

OCC Provides Seminar to Bloomfield Residents on the Retail Electricity Market

On July 21, 2015, staff from the Office of Consumer Counsel (OCC) presented a comprehensive "Know Your Rights" seminar about shopping for electricity prices in the retail market at the Marilyn Michaelson Senior Center in Bloomfield. The Program explored the difference between the Standard Service rate from Eversource Energy, which is fixed for six months (from January through June, and from July through December), and offers from electric suppliers who purchase electricity from the wholesale market. OCC staff discussed how to shop for the most competitive rates while avoiding often tricky terms and conditions that may include high variable rates, enrollment fees, and cancellation fees. New legislation affecting consumers, such as the residential electric bill redesign, was also explained.
