MINUTES OF THE JUNE 27, 2024 SPECIAL MEETING

The Citizen's Ethics Advisory Board ("Board") of the Office of State Ethics ("OSE") held a Special Meeting on Thursday, June 27, 2024. The meeting was held online via TEAMs video conferencing platform.

The following topic was addressed during the meeting:

General Counsel Brian O'Dowd presented Draft Advisory Opinion No. 2024-2, issued in response to the Petition submitted by the Office of the Governor on behalf of Philip Zecher concerning the application of a new gift exception in the Code of Ethics for Public Officials to a potential member of the Investment Advisory Council. Chair Castricone inquired if a representative of the Petitioner was present and wished to comment on the Draft Advisory Opinion, and Charlotte Moller from the Office of the Governor informed the Board that she did not. After the Board discussed the matter and asked a few questions to, and received answers from, General Counsel O'Dowd, the Board proposed to include two footnotes in the final draft of the opinion to address the Board's concerns.

On the motion of Mr. Chiusano, seconded by Ms. Cook, the Board voted six (6) to zero (0), with Mr. Farrell abstaining, to approve Draft Advisory Opinion No. 2024-2 with the addition of two footnotes as recommended by members of the Board.

On the motion of Mr. Farrell, seconded by Mr. Chiusano, the Board voted seven (7) to zero (0) to adjourn the meeting.
