AMENDED COMPLAINT

COUNT ONE

1. At all times relevant to the complaint herein, Dr. Cleveland Donald, Jr. (the "Respondent") was a state employee as that term is defined in Conn. Gen. Stat. §1-79(q).

2. The Respondent was the Director of the Waterbury Regional Campus of the University of Connecticut in May of 1992.

3. In his position as Director, the Respondent signed the payroll authorization form to hire his wife as Minority Recruiter at the Waterbury Campus, at the rate of \$6000.00 for a one-month period from May 11, 1992 to June 11, 1992.

4. Conn. Gen. Stat. §1-84(c) prohibits a state employee from using his public office or position to obtain personal financial gain for his spouse.

5. The Respondent's exercise of his authority as Director of the Waterbury Campus to hire his wife as Minority Recruiter at the Waterbury Campus constituted an improper use of public office or position, in violation of Conn. Gen. Stat. §1-84(c).

COUNT TWO

1-3. Paragraphs 1 through 3 of Count One are hereby incorporated as Paragraphs 1 through 3 of Count Two.

4. Conn. Gen. Stat. §1-86(a) provides a specific procedure to be followed by a state employee or public official when his or her official action would affect the financial interest of, among others, his or her spouse.
