
The above-captioned matter was scheduled to be heard as a contested case on May 5, 2022 and August 10, 2022, at which times the complainant and the respondents appeared, and presented testimony, exhibits and argument on the complaint. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the state's response to it, the hearing was conducted through the use of electronic equipment (remotely) pursuant to §149 of Public Act 21-2 (June Special Session), as amended by §1 of Public Act No. 22-3. At the time of the request and hearing in this matter, the complainant was incarcerated in a correctional facility of the Department of Correction. For purposes of the hearing, the above-captioned matter was consolidated with Docket #FIC 2021-0289, Travis Armstrong v. James Rovella, Commissioner, State of Connecticut, Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection; and State of Connecticut, Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection; Docket #FIC 2021-0403, Travis Armstrong v. 
