CONSUMER ALERT: PUBLIC COMMENT ON AQUARION WATER COMPANY SUBSTATION FLOODING IN GREENWICH, CONN.

The Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (PURA) is accepting public comment from members of the public, elected officials, and all other interested stakeholders regarding flooding associated with an Aquarion Water Company substation that occurred on April 12, 2021 in Greenwich, Connecticut and is currently being investigated in PURA <u>Docket</u> No. 21-04-09. A live <u>public comment hearing</u> will be held via Zoom on June 8, 2021 at 3:00 p.m. OCC encourages all interested members of the public to participate and provide their perspective on the flooding incident, Aquarion's quality of service, and other relevant topics. The public may also submit public comment in writing via e-mail to <u>Pura.ExecutiveSecretary@ct.gov</u> referencing Docket No. 21-04-09. All public comments, both live and in writing, will become an official part of the record and assist OCC, PURA, and other stakeholders the investigation of this incident. Formal <u>evidentiary hearings</u> will be held starting on July 8–9, 2021.
