STIPULATION

The parties in the above matter, having met and discussed the Complainant's request, hereby stipulate as follows:

1. The Complainant has received crime statistics for the Frog Hollow neighborhood broken down by crime type, for the first 6 months of 1981. With the exception of the request for numbers of arrests (which Complainant waives based upon the Respondent's assurance that this information will be forthcoming) and data from previous years (which does not exist on a neighborhood basis), this information complies with the Complainant's request.

2. In addition, the Respondent agrees to provide the Citizen's Steering Committee with crime statistics, city-wide and broken down by neighborhood by crime type, on a quarterly basis. The first two (2) quarters of 1981 will be provided to the Steering Committee at its July 27, 1981 meeting with Chief Sicaras.

3. Further, the Respondent agrees to provide the Citizen's Steering Committee ^{members} with copies of the crime analysis log of the Police Department's Crime Pattern

relevant to the neighborhood involved.

Bulletins^Δ The distribution to the Committee^{members} shall coincide with Departmental distribution, or shall be distributed monthly, whichever is more frequent.
