# Form 211 CATV Instructions

- Line 1: Enter the total amount of gross earnings during the calendar quarter from lines, facilities, apparatus, and auxiliary equipment used in operating a community antenna television system. Do not deduct commissions, rebates, or other payments (except refunds arising from errors or overcharges).
- Line 2: If carrying on the community antenna television system business wholly inside Connecticut during the calendar quarter, enter 1.00 and do **not** complete Part II.

  If carrying on the community antenna television system business both inside Connecticut and outside Connecticut during the calendar quarter, enter the decimal from Part II, Line 18.
- **Line 5:** Enter the amount of any assessment actually paid during the calendar quarter to the Department of Public Utility Control under Conn. Gen. Stat. §16-49.
- Line 7: To claim the following credits, complete Form CT-1120K, Business Tax Credit Summary. For information about Connecticut business tax credits, see the following pages in Informational Publication 2001(17), Guide to Connecticut Business Tax Credits.
  - Clean Alternative Fuel Credit: Pages 9 and 10.
  - · Computer Donation Credit: Page 11.
  - Electronic Data Processing Equipment Property Tax Credit: Pages 17 and 18.
  - Employer-Assisted Housing Credit: Pages 19 and 20.
  - Historic Homes Rehabilitation Credit: Pages 31 and 32.
  - Housing Program Contribution Credit: Pages 33 and 34.
  - Neighborhood Assistance Act Credit: Pages 41, 42, and 43.
- **Line 9: Late Payment Penalty:** The penalty for late payment or underpayment of the tax is 10% (.10) of the tax due or \$50, whichever is greater.

Late Filing Penalty: If no tax is due, the Department of Revenue Services (DRS) may impose a \$50 penalty for the late filing of any return or report that is required by law to be filed. Form 211 CATV must be filed even if no tax is due.

**Line 10: Interest:** If the tax is not paid when due, interest accrues at the rate of 1% (.01) per month or fraction of a month until the tax is paid in full. To compute interest due, multiply Line 8 by the number of months or fraction of a month late, then by 1% (.01).

#### **Signature**

The treasurer of the company, or an authorized agent or officer of the company must sign **Form 211 CATV**.

**Paid Preparer Signature:** A paid preparer must sign and date **Form 211 CATV**. Paid preparers must also enter their Social Security Number (SSN) or Preparer Tax Identification Number (PTIN), and their firm's Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN) in the spaces provided.
