
The above-captioned matter was heard as a contested case on October 25, 2021, at which time the complainant and the respondents appeared and presented testimony, exhibits and argument on the complaint. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the state's response to it, the hearing was conducted through the use of electronic equipment (remotely) pursuant to §149 of Public Act 21-2 (June Special Session). The complainant is incarcerated at a facility of the Connecticut Department of Correction.

During the contested case hearing on this matter, the complainant requested, and the respondents agreed, to go off the record to further discuss the matter without the presence of the hearing officer. Thereafter, on the record, the complainant and respondents informed the hearing officer that they had settled the complaint in this matter. In consideration of such settlement, the complainant withdrew the complaint.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. Based on the withdrawal of the complaint, the case is hereby dismissed.
