The above-captioned matter was heard as a contested case on September 12, 2025, at which time the complainants and respondents appeared and presented testimony, exhibits, and argument on the complaint. A continued contested case hearing was scheduled for October 29, 2025, and the Hearing Officer issued an order for the respondents to submit records for in camera inspection on the day of such continued hearing.

However, by email dated October 27, 2025, the complainants withdrew their complaint, citing a settlement agreement that they had reached with the respondents and the respondents' substantial compliance with the records request at issue. The Commission takes administrative notice of such withdrawal.
