1. Approval of Minutes

2. Legislative Update

OCA is working to have legislative recommendations from the report regarding Liam R. enacted into law. The bill is moving forward and OCA is working with agencies on an amendment to the JFS language. The OCA is also working on recommendations that the ADPC work on plans for distribution of Naloxone and a subcommittee to work on the intersection of child welfare and harm reduction. Current proposal is to have the CFRP house that subcommittee and move the work forward. DDS related bill was proposed in follow up to OCA report. Some provisions have fiscal implications and OCA is working on obtaining agreement to some of the revenue neutral pieces of the proposal. There was a bill to change the mandated reporting law to allow school employees to conduct a preliminary inquiry. OCA worked to add to that bill language requiring training to ensure there is clarity between proper preliminary inquiry and improper investigation. Sarah Eagan noted that the OCPD has a proposal to use funding to make 20 social workers available to contract attorneys to improve representation in child welfare cases. OCA supports that bill.

OCA supporting a bill to have a working group to review guardianship in Probate Court, based on reported case from Bristol, in the media.

3. Introduction of New Committee Member

Members welcomed Danielle Cooper to the Committee.

4. <u>Investigation Updates</u>
