The above-captioned matter was scheduled to be heard as a contested case on June 27, 2025, at which time the respondents appeared, but the complainant did not. At the time he filed the instant complaint with the Commission on January 29, 2025, the complainant was an inmate at the Cheshire Correctional Institution ("Cheshire").

On May 30, 2025, after the Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause sent to the complainant was returned as undeliverable. The Commission contacted the respondents, who advised that the complainant had been discharged in February 2025, but were unable to provide a forwarding address. Since receiving the complaint in this matter, the Commission has not received any correspondence from the complainant informing the Commission of his release or providing an alternate mailing address.

The following order is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint.

1. The complaint is dismissed for failure to prosecute.


