Please send an intern application (below), cover letter, and a current resume to the office head of the Public Defender office in which you would like to intern and obtain an interview. Simultaneous submissions to different offices are acceptable.

General Information:

- Certified Legal Intern Law students who are eligible for certification under Practice Book Section 3.14 et. seq., may appear in court. Read the requirements in the Practice Book and/or check with your school Dean.
- A background check is required and will be conducted for students who will be interning with our division.
- A mandatory intern orientation will be held either in-person or virtually at the beginning of each term.
- All internships are unpaid.
- As placements are not guaranteed, we encourage students to also seek other internship opportunities.
- Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis, so feel free to submit paperwork to a field office at any time but please make sure you indicate for which semester you are applying.
- GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSIONS:
 - SUMMER internships submit paperwork beginning in January.
 - o FALL internships submit paperwork beginning in April.
 - o SPRING internships submit paperwork beginning in August.
