
The above-captioned matter was scheduled to be heard as a contested case on January 13, 2025, at 9:30 a.m., at which time the respondents appeared, but the complainant, who is incarcerated, did not appear to prosecute the complaint.

By email on January 15, 2025, the Commission received a request to reopen the hearing from an unknown individual on the complainant's behalf. On January 31, 2025, the Commission sent the complainant a letter informing him that the Commission received such email but did not have any information on file indicating that its sender had permission to represent him or file motions on his behalf. The Commission further informed the complainant that, pursuant to its regulations, he could designate an attorney or another person to represent him regarding his complaint. The Commission received no subsequent correspondence from the complainant regarding the above-captioned matter.

The following order is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is dismissed for failure to prosecute.


