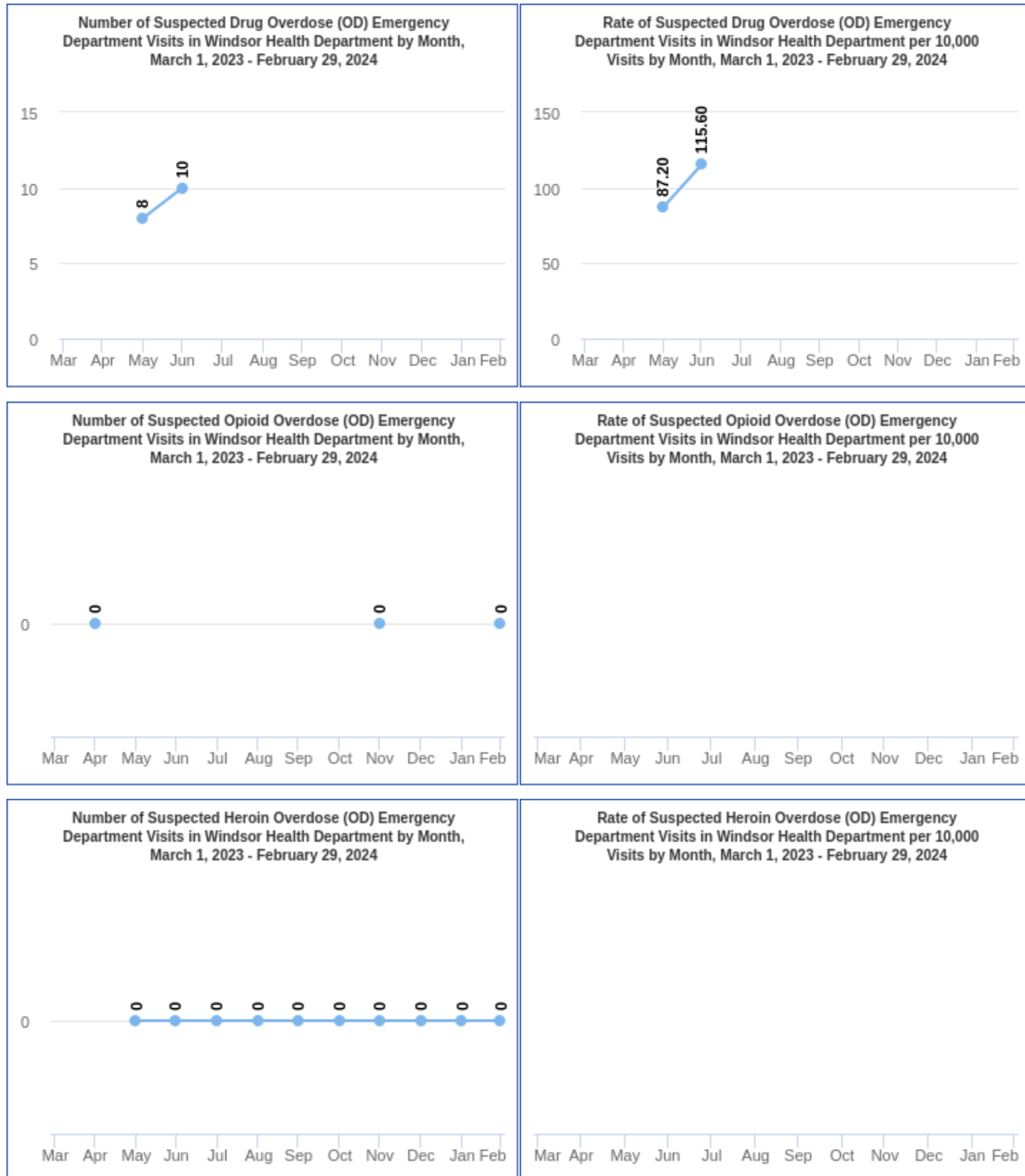

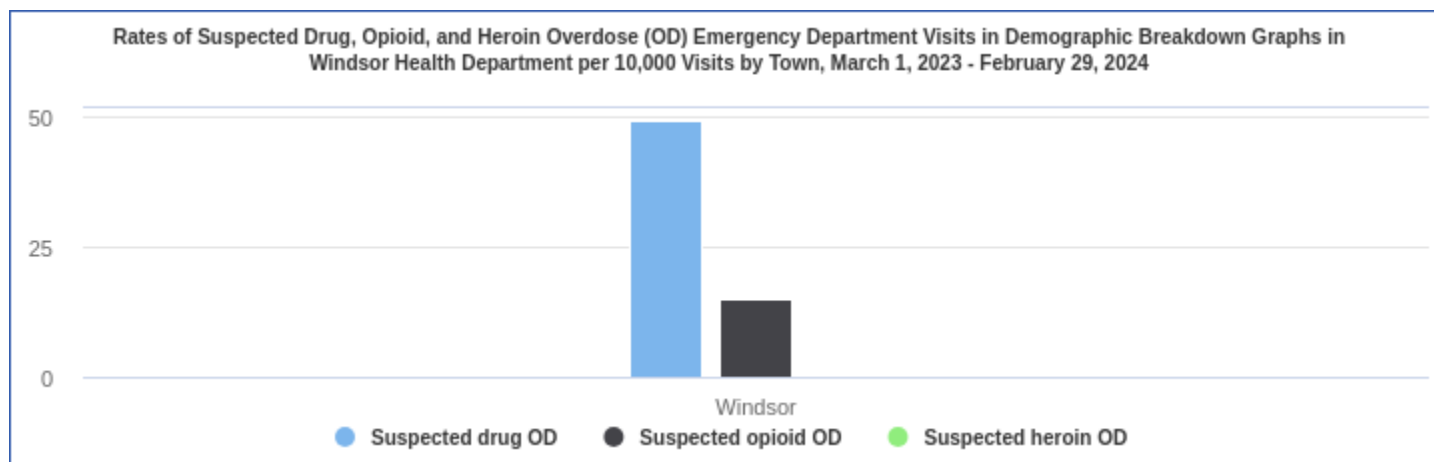

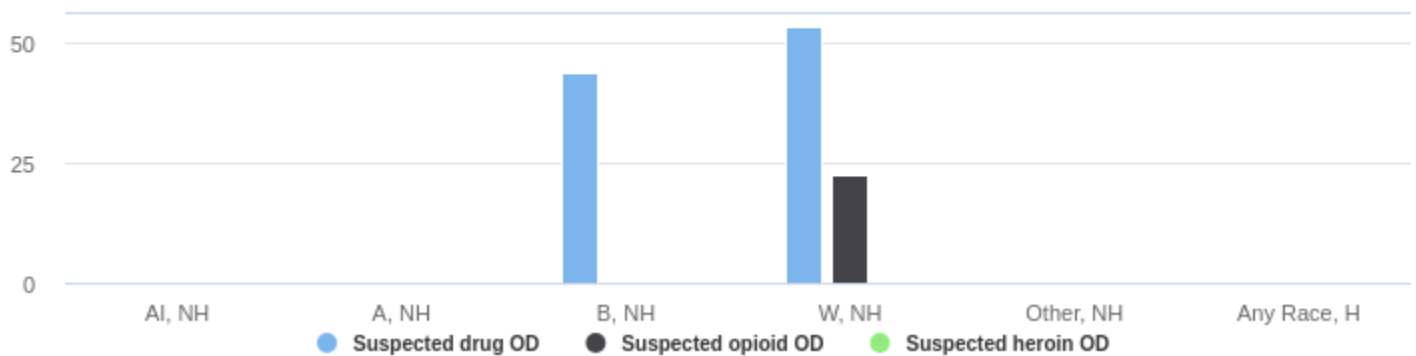
