
The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on September 4, 1980 and December 23, 1980, at which time the complainant and respondent appeared, stipulated to certain facts, and presented exhibits and argument on the complaint.

After consideration of the entire record, the following facts are found:

1. By letter dated February 8, 1980, the complainant requested the most current listing available of special payroll lecturers maintained by the respondent.
2. At the December 23, 1980 hearing, the parties agreed by stipulation that the respondent would provide the complainant access, up to three times a year, to employment authorizations and course assignments of special payroll lecturers employed by the respondent.
3. The parties further stipulated that the complainant will make its requests in writing and at reasonable times.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint:

1. The respondent will provide the complainant with access, up to three times a year, to employment authorizations and course assignments of special payroll lecturers.
2. The complainant will request such access in writing and at reasonable times.
