Subject: Extension of Interim Telework Guidelines to Executive Branch Employees Exempt from Collective Bargaining


Effective: March 12, 2020

Subject: Extension of the Agreed upon language concerning the Negotiated Final Telework Policy

Effective: January 1, 2022

Pursuant to the authority outlined in CGS § 5-200(p) and § 5-200(q), the provisions of the agreed upon language concerning the Negotiated Final Telework Policy between the State of Connecticut Office of Policy and Management, Office of Labor Relations and SEBAC, excluding Sections 4.7, 4.8, and 4.9, is hereby extended to all Executives, Managers, and Confidential employees of the Executive Branch except those who are employed in higher education.


