#### **Welcome and Introductions**

Ram Aberasturia, MAC Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m. A welcome was extended to those in attendance. Peggy Zabawar introduced Tyler Kleykamp, Chief Data Officer in the Office of Policy and Management.

#### **Guest Presentation**

Tyler gave a very informative presentation, and links are being made available on the MAC website. In particular, it should be noted that there are monthly "Data Basics" workshops, two and a half hours in length, that are open to state employees as well as the public. Custom classes can be provided to agencies on request. There is no cost to participate. Contact information for classes will be made available in the materials on the MAC website.

# **Approval of Minutes**

The business meeting convened at 10:12 a.m. The draft minutes of the April 19, 2017 MAC meeting were circulated via the list serv. The minutes were approved unanimously, as submitted.

## **Treasurer's Report**

Maura Welch, MAC Treasurer, reported that the balance in the treasury is \$3,290.47 as of April 30, 2017. There has been no activity since last month's report. The Treasurer's report was distributed to the membership via the list serv and was approved unanimously, as submitted.

# **Credentials Report**

Deb Paradis, MAC Credentials Chair, reported that the only agencies from which she is awaiting election results for the term beginning January 1, 2107 are the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) and the Department of Children and Families (DCF). Nancy Nicolescu will be reaching out to DCF. Elise Kremer indicated that the alternate for the Secretary of the State, Sonia Worrell Asare, has left state service. The Alternate for the Office of the Comptroller, Elena Vazquez, is transferring to DAS and an election will be held. The Credentials list has been updated and provided for posting on the website.

#### **Old Business**

<u>Speakers and Logistics for Upcoming Meetings.</u> The Lean presentation scheduled for the March 15, 2017 meeting (which was cancelled due to inclement weather) is being rescheduled. Wanda will confirm the

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speakers' availability for the June 14, 2017 meeting and will discuss with them the expected attendance. Based on Wanda's feedback, a decision will be made on the need for pre-registration.

<u>Web Content/Communications/Orientation Committee.</u> Nancy indicated that she is doing regular updates and invites the membership to submit items of interest. Nancy will post the updated Credentials list; she has also posted a Save the Date for Managers Day 2017.

Status of Updates to MAC list serv. Elise indicated that she has been maintaining the list servs. At this time, this has primarily involved following up on "undeliverables" and removing those managers who have left service. Any agencies which have not yet submitted their managerial distribution list are encouraged to do so.

<u>Legislative Update.</u> Elise indicated that there is little that is definitive to report at this time. There are various budget proposals, including the Governor's updated budget proposal dated May 15, 2017, in response to reduced revenues. The session adjourns on June 7.

Report of Managers Day 2017 Planning Committee. Ram reported that the committee continue to progress on finalizing speakers and will be reviewing menu options as well. The committee will be meeting following the conclusion of the business meeting, and all are welcome to attend.
