The above-captioned matter was heard as a contested case on January 30, 2024, at which time the complainant and the respondents appeared. Prior to the start of testimony, the parties requested the opportunity to discuss a potential resolution of the matter off the record outside the presence of the hearing officer. Following such discussion, the parties entered a stipulation narrowing the claims at issue.

Continued hearings were held on March 1, 2024 and April 12, 2024, at which time the parties appeared, stipulated to certain facts, and presented testimony, exhibits, and argument on the complaint.

At the April 12, 2024 continued hearing, after the parties presented evidence but prior to the close of the hearing, the complainant withdrew the complaint on the record. The Commission takes administrative notice of such withdrawal.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

- 1. Based upon the withdrawal, the complaint is dismissed.
- 2. The Commission commends the parties for their efforts to resolve this matter prior to the close of the contested case hearing.
