Sustainability Performance Plan

Executive Order 1 (EO 1) calls on Executive Branch agencies to advance environmental leadership and cost savings for taxpayers by reducing greenhouse gas emissions and other sustainability objectives in energy use in buildings and vehicles, water use, and waste disposal.

The goals of EO 1 include:

- 45% reduction in GHG emissions below 2001 levels,
- 10% reduction in water consumption from a FY20 baseline, and
- 25% reduction in waste disposal from a FY20 baseline.

Sustainability Performance Plans are plans drafted each year by Senior Sustainability Officers to detail agency progress and necessary goals, actions, and responsible parties to achieve the targets set in EO 1.

1. How has your agency worked towards the sustainability goals of EO 1 in FY23?

DECD convened a Sustainability Working Group, which met quarterly in 2023. DECD is located in 450 Columbus Blvd, so the Working Group discussed ways to reduce emissions, water consumption, and waste disposal, including:

- Adding signage in the bathroom to recommend paper towels go in the compost bin, and to encourage use of the hand dryer.
- Recommending staff shut off their equipment when they leave for the day.
- Sustainability initiatives at our museums, such as ensuring there are recycling bins, adding a drinking fountain with bottle fill, switching to LED lighting, and other water maintenance.
- Encouraging water bottle usage among staff.
- Encouraging public transportation and carpooling.

The Working Group is seeking guidance from DEEP regarding other best practices and plans to share this information agency-wide.
