The above-captioned matter was heard as a contested case on March 10, 2022, at which time the complainants and the respondents appeared, and presented testimony, exhibits and argument on the complaint.

At the hearing, Chief Michael A. Spera testified that the police department respondents would provide the requested record to the complainants shortly. In response, the hearing officer requested that Chief Spera send her an email (with a copy to the complainants) notifying her when the disclosure had been completed.


On March 23, 2022, Chief Spera notified the hearing officer by email that the requested records had been disclosed. On the same day, complainant Elizabeth Regan notified the hearing officer by email that this matter may be considered closed.

The Commission takes administrative notice of the complainant's email and construes such email as a withdrawal of the complaint.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. Based on the withdrawal of the complaint, the case is hereby dismissed.
