
The above-captioned matter was scheduled to be heard as a contested case on February 2, 2023, at which time the respondents appeared, but the complainant failed to appear.

The hearing officer notes that Lieutenant Earl Wheeler and Sergeant Michael Lafond appeared for the respondents, and Lieutenant Wheeler represented that he spent several hours preparing for the hearing. In addition, it is noted that Lieutenant Wheeler and Sergeant Lafond traveled over an hour to attend the hearing.

The following order is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is dismissed for failure to prosecute.
2. The complainant is admonished for her failure to appear at the hearing in this matter, which failure resulted in a waste of scarce state and local resources.


