## STIPULATION AND ORDER

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-177(c), the State Ethics Commission and the Respondent agree to settle this matter in the manner described below:

- 1. The Commission finds that the Respondent violated the Code of Ethics for Public Officials as alleged in the Complaint dated June 5, 1998.
- 2. The Respondent waives any rights he may have under Conn. Gen. Stat. §§1-82, 1-82a, 1-87 and 1-80, including any right to a hearing or appeal in this case, and agrees with the Commission to an informal disposition of this matter as authorized by Conn. Gen. Stat. 4-177(c).

WHEREFORE, the State Ethics Commission enters and the Respondent agrees to the following order in lieu of any other action regarding this matter:

The Respondent agrees to pay \$2000.00 to the Ethics Commission: however, based on the Respondent's cooperation with the Commission, \$1000 of the fine is suspended provided that the Respondent henceforth comply with the Code of Ethics. The remaining \$1000 is to be paid by the Respondent in equal monthly installments of \$250 each, commencing within thirty days of the signing of this Stipulation and Order.
