The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on December 13, 1977 at which time the complainant and respondents appeared and presented evidence and argument on the complaint.

After consideration of the entire record, the following facts are found:

1. The respondents are public agencies as defined in §1-18a(a), G.S.
2. By letter dated September 11, 1977 the complainant requested copies of all arrest records, rap sheets and files indexed or maintained under his name by the respondent department.
3. By letter filed with the Commission prior to October 11, 1977 the complainant alleged he had been denied access to documents under the Connecticut Freedom of Information Act.
4. It is found that there are no records indexed under the complainant's name at the respondent police department.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint:


1. The complaint is hereby dismissed.
