
The above captioned matter was scheduled for hearing on August 14, 1979. Prior to that date the Commission was informed that the matter would be withdrawn. However, subsequently the then counsel for the complainant indicated that the complainant was unsatisfied.

Efforts on the part of the Commission to clarify the nature of the complainant's continuing complaint were unsuccessful. The hearing was rescheduled for March 19, 1981 at which time the complainant, represented by new counsel, appeared. The complainant still sought further compliance with his request although the specifics of the request were not established. Prior to the hearing the respondent had indicated by letter that the complainant's request had been complied with and that unless the complainant's request could be further particularized the matter should be dismissed. The matter was continued.

Counsel for the complainant subsequently attempted by letter, dated March 24, 1981, to the complainant to clarify the complainant's complaint. Commissioner Lahey then set May 29, 1981 as a deadline after which she would recommend that the complaint be dismissed if the complainant failed to particularize the nature of his complaint. No further clarification from the complainant has been received by the Commission.


The following order by the Commission is recommended on the basis of the record in the above captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is hereby dismissed.
