

The complainant had previously informed Commission staff that he intended to withdraw his complaint and would not be attending the January 3 hearing. After waiting approximately fifteen minutes past the scheduled time for the hearing, and having not received any such withdrawal from the complainant, the undersigned hearing officer opened the hearing.

After the January 3 hearing, the respondents informed the Commission that the complainant withdrew his complaint; however, to date, the Commission has not received any such withdrawal in the above-captioned matter.

The following order is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is dismissed for failure to prosecute.


