GreenerGOV Goals

Public Act 25-125 codified the Greenhouse Gas Emission Reduction Goals of:

- 45% reduction from 2001 levels by 2030
- 70% reduction from 2016 levels by 2040
- Net-zero by 2050



GreenerGOV Current Progress


Decarbonation study is currently underway to develop a plan for decarbonizing state buildings.

Annual report data shows the state has achieved

- 14% reduction in Executive Branch Greenhouse Gas Emissions
- 8% Reduction in state Building emissions
