
The above-captioned matter was scheduled to be heard as a contested case on September 17, 2024, at 1:00 p.m., at which time the respondents appeared, but the complainant did not appear to prosecute the complaint.

The hearing officer notes that Attorney Brendan Sharkey, counsel for the respondents, appeared at the hearing with a witness, Christina Colaiacovo, records manager for the Hamden Police Department. It is further noted that Attorney Sharkey represented that the respondents had provided the complainant with all the records responsive to the request that is the subject of the complaint in this matter.

The following order is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is dismissed for failure to prosecute.
2. The complainant is admonished for her failure to appear at the hearing in this matter, which failure resulted in a waste of scarce state and local resources.


