

The complainant, who is incarcerated, appeared via teleconference, pursuant to the January 2004 memorandum of understanding between the Commission and the Department of Correction. On November 25, 2025, the complainant, via signed "Withdrawal of Complaint to FOIC," withdrew his complaint. The Commission takes administrative notice of the complainant's withdrawal.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. Based upon the withdrawal, the complaint is dismissed.


