From West of Hartford: Take I-84 East. Take exit ramp to I-91 South. Go to Airport Road exit. At end of ramp, turn left onto Airport Road. Stay in the left lane. Proceed to next light and turn left onto Brainard Road/Maxim Road. The driveway to the Training Center will be on your right shortly after you cross over the railroad tracks.

From East of Hartford: Take I-84 West. Take Exit 57 for the Charter Oak Bridge (Routes 5/15). Take the Brainard/Airport road Exit and bear left. At end of ramp, turn left onto Brainard Road. Brainard Road becomes Maxim Road. The driveway to the Training Center will be on your right shortly after you cross over the railroad tracks.

From North of Hartford: Take I-91 South. Take the Airport Road exit. At end of ramp, turn left onto Airport Road. Stay in the left lane. Proceed to next light and turn left onto Brainard Road/Maxim Road. The driveway to the Training Center will be on your right shortly after you cross over the railroad tracks.

From South-East of Hartford: Take Route 2 West. Take Exit 5D to Route 3 West. Take the Exit for I-91 North. Take the Brainard Road Exit to the end (Chowder Pot Restaurant will be on your right). At end of ramp, turn left onto Brainard Road. Brainard Road becomes Maxim Road. The driveway to the Training Center will be on your right shortly after you cross over the railroad tracks.
