This communication is being sent to all key contacts at provider organizations enrolled in the pediatric CT Vaccine Program (CVP) – please read this message in its entirety. Dear CVP providers,

As you are aware, nirsevimab doses are on allocation through the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for the 2024–2025 season. At this point, the Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) is receiving adequate supply with each allocation to meet all provider needs. Previously, DPH has asked providers to only request enough doses for a two-week supply; however, moving forward providers can begin ordering enough doses for a month’s supply of administration.

- Please continue to submit requests via the link by noon on the allocation date below. This will ensure DPH will be able to fulfill your requests with the given allocation.
- On January 6, 2025, nirsevimab orders will no longer need to be requested via the [link](#) and can be placed directly in CT WiZ, similar to all other CVP-supplied vaccines, for the remaining two months of allocation.
- The last allocation date for the season will be February 17, 2025.
