Attorney Roberts represented that, in preparation for the hearing, he spent approximately four hours reviewing the case file, preparing exhibits, organizing his presentation, and consulting with Mr. Perry. Mr. Perry represented that he spent approximately seven hours gathering, reviewing and disclosing responsive records to the complainant, and working with Attorney Roberts in preparation to testify at the contested case hearing.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

- 1. The complaint is hereby dismissed for failure to prosecute.
- 2. The complainant is admonished for his failure to appear at the hearing in this matter, which failure resulted in a waste of scarce state resources.
