Notice of GreenerGovCT Steering Committee Meeting

On April 24, 2019, Governor Ned Lamont issued Executive Order No. 11 to continue Connecticut's success for state agencies to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, curb wasteful water use and reduce the amount of waste disposed at state facilities. In the past decade, state agencies have participated in Lead By Example Initiatives to achieve cost savings through energy conservation. To continue Connecticut's success in achieving its goals the Steering Committee was established as part of the Executive Order.
