A hearing was held on the above entitled matter on October 24, 1977, at which time both parties appeared through their representatives and negotiated a procedure to effect settlement of the complaint. Although correspondence later indicated that the complainant was unsatisfied with the attempted compliance, the complainant's representatives were unwilling to pursue the matter further.
