<u>Sleep-Related Infant Deaths: Updated 2022 Recommendations for Reducing Infant Deaths in the Sleep Environment | Pediatrics | American Academy of Pediatrics (aap.org)</u>

CFRP Retreat - planning for the upcoming year-

<u>Infant/Toddler</u>- The OCA is currently working on an Infant Toddler Fatality report which will focus on systemic issues. Data will be collected from different state systems involved with pregnant and new parents to focus interventions and messaging. Current data shows that birth hospitals could be an area where more robust messaging can be provided to parents. Prenatal discussions should also be happening, trying to understand the motives for bed sharing and who is involved in these conversations. How are parental beliefs addressed, are there possible harm reduction strategies/ safe bedsharing? How is the system teaching strategies to avoid unsafe sleep environments and presenting alternatives? Possibly using the voice of lived experience, asking parents for their permission to share their story. Feedback loop has been discussed with CHA to inform respective hospitals of children that have passed due to unsafe sleep environments, so that they can look at their systems and communications.

<u>Homicides-</u> Two main age groups, those under 8 years of age and those 13 and older. Who do we partner with to share our review information to move the needle, with regards to public policy? Possible connections can be made with religious institutions, community agencies and private foundations. Some municipalities are currently working on prevention and there are hospital violence interruption programs at Yale and Hartford. Looking at what causes these young men to pick up firearms in the first place may be a good start. Some teens carry guns for their own safety, once released from detention they go back to the same neighborhood they lived in before. In Hartford there may be ARPA dollars that can towards prevention since there is a significant gun violence issue in the county. Partnering with the SDE to help with school messaging.

<u>Suicides-</u> Most kids will communicate their intent/ ideation, how does CFRP help inform the public on what to do with that information. Lots happening with teen suicides, MH bill in CT will help get kids in crisis the help they need. Absence of systems to complete a deeper review/investigation to understand the circumstances around youth suicide.

<u>Ingestion</u>- Data is currently being collected on ingestions of newly legalized substances. PHA's were discussed. OCA has had conversations with DPH regarding the safe storage, packaging and marketing of marijuana given the new upcoming legal sales.
