Review Team Deliverables:

- a. February 1, 2020 – Interagency Steering Committee report on progress to CT General Assembly (DEEP Compiles)
- b. April 2020 – Develop SOPs or contracts for implementing/deploying measures statewide
- c. April 2020 – EnergyCap Level 3 Actions Complete.
DUE DATE is April 1st for all Agencies to enter historical data going back to January 1, 2018.
- d. Ongoing – Make deployment measures replicable and BAU across all state facilities and activities.

Small Business Energy Advantage (SBEA) Program

The Eversource SBEA Program is under review at the AG's Office. UI submitted their revisions to DEEP and once approved the agreement will proceed through the finalization process. Once approved, details will be disclosed as to increases to financing limits. It is anticipated the Eversource SBEA agreement will be in place early in March, with UI following approximately four weeks after.

State Facility Audits

Contractors have been secured for the Level 2 Audits of the thirty-four identified buildings. The Contractors are scheduled to begin by March 1st. Andy (Eversource) suggested that the utility companies may be able to provide a cost share to complete the audits.

Criteria Rating System

Team discussion of a draft of a project criteria rating system document. Once all recommendations have been incorporated, the document will be provided to our Team's Chairs who will manage further processing of the recommendation.

Project Tracking

Spreadsheet will be distributed to team members to input "shovel ready" projects. Once five projects have been selected, the EEP Team will use these projects to develop a tracking system.
