1. The respondent is a public agency within the meaning of §1-18a(a).
2. By letter dated September 12, 1981 the complainants requested copies of a certain status report of a complaint she made to the respondent.
3. On September 5, 1981 the complainants filed their complaint with this Commission.
4. No such status report was provided by the respondent.
5. There is no such status report in the file of the respondent agency.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is hereby dismissed.
2. The Commission observes that the respondent could have saved all parties including the Commission significant inconvenience by providing the complainants with a status report even though they did not have one on file.
