

At the time of the request and hearing, the complainant was incarcerated in a correctional facility.

On March 17, 2022, the complainant notified the Commission in writing that he wished to withdraw his complaint in this matter. The Commission takes administrative notice of such withdrawal.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:
