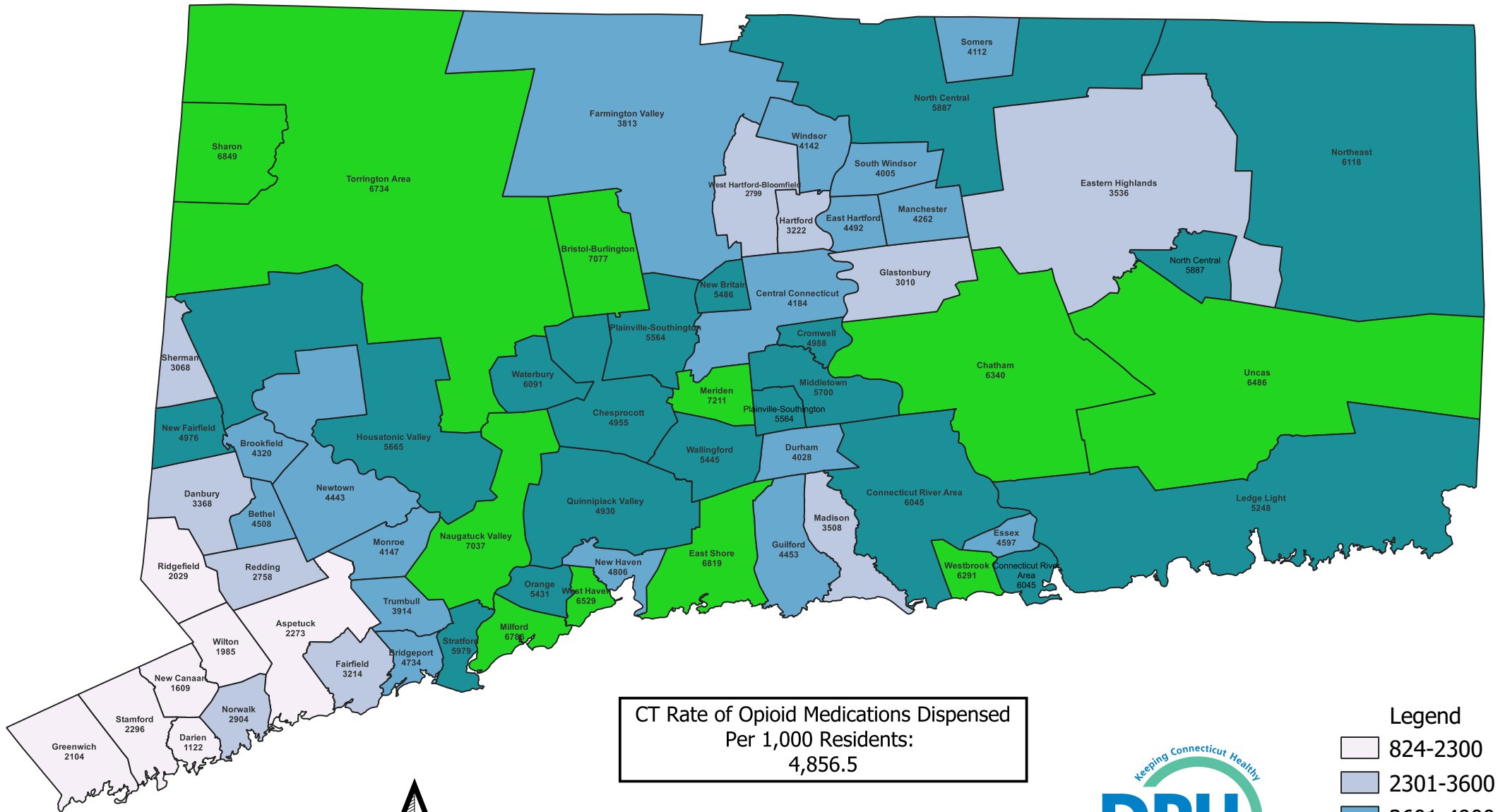
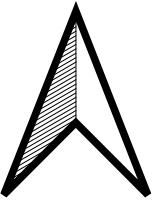
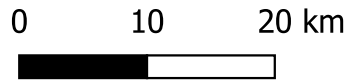


Rate of Opioid Medications Dispensed per 1,000 Residents, by Local Health Department/District, Connecticut, January 1-March 31, 2022

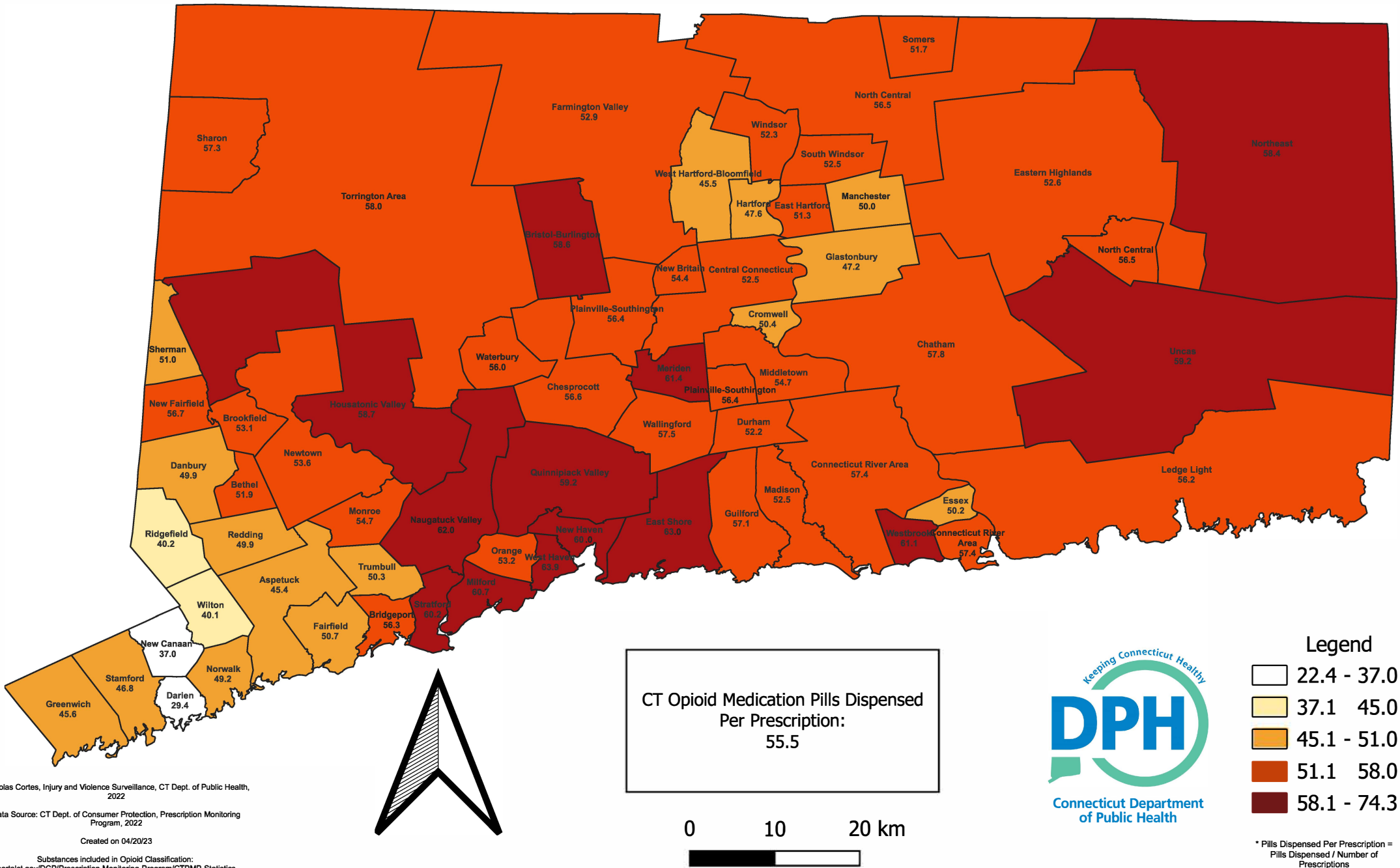
