
The above-captioned matter was heard as a contested case on February 11, 2026, at which time the respondents appeared, but the complainant failed to appear.

The hearing officer notes that Attorney Lisa Waller, counsel for the respondents, appeared with two witnesses. Attorney Waller represented that she spent over eight hours preparing for the hearing. In addition, it is noted that the respondents traveled over an hour to attend the hearing.

The following order is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is dismissed for failure to prosecute.
2. The complainant is admonished for her failure to appear at the hearing in this matter, which failure resulted in a waste of scarce state and local resources.


