The above-captioned matter was heard as a contested case on October 18, 2021, at which time the complainant and respondents appeared and presented argument on the complaint. The hearing was continued to permit the parties to discuss the possibility of settlement of the complaint in this matter. At the time of the October 18, 2021 hearing, the complainant was incarcerated.

A continued hearing was scheduled for February 8, 2022. Subsequently, the complainant requested a postponement, which was granted. The continued hearing was rescheduled to April 21, 2022. Pursuant to the request of the hearing officer, the continued hearing was postponed and rescheduled for June 30, 2022.

At the June 30, 2022 continued hearing, the respondents appeared, but the complainant failed to appear. At the time of the continued hearing, the complainant was no longer incarcerated.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the state's response to it, the hearings were conducted through the use of electronic equipment (remotely) pursuant to §149 of Public Act 21-2 (June Special Session), as amended by §1 of Public Act 22-3.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is hereby dismissed for failure to prosecute.
