
The above-captioned matter was heard as a contested case on July 15, 2025,<sup>1</sup> and December 1, 2025, at which times the complainant and the respondents appeared, stipulated to certain facts, and presented testimony, exhibits, and argument on the complaint.

At the conclusion of the continued hearing on this matter, the undersigned hearing officer further continued the matter upon the parties' representations to further work to resolve and fulfill the underlying request. Accordingly, the Commission scheduled an additional contested hearing for January 29, 2026, in the event the matter was not resolved. By email dated January 28, 2026, the complainant informed the Commission that she wished to withdraw the complaint.<sup>2</sup> The Commission takes administrative notice of such withdrawal.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. Based upon the withdrawal, the complaint is hereby dismissed.


<sup>2</sup> In her email, the complainant noted that she had "received the documents" she requested.
