Freedom of Information Commission of the State of Connecticut

The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on March 9, 1976, at which time the complainant and the respondents appeared and entered on the record a stipulation withdrawing the complaint.

Pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, it is recommended that the Commission find the following facts:

1. The respondent, the Meriden-Wallingford Catchment Area Council, went into executive session at its meeting on December 29, 1975 improperly, in that (1) the vote to go into executive session was less than the two-thirds required by Section 6 of P.A. 75-342 and (2) the matters discussed at such session were outside the scope of executive sessions as defined in section 1(e) of P.A. 75-342.

2. The complaint has been withdrawn on the assurance of the respondents that henceforth the respondents will conduct their activities in strict conformance with P.A. 75-342.

3. It is recommended that, subject to the foregoing finding, this complaint be dismissed.
