The hearing officer continued the hearing to allow the respondents to complete their cross-examination of the complainant. In addition, the hearing was continued to afford the respondents the opportunity to offer witnesses, and to afford the complainant an opportunity to cross-examine such witnesses.


By notice dated July 10, 2023, the Commission informed the parties that an in-person, continued hearing would take place on July 27, 2023.


