The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on September 14, 1976, at which time the complainant and the respondents appeared, and presented testimony, exhibits and argument on the complaint.

After consideration of the entire record, the following facts are found:

1. The respondents are public agencies.
2. By letter of complaint dated July 30, 1976 and filed with this Commission on August 2, 1976, the complainant alleged that a record of votes taken upon issues before the respondent board's meeting, in executive session, of July 20, 1976, was not placed on file at respondent board's regular office or place of business as required by §6 of P.A. 75-342.
3. It is found that a record of the votes taken at the July 20, 1976 executive session of the respondent board was not available for public inspection at the respondent board's regular office within the time requirements prescribed by §6 of P.A. 75-342.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint:


1. Henceforth, the respondent board shall adhere strictly to the time requirements of §6 of P.A. 75-342.
