The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on August 24, 1976, at which time the complainant and the respondents appeared and presented testimony, exhibits and argument on the complaint.

After consideration of the entire record, the following facts are found:

- 1. The respondents are public agencies as defined in \$1(a) of P.A. 75-342.
- 2. By letter dated June 30, 1976 and delivered to the chairman of the respondent commission on July 6, 1976, the complainant requested a copy of a letter-petition dated November 17, 1975.
- 3. The document requested is a public record within the meaning of \$1(d) of P.A. 75-342.
- 4. Having failed to receive compliance with such request, the complainant appealed to this Commission on July 20, 1976.
- Subsequently, the respondents complied with the complainant's request. The document requested was mailed to the complainant and postmarked July 20, 1976.
- This tender of compliance was in violation of the time requirements of \$5 of P.A. 75-342.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint:

1. Henceforth, the respondents shall comply in all respects with the time requirements of \$5 of P.A. 75-342.
