Part I - Eligibility Criteria

1. Enter the total gross receipts of the company for the current income year from all sources.

The gross receipts of the company should be annualized if this application is for a short period. If the total gross receipts of the company for the current income year exceeds \$5 million, the company is **not eligible** for a refund of tax credits. Do **not** check the applicable box on Form CT-1120, Form CT-1120CU, Form 207, Form 207F, or Form 207 HCC.

Part II - Computation of Refund Amount

1. Enter the amount of 2023 Student Loan Payment tax credit from 2023 **Form CT-SLP**, Part I, Line 2.

- Proof of payment to the Connecticut Higher Education Supplemental Loan Authority (CHESLA); **and**
- A detailed schedule identifying each employee as a full-time, qualified employee for purposes of the Student Loan Payment tax credit.

Attach **Form CT-SLP**, *Student Loan Payment Tax Credit*, and all required supporting schedules and documentation to Form CT-RSLP.

Check the box at the top of Form CT-1120, Form CT-1120CU, Form 207, Form 207F, or Form 207 HCC to indicate that you are claiming a refund for Student Loan Payment tax credits and enter the amount of credit to be issued in the form of a refund requested.

Definitions

Qualified Small Business for the purposes of the tax credit to be issued in the form of a refund means a qualified employer that has gross receipts of not more than five million dollars for the calendar or income year, as applicable, for which a credit under this section is allowed.

Gross Receipts means gross receipts as defined by the Internal Revenue Code are the total amounts the organization received from all sources during its annual accounting period, without subtracting any costs or expenses.
