
The above-captioned matter was heard as a contested case on April 1, 2022, at which time the complainant and respondents appeared, stipulated to certain facts and presented testimony, exhibits and argument on the complaint. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the state's response to it, the hearing was conducted through the use of electronic equipment (remotely) pursuant to §149 of Public Act 21-2 (June Special Session). At the time of the request and hearing, the complainant was incarcerated in a correctional facility of the Department of Correction.

After the respondents' witness testified that the respondents do not maintain the only remaining outstanding record in this matter, the complainant testified that he was satisfied with that explanation and withdrew the complaint on the record.

The following order is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. Based on the withdrawal of the complaint, the complaint is hereby dismissed.
