Governor Lamont signed the following legislation of the 2021 Regular Session on July 7:

As of this date, the governor has signed one hundred sixty-eight (168) bills and vetoed one (1) bill of the 2021 Regular Session. He has also signed two (2) bills of the June 2021 Special Session.
