


# Tips from Terri

#### **Share with Your Parents or Caregivers:**


	Expect the Unexpected.		<b>Obey Road Crew Flaggers.</b>
	Things like speed limits, traffic lanes and road closures may change on the roads drivers travel every day!		The flagger knows what is best for moving all road users safely through the work zone.
			Know Before You Go.
	Stay Alert.  Avoid distractions while driving/walking/biking in a work zone. Construction signs are there to help everyone move safely through the work zone.		Check radio, TV, and websites for traffic info; and schedule enough time so you can reach your destination on time and safely.
			<b>Be Patient and Stay Calm</b>
	<b>Keep a Safe Distance.</b> Drive defensively by keeping distance between you and the car ahead of you to avoid accidents.		Remember, the crew members are working to improve the transportation system you use every day.
	Obey Speed Limit.		Obey the Signs.
	Driving slower means you can react quicker and avoid workzone accidents!		There are signs at the beginning AND the end of the work zone. Obey the signs all the way through to the end of the work zone.
	Keep Up with Traffic Flow.







Draw a picture of what you think a safe work zone looks like. (Remember safety cones, hard hats and safe drivers!)




#### Game














#### **Game Setup:**

**Color and cut along the dotted lines** to make your game pieces and dice. Fold along the dashed line on your game pieces to make them stand up. Fold the dice along the dotted line and glue/tape edges together.

#### **How to Play:**

Place your player on the **Start** space. Roll the dice and move your player as many spaces as the number on the die. If you roll a "detour," move to the nearest detour space. If you roll a "slow," skip a turn. If you land on a space with a detour, follow the arrow and stop at that space. The first player to reach the work zone safely wins.
