2. A special meeting of respondent Board of Selectmen was held on Monday, February 9, 1976 at 8:00 A.M.



4. The minutes of the meeting reveal that no business was discussed or acted upon at said meeting other than was set forth in the notice.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:


1. The complaint is dismissed as the respondents complied with section 6 of P.A. 75-342.

2. The dismissal of this complaint will indicate that the Commission considers the nature of the compliance as having satisfied no more than the minimal technical requirements of P.A. 75-342. For future purposes the respondents should adopt and implement notice requirements that will be more consistent with the spirit and intent of Public Act 75-342.
